### DOUBLE TRIGGER SALE FALLS THROUGH

**Double Trigger** (Ire) (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), winner of last year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup and runner-up when seeking a second victory in that event last month, will not, as had been expected, leave Britain to race in Saudi Arabia. An offer for the five-year-old had been accepted by owner Ron Huggins, but the sale has now fallen through. Prince Mitaab Abdullah, also owner of the French and Irish Derby second **Polaris Flight** (Northern Flagship), seems to have changed his mind about the purchase following a vet's examination. Huggins, whose chestnut tore off a shoe during this year's Gold Cup and is still suffering related foot problems, said: "It was a surprise because we had had reassurances that the deal was going ahead." Others offers are on the table. But, at this stage, it appears that Double Trigger is likely to stay with trainer Mark Johnston and continue a racing career in Europe once he has fully recovered from his current injury.

**STAR STANDARD INJURED** According to a report in yesterday's *Daily Racing Form*, G1 Pimlico Special winner **Star Standard** (Risen Star) has suffered an injury to his left front leg which will keep him out of action for the rest of the season. The four-year-old worked five furlongs in :59 3/5 over the Belmont main track Wednesday, but showed lameness in the leg after the workout. Without specifying the exact nature of the problem, trainer Nick Zito told the *Form*, "It is the type of injury that would take at least three months to take care of. He won't be able to make any big races this year, so we'll just send him to Kentucky to get him well and ready to race again." Star Standard, a winner of seven of his 24 career starts and \$1,121,512, has not been out since taking the Pimlico Special May 11.

Halling put up a brave front-running performance to take his second successive Eclipse S., but gave his supporters a few anxious moments by veering off a straight line in the last 50 yards and bumping runner-up Bijou d'Inde (GB) as the pair fought out a tight finish. Jockey John Reid set a steady pace on Halling, but began to wind it up turning into the home stretch. Pentire (GB) looked the chief threat at that stage, but a combination of the rain-softened ground plus a layoff of three months since he finished fourth in the Dubai World Cup was too much to overcome for the eventual third, whose stride shortened as Halling and Bijou d'Inde really got down to business in the final furlong. Reid's mount, under hard driving, then began to roll right on to his rival. But interference was not enough to affect the final result and, after a stewards' inquiry, places were left unchanged. Reid said: "Halling has tremendous enthusiasm and loves his racing. He's a pleasure to ride." Next stop for the winner will be an attempt to repeat last year's win the G1 Juddmonte International.

Victory Speech, winless since taking a Gulfstream allowance by 11 lengths in February, was most recently second in the GII Ohio Derby June 23. The colt took the lead around the turn and then drew off through the stretch for an easy win. "They had been pointing Honour and Glory toward this race, but then they decided to go to Chicago for a shot at Cigar," explained D. Wayne Lukas assistant George Weaver. "As soon as they made that decision it was a no-brainer to start Victory Speech here--a 1 1/16th-mile race around one turn, right up his alley, plus he was doing great. It made a lot of sense. He was 4-5 today and he ran like it."

Top Secret won the GII Astarita last October at Belmont and had two allowance victories to her credit in four starts this year. Most recently eighth in the GII Prioress June 23, the filly took the lead soon after the start and increased her advantage when called upon in the stretch to win under a hand ride. Winning trainer Rusty Arnold said, "We had an outside speed trip today. We were the lone speed in the race and it's easy for the lone speed to win when it's easy to get away with a quarter in :24. She fell out of the gate today and was able to relax on the lead." The 1-5 favorite Yanks Music, coming off a narrow win in the GI Mother Goose June 22, rallied wide on the final turn to get up for second. "She had never run two races so fast together, two weeks, and that may have made the difference," explained jockey John Velazquez on the beaten favorite. "We were going nice and easy the first half of the race. Then near the half-mile pole I asked her to run and she wasn't responding. I hit her a couple of times in the middle of the turn and I knew it wasn't going to be her day."

Starry Ice, an easy winner over listed stakes foes in her last two starts, found no difficulty making the step up to graded company. The 1-2 favorite followed second choice COZY ANGIE (Cozzene) through a half in :45, then took over as that one faded and strode clear under an Eddie Delahoussaye hand ride. "All I was worried about was her breaking well," said Delahoussaye. "She relaxed nicely off the gray horse...then she just cruised to the lead and kept on to her business. She's not very big, but she gives you all she's got." Trainer Jerry Dutton, who also bred and co-owns the winner, indicated the GII Del Mar Debutante August 25 could be next. Cozy Angie had nothing left after setting the pace and finished last. "She completely stopped at the three-eighths pole," said her jockey, Alex Solis. "She sure acted like she bled."
