ECLIPSE RERUN AT YORK NEXT MONTH

Halling (Diesis {GB}) and **Bijou d'Inde** (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), the duo who fought out such a thrilling finish to Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown, now look virtually certain to clash again over 10 furlongs in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York August 20. The Godolphin team indicated immediately after the trophy presentation Saturday that Halling would go for his second straight win in the Juddmonte International. Now, having checked his colt over following his Sandown efforts and the bump which he took close to home, runner-up Bijou d'Inde's trainer, Mark Johnston, is eagerly anticipating a rematch. "He has come out of the race well," the handler said. "So, now he has proved he stays the distance, York's Juddmonte is his next target." Bijou d'Inde was the first of this year's English-based three-year-olds--officially regarded as below standard--to test his elders in Group One class. Johnston added: "Shaamit (the Epsom Derby winner) is the only one (among his generation) with claims to be better."

FIRST STAKES WINNER FOR SUAVE DANCER

The 1991 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and French Derby winner **Suave Dancer** (Green Dancer) sired his first stakes winner Sunday when his two-year-old colt **Classsem Ducere** (GB) won the listed Premio Guiseppe de Montel over seven and a half furlongs in Milan, Italy, by four lengths, his third win from three career starts. Freshman sire Suave Dancer, now eight, stands for a fee of approximately \$18,000 at The National Stud in Newmarket, England.

DRAMATIC GOLD TO CITATION CHALLENGE

Trainer David Hofmans will send millionaire **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold) to Arlington July 13 to face **Cigar** (Palace Music) in the Arlington Citation Challenge, but admitted yesterday, "We're going to run for second money. The distance is about right and the weights are good, so we'll see what happens." The five-year-old has been on the board in four of his five starts this year, and earned his first victory of the campaign in his most recent start, a Hollywood allowance test June 19. Jockey Corey Nakatani will be in the saddle for the Citation Challenge.

Victor Cooley took at two-race win streak into the Queen's Plate after capturing the G1C Queenston S. May 19 and the G1C Marine S. June 9. The colt, on the rail early after breaking from the inside post, moved to the outside leaving the clubhouse turn and inched closer to the leaders as the field left the backstretch. He moved to challenge around the final turn and battled Stephanotis to deep stretch to prevail under pressure. "I guess you could say the pressure was on this year, having (second choice) Victor Cooley and (favorite) Chief Bearheart," said trainer Mark Frostad, who had saddled just one previous Queen's Plate starter, Bruce's Mills, second in 1994. "Then when Victor Cooley drew the one hole and people started telling me that a horse hadn't won (the Plate) from there since Northern Dancer in 1964, I really got a lump in my throat." As for the winner's future schedule, Frostad said, "We'll keep him here, go on to the Prince of Wales, and we'll be looking at the Woodbine Million in early fall. I don't know about the Breeders' Cup right now--that's too far away. Let's just enjoy this moment." CHIEF BEARHART (Chief's Crown), the slight betting favorite, was last early and mounted a strong late rally, but could not get up in time.

Successful in Group 1 company in her native Argentina, Different (Arg) was tested against the elite of the U.S. in her second Stateside start and proved her ability north of the border as well. Racing head-and-head with GRAFIN (Miswaki) through easy early fractions of :25 1/5, :49, and 1:13 1/5, the chestnut filly took control in midstretch and sprinted home, running the last quarter in :23 3/5 to give trainer Ron McAnally another South American stable star. "We paid \$550,000 for her," said McAnally. "Dr. Pavlowsky, a very influential veterinarian in South America...sent me tapes of her races. I reviewed them at least 20 times. She won on grass, dirt and in the mud. She set track records short, long--it didn't matter. She was very impressive." The winner will point to the GI Ramona H. at Del Mar August 3.

Kayrawan was making his fourth start in the U.S. after winning a Belmont allowance May 2, finishing second in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H., and then sixth in the GII True North H. last time out June 8. The Dubai-based colt moved up steadily from last place, was forced to steady at the half-mile pole, was wide into the stretch and then drew off to the wire. "The plan was to be back and settled, but the first eighth turned out to be pretty dicey," said winning jockey Richard Migliore. "I actually clipped heels with FLYING CHEVRON (Carson City) at one point, and my horse was very rank--he wanted to run off with me. But it helped that Lite the Fuse got trapped down in there--I was able to sit until the 3/16ths pole. It made my life easier." Favored Lite the Fuse had a troubled trip, according to jockey Julie Krone. "He broke slow and I was boxed in 'til I swung him out at the head of the lane. I had to fight him all the way down the backstretch, and when I finally had a place to run I had no horse left. I was a victim of the one hole." Trainer Kieran McLaughlin said the GII A Phenomenon S., August 8 at Saratoga, could be next for Kayrawan.

Connections of **Lucayan Prince** (Fast Play), the 50-1 winner of Royal Ascot's G3 Jersey S. last month, have paid £15,000 to supplement their colt for Thursday's G1 July Cup at Newmarket. Jockey Richard Hughes, on board when Lucayan Prince collected over seven furlongs at Ascot, thinks the drop back to six furlongs this week will suit his mount. "He is a class horse," the Irish-born rider said. "The distance will be no problem."

Mons (GB) (Deploy {GB}), considered a leading candidate for English Classic honors this year after winning Ascot's G2 Royal Lodge S. last autumn, has Goodwood's Gordon S. July 30 as his comeback target following a spell off the course with leg problems. Trainer Luca Cumani has not run his colt, among the winter favorites for the Epsom Derby, since he finished third April 27 in Sandown's Classic Trial. But the Newmarket handler is hoping that Mons, whose long-term aim is likely to be the St. Leger at Doncaster September 14, will be ready to compete at the Group Three level before this month is over. Cumani said: "Mons got sore shins after running at Sandown and we had to give him an awful long time off. The weather and (firm) ground haven't been kind to him, but he is back in work and happy in himself. The Gordon S. is a possibility for him and that could be followed by the (G2) Great Voltigeur S. at York. He has been entered in the St. Leger."

Pricket (Diesis {GB}), who started hot favorite for last month's Epsom Oaks before losing out behind Lady Carla (GB), will not renew rivalry with her Classic conqueror in next Sunday's Irish Oaks at The Curragh. Pricket led the market for Epsom following an easy win in Newmarket's Pretty Polly S. on her opening outing of 1996, having spent the winter with the rest of the Godolphin team in Dubai, but proved no match for nine-length Oaks winner Lady Carla. Connections were, though, keen for a rematch until Pricket--usually a good worker at home--disappointed in a seven-furlong gallop with stablemates last Wednesday. Simon Crisford, racing manager for Godolphin, said: "There is nothing clinically wrong with Pricket--she is just not sparkling." Next stop for Pricket is now likely to be the G1 Yorkshire Oaks (August 21).
