KEENELAND JULY SET FOR MONDAY

Despite a 9.5 percent drop in the number of yearlings catalogued for this year's Keeneland July Selected Yearling Sale, hopes are that the prestigious auction will duplicate last year's results. The 1995 catalogue was 15 percent smaller than the year before, but the sale still showed an increase in both gross and average. "We are very hopeful," said Keeneland Director of Publicity Jim Williams. "The most attractive stallions in the world are represented well in the sale. And **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), who was offered at this sale two years ago, went on to win this year's Preakness. The combination of the performances of horses from past sales and the quality of those offered this year lead us to be optimistic." A total of 219 yearlings have been catalogued for this year's event. Seeking the Gold leads all stallions with 17 representatives; Nureyev and Storm Cat have 13 each, while Danzig and Mr. Prospector have 12 apiece. Unbridled, sire of this year's Kentucky Derby hero Grindstone as well as 1995 Breeders' Cup Juvenile victor Unbridled's Song, will have four yearlings; two yearlings, both fillies, will be sold from Easy Goer's last crop. Nearly 70 percent of the first dams in the July sale are stakes winners and/or stakes producers. "The response to the sale has been good," said Williams. "There is new money coming in, both foreign and domestic, and we've also had a lot of seat requests from Japan. We are anticipating strong interest from the Japanese." The Keeneland July sale will be held during two evening sessions, July 15-16, rather than in two afternoon and two evening sessions, for the first time in recent memory. Sessions begin at 7:30 p.m. EDT. "The results will once again be available on the Internet," said Williams, "and the sale will be on satellite. We will up-link our closed-circuit feed and it will be available in most parts of the world."

ATLANTIC CITY CANCELS SATURDAY CARD

Expecting high winds and heavy rains from the approaching storm, Hurricane Bertha, Atlantic City Race Course has called off its live card for Saturday night. The track was open for racing Friday evening, and will offer full-card simulcasting throughout the weekend. "We're not only concerned about the safety of our horses and jockeys...but also for the large number of horses and trainers that ship in on a daily basis to compete," said Assistant General Manager John Wayne. BROOKS ON THE IMPROVE

Steeplechase jockey Charlotte Brooks, injured in a spill at Delaware Park Tuesday, has regained consciousness at Christiana Medical Center and while she is still listed in critical condition, doctors are encouraged by her progress. "Charlotte sustained a skull fracture and kidney contusion," said Dr. Glen H. Tinkoff, director of trauma and the rider's attending physician. "Her prognosis is guarded; it is not yet possible to predict anything about disability. However the medical team is encouraged by the fact that she has regained consciousness in the last 48 hours." Brooks remains in the hospital's surgical shock trauma unit.
