TORRENTIAL RETIRED TO GAINSBOROUGH STUD

Torrential (Gulch), winner of last year's G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly, has been retired and will stand at Gainsborough Stud in Versailles, Kentucky beginning with the 1997 breeding season. The four-year-old, unraced as a juvenile, won his first two career starts before posting a disappointing run, soon discovered to have been caused by an injury, in the G3 Thresher Classic Trial at Sandown Park. Torrential recovered his best form with a Jean Prat win, a close fourth in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp and, when flown to the U.S. for his final three-year-old test, a second in the GII American Derby at Arlington. This year Torrential--a half-brother to Grade One winner and leading sire Fappiano--has been seen only twice. His last performance on the track, carrying the Godolphin silks, saw him finish eighth behind **Cigar** (Palace Music) in the March 27 Dubai World Cup. Torrential retires with three wins from six starts for earnings of \$178,550.

CIGAR SETS ANOTHER RECORD Thoro-Graph has assigned **Cigar** (Palace Music) a speed figure of -2 1/4 for his winning performance in the July 13 Arlington Citation Challenge, the lowest number the service has ever assigned to a Thoroughbred in its 14-year history. Thoro-Graph produces speed-figure sheets at tracks across the country, assigning a number to every performance a horse makes, taking into account final time, ground loss, weight carried and other factors. The more impressive a performance is, the lower the horse's Thoro-Graph figure will be. Cigar earned a -1 in the June 1 Massachusetts H. just prior to his historic 16th consecutive win last Saturday, but bested that performance with a wide trip under a heavy impost in Chicago. "He was five wide on the first turn and three wide on the second turn and carrying 130 pounds," said Thoro-Graph's Jerry Brown. "His performance was from another planet." Other negative Thoro-Graph figures include Risen Star's 1988 Belmont win (-3/4) and Inside Information's 1995 Breeders' Cup Distaff (-1/2).

BELCUORE WINS DOMINION AWARD Grace Belcuore is the winner of the fourth annual Dogwood Dominion Award. The recipient of the 1996 award, which honors unsung heroes in racing, was announced Wednesday by Dogwood President W. Cothran "Cot" Campbell. Belcuore is founder and president of the California Equine Retirement Foundation (CERF), which provides permanent homes for geldings and a placement service for ex-racehorses going on to other careers. "Grace is an admirable, hard-working and determined lady who does this out of the goodness of her heart and with no tangible reward," Campbell said. "She's certainly an appropriate winner of this award and we're happy to provide this deserved recognition." An award luncheon will be held at the Reading Room in Saratoga Springs Aug. 7 to present Belcuore with a cash award of \$5,000 and a bronze sculpture of Dominion, a five-time Champion Sire in England.

SWINBURN'S RETURN IN JOCKEY CLUB'S HANDS Britain's Jockey Club announced yesterday that its Licensing Committee will meet with Walter Swinburn next Wednesday to discuss the re-issue of his riding credentials. Swinburn, a three-time Epsom Derby hero, has been out of racecourse action since suffering multiple injuries in a fall at Hong Kong's Sha Tin track in February. The 34-year-old jockey returned to exercise work in Newmarket last month and had hoped to make his public comeback in time to ride Godolphin's **Halling** (Diesis {GB}) in Sandown Park's G1 Eclipse S. 12 days ago. But although Swinburn has been declared fit by his own neurosurgeon, the Jockey Club has not until now agreed on a date to discuss his re-application. Swinburn's agent, Graham Green, stated, "All the reports are before the Licensing Committee and now it's up to them."

SOLON RETIRED Solon (Ger) (Local Suitor), the top-rated three-year-old in Germany last season, has been retired to stud after reportedly suffering a recurrence of a tendon problem. The bay, trained by Heinz Jentsch, won five races in 1995, including the Swiss Derby and the G1 EMS Kurierpost-Europa-Preis over a mile and a half in Cologne last September. He returned to that course June 16 to register an easy victory in a conditions race. But a leg injury, which appears to be related to the one which kept him off the course for more than eight months, has now forced his early retirement to Gestut Schlenderen, the stud which bred and raced him.

Trainer Ron McAnally reported Tuesday that Santa Anita H. winner **Mr Purple** (Deputy Minister) has suffered a hairline fracture of his left front ankle bone and will be out of training for at least two months, according to a story in the *Blood-Horse Online Daily Edition*. The four-year-old, who was eased in his last start, the June 30 Hollywood Gold Cup, will therefore not be eligible for the MGM Grand Classic Crown bonus for horses who compete in the Santa Anita H., Hollywood Gold Cup and Pacific Classic, scheduled for Aug. 10 at Del Mar.

Trainer Neil Drysdale will enter both **Time Star** (Manila) and **Special Price** (Bering {GB}) in Sunday's GII Caesars Palace Turf Championship.
