PERFECT ARC TOPS MATCHMAKER

Perfect Arc (Brown Arc), whose only loss in 10 career starts came in her very first appearance, tops a list of 52 fillies and mares nominated to this year's Gil \$100,000 Vinery Matchmaker S. at Atlantic City July 24. The four-year-old came back from an eight-and-a-half month layoff to take her ninth straight in a Belmont allowance test yesterday, winning by a length and a quarter as the 1-5 favorite (see *New York Report*). "The first race back is the hardest--you have to get by that," said trainer Angel Penna Jr. "She was antsy because she hadn't run in a while. I told (jockey John Velazquez) to get her to relax--he did a nice job rating her. If she comes out of this okay, we'll try the Matchmaker." The Matchmaker, to be run at a mile and three-sixteenths on the grass, has also attracted Bill Mott trainees **Apolda** (Theatrical {Ire}), a MGSW of nine of 14 starts, and GISW **Bail Out Becky** (Red Ransom), nine-for-18 lifetime; Canadian champion **Bold Ruritana** (Bold Ruckus); **Class Kris** (Kris S.), a five-time GSW who has been first or second in all seven starts this year; GSW **Miss Union Avenue** (Steinlen {GB}), nine-for-13 on her career; and last year's Matchmaker runner-up **Plenty Of Sugar** (Ascot Knight). In addition to the \$100,000 purse, the turf mares will also vie for seasons to three Vinery stallions: **Strike The Gold** (Alydar), **De Niro** (Gulch) and **River Special** (Riverman).

CIGAR, MARIA'S MON WORK AT BELMONT

Cigar (Palace Music) worked seven furlongs in a solid 1:27 at Belmont Friday morning as he prepares to bid for his 16th consecutive victory in the Arlington Citation Challenge July 13. With jockey Jerry Bailey in the saddle, the six-year-old eased through a half in :50.61 and five-eighths in 1:02.11 before finishing up with a final quarter in :24.89. "It was a good work for him," said Bailey. "I was happy with the way he went." Also on the work tab yesterday, last year's champion two-year-old **Maria's Mon** (Wavering Monarch) continued toward his return with a sharp five furlongs in :59.20. The colt was clocked in fractions of :23.44 and :47.11 before galloping out the six furlongs in 1:12.09. "He went perfect," said trainer Rick Schosberg. "He's right on schedule." The Eclipse winner is just one work away from his 1996 debut.

Kelly Kip set a track record of :55 3/5 for five furlongs in his debut, leading a field of \$35,000 maiden claimers home by 6 1/2 lengths in the slop June 21. Proving he could handle a fast track as well, the dark bay jumped right into graded stakes company as the 7-5 favorite and once again led from flagfall to finish, drawing off late under jockey Jean-Luc Samyn. "I'm just happy he could prove himself today and that he wasn't just a fluke," said trainer Allen Jerkens. "I didn't think he was this nice of a horse. I sure would have been sorry if I would've lost him the other day." Added Samyn, "It is just a pleasure to ride a horse with so much speed. The gates opened and he just went." The colt will try to add to his unbeaten streak in the Gill Sanford S. at Saratoga July 26.

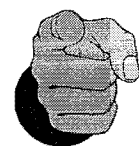

Smart Alec (GB) (Diesis {GB}), expected to play a leading role in Europe's major mile events this year, is out of action after suffering a recurrence of an injury which kept him sidelined for all of last season. The Luca Cumani-trainee won both his starts as a juvenile in 1994, but a training setback in the spring of his three-year-old career meant he had to be rested. He came back this year, however, with a fine second to subsequent G2 winner Luso (GB) in Newmarket's Earl Of Sefton S. and a fourth-place finish behind Soviet Line (Ire) in Newbury's G1 Lockinge S. May 18.

Cumani said, "He's had a recurrence of the problems which kept him out last season and won't run again this year."

Polaris Flight (Northern Flagship), runner-up in both the French and Irish Derbies, is taking a summer vacation before being aimed at the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6. The Peter Chapple-Hyam-trained colt, who demonstrated his talent at the Group One level when winning the Criterium de Saint-Cloud as a juvenile, will be given just one prep-race for the Arc. Chapple-Hyam stated, "Polaris Flight is having a bit of a holiday and the Prix Niel (at Longchamp in September) is his next target. It is the ideal race for him, as he won't receive a penalty for his Group One win."
