**MORE LABOR WOES FOR OJC?** The Ontario Jockey Club is facing another labor dispute, this time with its security guards. The OJC has given its 100 security workers a deadline of July 29 to accept its offer or face a lockout. The security guards, who became unionized this year, have not had a raise in three years and have been without a contract since the beginning of 1996. The workers are concerned about losing money due to proposed changes which would shorten their weekly work schedules; they are expected to ask for a raise from their current rate, which is \$10.77 (Canadian) per hour for full-time workers. An OJC official said there is a provision for a pay increase in the offer currently on the table. Allen Ferens, business agent for Local 204 of Service Employees International Union, has indicated that the Breeders' Cup may once again be threatened. "We certainly hope not, but that's their decision," said Ferens. The security guards belong to the same union as the mutuel employees, who were involved in a lengthy dispute with the OJC which nearly caused Woodbine to lose the 1996 Breeders' Cup. Jim Ormiston, the OJC's Senior Vice President of Finance and Administration, said, "The reality is, we're offering a very reasonable proposal. Any union leader is going to use the Breeders' Cup as a leverage position, but we're very confident we'll have a deal by next week, and we won't have to (lock them out). It's not in their best interest to hold up the (Breeders' Cup)." Ormiston also said that the OJC still has to work out a contract with its maintenance personnel, but added it was not unusual for contracts to come up at the same time, saying, "It's not a big deal--not like the situation with the mutuels."

**HASKELL WEIGHTS RELEASED** Belmont Stakes winner **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) and **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), narrowly beaten in that race and first in the Ohio Derby last time out, have been assigned 124 pounds each for the GI Buick Haskell Invitational, to be run August 4 at Monmouth Park. A total of 26 three-year-olds have been weighted for the nine-furlong event; next on the list is Preakness victor **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), 123, followed by Met Mile winner **Honour and Glory** (Relaunch) and two-year-old champ **Maria's Mon** (Wavering Monarch) at 122; Jim Beam winner **Roar** (Forty Niner) and **Victor Cooley** (Cool Victor), tops in the Queen's Plate, are in at 118. The co-highweights are both expected to compete for the winner's share of the \$750,000 Haskell pot.

**MARIA'S MON SET FOR JIM DANDY** Last year's champion two-year-old *Maria's Mon* (Wavering Monarch), second in his 1996 comeback at Belmont Wednesday, came out of the race in "terrific" shape, according to trainer Rick Schosberg, and is likely to make his next start at Saratoga August 4. "He came out perfectly," said Schosberg. "His legs were ice cold, he was mentally sharp and I couldn't be more pleased. Hopefully, the next start will be the Jim Dandy."

**JAPAN BIDS FOR ST. JOVITE** *St. Jovite* (Pleasant Colony), officially rated Europe's champion racehorse of 1992, is the latest stallion to become a target for Japanese buyers, according to a story in Friday's *Sporting Life*. But the seven-year-old, whose wins included the Irish Derby and Ascot's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., looks set to remain in Kentucky after owner Virginia Kraft Payson turned down a \$20 million offer for her star bay. Dean Grimm, president of Payson Stud in Lexington, where *St. Jovite* stands, told *Sporting Life*, "We had an offer this week at the sales, but we believe in the horse. This is the highest bid we have had--they started over two years ago at \$8 million." *St. Jovite's* first foals are two-year-olds of 1996.

**THE VID RETURNS TODAY** Turf star *The Vid* (World Appeal), out since taking the GII Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream January 27, will make his return in today's fifth race at Calder. The six-year-old had won three straight graded stakes before suffering a fractured sesamoid in training just after his Canadian Turf victory. "Everything has gone very well for him so far, but when they are coming off that kind of injury, you really don't know where you stand until they run in a race," said trainer Martin Wolfson. Jockey Abdiel Toribio will be aboard for the 1 1/16th-mile grass allowance.

**PERUVIAN RETIRED** Dogwood Stable's *Peruvian* (Conquistador Cielo) has been retired and will be sold for stud duty, Dogwood President W. Cothran (Cot) Campbell announced yesterday. The four-year-old colt underwent knee surgery in April and was unable to regain his previous form, Campbell explained. At two, *Peruvian* won both the Ellis Park Juvenile S. and the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill Downs. At three, he won the inaugural running of the Indiana Derby at Hoosier Park and the Beulah Park Budweiser Breeders' Cup. He was also second in the Fort Springs S. at Keeneland and fourth in Saratoga's GII Jim Dandy. Trained by Pete Vestal, *Peruvian* retires with six wins in 14 career starts for earnings of \$318,272. The colt is currently at Dogwood's headquarters in Aiken, South Carolina.
