BLUE DUSTER SHINES ON COMEBACK Blue Duster (Danzig), champion juvenile filly in Europe last year, is right on course to tackle Group One company after winning easily on her 1996 racecourse debut at Yarmouth yesterday. Sheikh Mohammed's unbeaten bay had been suffering a series of back problems, but, despite appearing quite fresh and pulling hard during the first quarter-mile of the seven-furlong Tunstall Conditions S., she quickened when asked to beat long-time pacesetter **Unconditional Love (Ire)** (Polish Patriot) by a length and a half. Trainer David Loder was thrilled with Blue Duster's comeback, her first start since taking the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket last September, and immediately nominated Deauville's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest next month as her probable target. "She was a bit fresh today," he admitted. "But she has been back with us (since flying to Dubai for a period of rehabilitation) for only three weeks, so that's not very surprising." Anthony Stroud, Sheikh Mohammed's racing manager, added: "I think the Maurice de Gheest should suit her--the ground was very fast here and they usually water the course well at Deauville--but it is not going to be an easy race as the July Cup winner (**Anabaa** {Danzig}) is likely to be in the field."

TOP CONTENDERS WORK FOR KING GEORGE

Last year's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. runner-up **Pentire (GB)** (Be My Guest) and this year's Epsom Derby hero **Shaamit (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}) showed they are bang-on for their appearances in this year's edition of the mile-and-a-half G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., to be run Saturday at Ascot, when they worked well at Newmarket Sunday. Pentire worked over a mile, and trainer Geoffrey Wragg said: "My plan is now to get him ready for Saturday and hope that he goes one better than last year, when he was beaten by Lammtarra." Former British champion jockey Michael Roberts is standing by to partner Pentire if the four-year-old's regular rider Michael Hills fails in his appeal against suspension this week, and was aboard for Sunday's work. Shaamit, partnered by his big-race jockey Pat Eddery, also worked well and trainer William Haggas remarked: "He looked pretty good to me and I'm very happy. The horse seems fine and I hope to have a trouble-free week with him. People have been decrying the Derby form, but they said the same thing about Lammtarra last year and he went on to win both the King George and the Arc."

Jewel Princess, second her last two starts after taking graded events in three of her first four outings this season, hadn't been beaten more than three-quarters of a length all year but was still third choice behind co-favorites Serena's Song and pacesetter BORODISLEW (Seattle Slew) here. The bay shadowed the leaders for a half, moved up the rail to take the lead three furlongs from home and opened it up down the lane to win decisively. "She's a wonderful animal and this time we got the trip," said winning trainer Wally Dollase. "I'm ecstatic." As for the future, he said, "I was actually planning on giving her a little break...our main goal is that mile-and-an-eighth race in Toronto. She may get two races before the (Breeders' Cup Distaff October 26)." Serena's Song got up for second while no match for the winner; Borodislew, who was washy warming up, tired in the stretch and finished a well-beaten fifth.

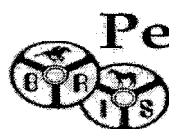
