UNBRIDLED'S SONG FRACTURES

SPLINT BONE Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) suffered a non-displaced fracture of the splint bone in his left front leg during Saturday's Arlington Citation Challenge, trainer Jim Ryerson reported yesterday. Ryerson said the injury is not serious, adding that the three-year-old colt may race again before the year is over. In what was arguably the worst race of his career, Unbridled's Song finished ninth in the 10-horse Challenge field. According to Ryerson, the gray colt also bled in the race. "I've talked to (owner) Ernie (Paragallo) and Ernie's plan is to try and bring him back," Ryerson said. "I believe he's thinking this year." When asked when the horse may reappear at the races, Ryerson responded, "I don't want to get into that. I haven't got a real estimate of that. It's going to take some time. At this time we're just looking to give him some rest and will try and get the splint bone to heal." Unbridled's Song accompanied Cigar on a flight Sunday from Chicago to Saratoga. He is expected to remain there for at least the next few days while he recuperates. Unbridled's Song, fifth as the favorite in this year's Kentucky Derby, won the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, GI Florida Derby and Gil Wood Memorial for earnings to date of \$1,253,000.

TONIGHT The 1996 Keeneland July Select Yearling Sale begins tonight at 7:30 p.m. Eastern Time. The second of the sale's two sessions will be held Tuesday night, also at 7:30 p.m. Catalogue highlights include a half-brother to 1986 Horse of the Year Lady's Secret (by Gone West--Great Lady M.); a half-sister to 1991 Horse of the Year Black Tie Affair (Ire) (by Storm Cat--Hat Tab Girl); a full-brother to champion Pleasant Tap and half-brother to 1994 Kentucky Derby winner Go For Gin (by Pleasant Colony--Never Knock); and a half-sister to champion Gold Beauty (by Storm Cat--Stick to Beauty). Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent, leads all consignors with 26 yearlings in the 219-strong catalogue. Among the 1996 racing stars who graduated from the sale are GI Belmont S. winner **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner), GI Preakness S. winner **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) and GI Hempstead H. winner **Serena's Song** (Rahy). Another prime purchase from the Keeneland July Sale was **Mr. Prospector** (Raise a Native), who topped the 1971 auction. A.I. "Butch" Savin purchased Mr. Prospector for \$220,000. The bay went on to earn \$112,171 as a racehorse and to date has sired 147 stakes winners and the earners of over \$63,800,000.

Dance Design (Ire) gave her trainer Dermot Weld a memorable Classic double when narrowly beating French raider Shamadara (Ire) in yesterday's Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks. LADY CARLA (GB) (Caerleon), a very easy winner of the Epsom Oaks on her previous start, was made the 1-2 favorite to claim this prize for England and Pat Eddery confidently sent her off in front from the start. But she could never establish a clear lead and, even when Eddery asked her to quicken turning into the home stretch, she was unable to shake off Key Change (Ire), who had shadowed the market leader for every stride of the first mile. Shamadara began to gain ground as the front two started to work hard with two furlongs left to race and, for a moment, appeared likely to claim the contest. But Michael Kinane, timing his run on Dance Design to perfection, hit the front in the final 100 yards and drove head down to the post. Weld, successful with the colt Zagreb (Theatrical {Ire}) in the Irish Derby two weeks previously, said, "Dance Design is a lovely filly. We had our doubts about her stamina, but she did it well and it's great to complete the Classic double. She'll have a short break now and then we'll think about an autumn campaign."

Cleante, named the 1993 Horse of the Year and Champion Miler in his native Argentina, had registered only one victory in 18 previous starts in the U.S. when he dead-heated for first in the Bates Motel S. at Santa Anita April 23, 1995. Second to Soul of the Matter in last year's Bel Air H., the dark bay came into this year's event off a second-place finish to Dramatic Gold in a June 19 Hollywood allowance. Sent off the 2-1 second choice in this short four-horse field, he was bumped at the start, stalked the pace through moderate fractions of :23 4/5 and :47 1/5, moved up outside on the second turn, came four-wide into the drive and battled gamely outside Dare and Go through the final furlong to narrowly prevail for his first North American graded stakes victory. "He's very durable; he's stayed sound and he hasn't missed too many dances," said winning trainer Ron McAnally. "Today he looked good. A mile and a sixteenth is just about his limit." Gary Mandella, assistant to Dare and Go's trainer Richard Mandella, said of the beaten favorite, who finished fifth in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup two weeks ago, "I would rather have been on the lead and set the pace myself, but it didn't shock me that FLYING MARFA (Marfa) was on the lead. I think we had a good enough trip, but I also think we saw he's a 1 1/8-mile, 1 1/4-mile type of horse. He got a lot out of this and it's just important that he comes out of this race sound. There's no telling where he'll run next."

CIGAR RETURNS TO NEW YORK After posting his 16th consecutive victory before a national television audience in Saturday's Arlington Citation Challenge, superstar Cigar (Palace Music) left Chicago Sunday morning on a flight from O'Hare Airport to Saratoga. **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o' Gold), who hooked Cigar at the top of the stretch then held on to be second, beaten 3 1/2-lengths, will wait until Monday or Tuesday to leave by van for Churchill Downs, and will then fly back to California and Hollywood Park Wednesday. Darla Elliott, who travelled with Dramatic Gold, reported that the five-year-old came out of Saturday's event in good shape. "He always gives his all," Elliott said. "When they (Cigar and Dramatic Gold) came together, it was so exciting to see Dramatic Gold dig in like that and challenge Cigar. But, after all, it was Cigar. What can you do?" Trainer Bobby Frankel indicated that he will probably keep third-place finisher **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) at Arlington to run in the \$200,000 Arlington H. Aug. 4 at 1 1/4-miles on the grass. "If he does well in there, who knows, maybe he'll run in the Arlington Million," said Ruben Loza, Frankel's barn foreman.

MARIA'S MON RETURNS WEDNESDAY Last year's Champion Two-Year-Old Colt **Maria's Mon** (Wavering Monarch), unraced since his Oct. 7 victory in the GI Moët Champagne S., will return Wednesday at Belmont Park in a 6 1/2-furlong allowance event. The gray has been sidelined with a leg fracture, but is reportedly fully recovered and has been training sharply for his return. With regular rider Robbie Davis aboard and carrying 115 pounds, Maria's Mon will meet six others in a race that is expected to be a steppingstone for him to the Aug. 4 Jim Dandy S. and Aug. 24 Travers S.

OCEANPORT HANDICAP WILL NOT BE RESCHEDULED The Grade III \$100,000 Oceanport H., washed away with the rest of Saturday's live racing card at Monmouth Park due to Hurricane Bertha, will not be rescheduled, it was announced yesterday. The stakes was to be for three-year-olds and up at 1 1/16-miles on the turf. "When we contacted the horsemen, they could not commit to the race due to other plans," said Michael P. Dempsey, director of racing and racing secretary for Monmouth Park. "We had a good field for the Oceanport, but now there are numerous other races coming up to run on the turf. It's more a matter of timing than anything else."

Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam "won" the G2 Prix Eugene Adam for the second year running when his Desert Boy beat the French-trained Radevore by a half-length at Saint-Cloud, but then lost the race in the stewards' room after the authorities found that Lord Weinstock's runner had interfered with fellow British challenger Acharne in the closing stages. "I am very, very disappointed," said Chapple-Hyam. "The best horse won the race." Ridden by Andre Fabre's second jockey Sylvain Guillot, Desert Boy set out to lead from from start to finish, but a furlong and a half out, with Guillot using his whip in his right hand, the colt drifted into Acharne and nearly put Clive Brittain's colt over the rails. Ironically, it was Fabre's colt Radevore who came late to beat Acharne for second spot and therefore take the race. While Fabre was able to celebrate a lucky ninth win in the Prix Eugene Adam, Guillot collected a four-day suspension, starting July 23.

Raphane, who had swerved away his chance of winning last month's G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot, gained consolation on home soil when taking the Omni Irish Club Curragh S. The Con Collins-trainee was wearing blinkers for the first time in public here and the addition of headgear clearly helped his concentration. He was quickly out of the gate and, although CLASSIC PARK (GB) (Robellino) took a definite advantage before the first furlong was over, Raphane always appeared in total control. Jockey Kevin Darley asked him to make his move with just over a quarter-mile to run and the response was virtually immediate. NEVADA (IRE), who had been tracking the eventual winner throughout, put in late a challenge. But he had to settle for the runner-up spot as Raphane justified his starting odds of 8-11. Raphane holds an entry for Goodwood's G2 Richmond S. over six furlongs Aug. 1.

Restructure (Ire) paid a handsome compliment to his Royal Ascot conqueror Charnwood Forest (Ire) (Warning) with a gutsy win here. The Julie Cecil-trainee had finished four lengths second on his latest start in Ascot's G2 Queen Anne S., but was made the 3-2 favorite here to give that form a big boost. Rainbow Blues (Ire), runner-up in the Irish 2000 Guineas and then fifth in the Irish Derby, set off in front in a bid to bolster the latest Classic generation. But jockey Paul Eddery always had Restructure in behind the leader and, once he asked for extra 1 1/2-furlongs from home, his mount responded admirably to grab an advantage. Bin Rosie (GB), whose challenge came from way back, made rapid progress inside the last 200 yards but could not quite grab first prize. Winning trainer Julie Cecil is adamant that a mile is as far as Restructure wants to go. So, unless the Newmarket handler feels her colt can improve sufficiently to make it worthwhile tackling Charnwood Forest again in Goodwood's G1 Sussex S. July 31, she may choose more trips abroad.
