SWEET SIXTEEN FOR CIGAR It was classic Cigar (Palace Music). Sporting Allen Paulson's red, white and blue silks, America's Horse acknowledged his cheering fans with a nod in the post parade, kept cool on the way to the gate, then barely seemed to break a sweat as he cruised through the mile-and-an-eighth of yesterday's Arlington Citation Challenge on his way to his 16th straight victory. The six-year-old thus proved up to the challenge, matching the feat of one of this century's greats; he will look to break Citation's U.S. record for consecutive victories in the GI \$1,000,000 Pacific Classic at Del Mar August 10. "I was never so proud of a horse," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "It was a spectacular effort." Breaking from the far outside, the consummate professional was widest of all into the first turn but loomed off the front-runners down the backside like a panther waiting to pounce. And pounce he did, gliding to the lead as they straightened into the stretch, turning back a game **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold) with one flick of Bailey's whip, and striding away to win by 3 1/2 lengths. "He was further back and carried further out than we had hoped, but Cigar was good enough to overcome it," said trainer Bill Mott. "The rest is history."

BERTHA BEATS UP EAST COAST RACING Hurricane Bertha had been downgraded to a tropical storm by the time she reached New Jersey, but her heavy rains and high winds still managed to disrupt the East Coast racing scene, cancelling the live cards at Jersey's Monmouth Park and Long Island's Belmont Park. Monmouth did offer its scheduled simulcast program, but Belmont was closed for live and simulcast racing. Both tracks are expected to be back in action this afternoon. Belmont's scheduled feature for Saturday, the GII New York H., will be opened to all original nominees and redrawn Thursday, to be run Saturday, July 20. Racing was also called off after the fifth race at Rockingham Park in New Hampshire when a downpour turned the track into a sea of slop.

Looking to silence those disagreeable few who waste time searching for the clouds behind every silver lining, the great Cigar wowed the crowd at Arlington with yet another sterling silver performance. Sent off at a generous 1-5, the unflappable bay was parked wide throughout the nine furlongs but made the most of his position, biding his time midpack as they raced down the backstretch, ranging up on even terms with pacesetter HONOUR AND GLORY (Relaunch) and Dramatic Gold as they headed out of the far turn, then shifting it up another gear to shake off a determined Dramatic Gold and draw away to his 16th straight victory. "I wasn't happy on the first turn," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "My worst fear was realized and we were hung out there as wide as we could be. But when we turned down the backside and I knuckled on him, he picked it up and it was pretty much all smiles after that." The champ returned to the roar of the 35,000-plus fans. "He really seems to enjoy it," said trainer Bill Mott. "I'm not so sure he doesn't know all this crowd noise is for him." Future plans call for a trip to Del Mar for the GI Pacific Classic August 10, then back to Belmont for a race or two before taking the tour back on the road for the Breeders' Cup Classic at Woodbine October 26. UNBRIDLED'S SONG (Unbridled), the second choice at 9-2, sat just inside Cigar to the middle of the backstretch and was asked for run when the favorite started his move, but had no response and was finished before they reached the far turn.

Listening, stepping up to Grade I company in her seventh career start, followed a victory in the GII Princess S. with another decisive score. Sent off the second choice behind stablemate Antespend, the grey sat just off the lead as the favorite cut out the early fractions but put a head in front at the top of the stretch and drew clear. "It was just a matter of who was the fastest from the head of the lane to the wire...Listening was just able to outfinish Antespend," said winning rider Chris McCarron. "She's always shown ability and class right from the word 'Go.' This is a very good filly." Added trainer Ron McAnally, "I was very high on this filly as a two-year-old. She had some shin problems earlier and we took care of that." As for what's next, McAnally said, "More than likely we'll try to run her on the turf at Del Mar. She's bred to run on the turf. I still think Antespend is a better filly on the turf, too."
