PENTIRE SHINES AT ASCOT Pentire (GB) (Be My Guest) is on course for the Breeders' Cup at Woodbine after returning to his best form in yesterday's King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S at Ascot. The Geoff Wragg-trainee could do no better than third when trying a mile and a quarter in his previous outing in the Eclipse S. at Sandown three weeks ago. But, with the advantage of fast ground here, he proved a brilliant winner. Wragg was in a buoyant mood after the race. However, he admitted being worried after a slow beginning from his four-year-old. "Michael (Hills) said the horse fell asleep in the stalls," Wragg said, "but he did it well in the end. I was a little bit concerned about having to give so much weight to the 3-year-olds but, thankfully, he proved he was good enough. We are going to concentrate on preparing for the Breeders' Cup now. The Arc would be a possibility, though the ground is often soft for that; we might consider the Japan Cup."

MONMOUTH RAISES PURSES Overnight purses at the current Monmouth Park meet will be raised an average five percent daily, it was announced yesterday by Director of Racing Mike Dempsey. "We began the meeting offering over \$230,000 a day in total purses and we'll be over \$240,000 starting with Tuesday's races," said Dempsey. "Both our local horsemen and the betting public have responded strongly to the 1996 season."

EUROPEANS TO ARLINGTON Two-time Group 1 winner **Valanour (Ire)** (Lomond) will arrive at Arlington Park next Tuesday to run in Sunday's \$200,000 GII Arlington H., a prep for the August 25 Arlington Million. Sixth last out in the G1 Coral Eclipse S. at Sandown, England, the colt had won the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp in his prior start. The win was his second G1 victory over that course; he took the G1 Grand Prix de Paris in June, 1995. He will be accompanied by **Volochine (Ire)** (Soviet Star), a multiple stakes winner in France who was third in his only North American start, the '94 GI Rothman's International at Woodbine.

He was still at the back of the pack when the leader turned into the home stretch and Classic Cliche (Ire) began to make his move. But Pentire's jockey, Michael Hills, did not panic and, gradually making progress through the last quarter mile, finally grabbed an advantage inside the final 200 yards. Classic Cliche tried to rally and Epsom Derby winner Shaamit (Ire) also threw down a challenge. But Pentire, despite rolling slightly to his right close to home, never looked in danger of defeat.

Looking for her fourth straight win in the Test, Capote Belle set down torrid early fractions, turning in a 21.45 quarter and a 43.33 half. Breaking loose from 7-5 favorite ESCENA (Strawberry Road {Aus}) on the turn, she then turned back the upper-stretch challenge of Flat Fleet Feet. "Today she did what she didn't do last time--she took everyone out of the race by running them off their feet," said trainer Dan Peitz. "We're looking at the (Aug. 18) Ballerina next and then the (Sept. 8) Gazelle at Belmont. We have talked about the Breeders' Cup Sprint, although we would like to think she'll go a distance of ground. We've also talked about the Breeders' Cup Mile...but she's running too well on the dirt to think she'll ever get that chance." Said Jerry Bailey, aboard Escena, "We couldn't keep up with Capote Belle and we couldn't catch her."

Primarily a sprinter, her longest effort was a mile-and-a-sixteenth allowance win last out July 3 at Hollywood. "We always thought she would run long," said trainer Ron Ellis. "She's never shown us she couldn't. It's only by pure circumstance she didn't stretch out any sooner. Distance racing is where the big money is and her last race was a nice prep and a good experience for her. She's all set and if she can go this far against Grade I company, she'll be okay."

QUEEN SCEPTRE (IRE) (Fairy King), narrowly beaten behind Moonlight Paradise last time out, led at a good pace. But her stride began to shorten with two furlongs left to run and Seebe, squeezing between rivals to make her challenge, and Moonlight Paradise, brought wide of the rest, went on together. The eventual runner-up definitely took an advantage around 100 yards from the post. However Seebe, under strong driving from Michael Hills, fought back in the last few strides to score by inches. Successful trainer Ian Balding, whose filly had made her first racecourse appearance only 10 days prior to this victory, had been in two minds about allowing her to run as he thought she may lack the necessary experience to make the big step up from maiden company.

Iktamal had been beaten almost five lengths when fourth in the July Cup at Newmarket, but had too much fire-power for his rivals here. **KAHIR ALMAYDAN (IRE)** (Distinctly North) took the field along at a decent gallop, with **WIZARD KING (GB)** (Shaadi) stalking the leader. Dance Sequence began to make her move at halfway and Branston Abby (Ire), attempting to equal the post-war record of 22 wins from a distaff runner, also started to make progress. But Willie Ryan, who had been biding his time at the back of the pack, shook the reins at Iktamal just over a furlong from home and swept into the lead. Dance Sequence stayed on strongly to retain the runner-up spot. Winning trainer Ed Dunlop had been concerned that his four-year-old chestnut would not last this distance as, even though he had already won at seven furlongs, undoubtedly his best form was last time over six. Dunlop said: "He ran the race of his life in the July Cup and we were slightly worried that this might be too far in Group company."

But he overcame those twin doubts to beat the previously unbeaten Predappio (GB) with something in hand. His Excellence (El Gran Senor), third last time in the Irish Derby, set out to make all the running. Song of Tara (Ire) was, however, always snapping at his heels and, at one point in the home stretch, appeared to be travelling best. But the eventual first and second proved too strong for him inside the final furlong and looked set for quite a battle until Idris displayed the superior pace close to home. **PRINCE OF ANDROS (Al Nasr)** attempted to make progress on the front two inside the final quarter before his challenge fizzled out.
