CELTIC SWING RETIRED Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister), champion juvenile in Europe in 1994 and winner of last season's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly, has been retired after suffering a hairline fracture to his off-hind leg, according to yesterday's *Sporting Life*. Celtic Swing earned his ranking as Europe's best two-year-old with a stunning win in the G1 Racing Post Trophy, and was immediately made a short-price favorite for the 1995 Epsom Derby. But, after a victory in Newbury's G3 Greenham S., he suffered his first career defeat in the Newmarket 2000 Guineas. Connections attributed that reverse to very fast going on an undulating course and, instead of aiming their colt at Epsom, sent him instead to Chantilly. The French Derby was Celtic Swing's last victory. The colt was disappointing next time in what was to be his final start, the Irish Derby last July, and came out of the race with a problem with his left knee. "I kept him in training with a view to racing him as a four-year-old and his programme was progressing perfectly until recently, when intermittent lameness caused us to scan him thoroughly," owner Peter Savill told *Sporting Life*. "Unfortunately, his vet has identified a small hairline fracture in his off-hind, which is a recurrence of an injury he sustained as a foal." Plans for Celtic Swing's stud career were not announced.

BLUE DUSTER RETURNS AT YARMOUTH Blue Duster (Danzig), last year's high-rated European juvenile filly, makes her first appearance of 1996 in a minor contest at Yarmouth this afternoon. The David Loder trainee, unbeaten in four outings as a two-year-old, earned her position at the top of the rankings when winning the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket last September. But she has suffered back problems this year and it is only now, after a recent spell spent in Dubai, that she has satisfied her handler that she is ready to make a belated reappearance. She faces just four rivals in her comeback bid, going seven furlongs in the Tunstall Fillies' Conditions S.; jockey Mick Kinane gets the call.
