**EDITOR'S NOTE TO JIM DANDY** Belmont S. winner **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) will make his next start in Sunday's GI \$150,000 Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga, said trainer D. Wayne Lukas yesterday. Expected to send his colt to the \$750,000 Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth the same day, trainer D. Wayne Lukas said he elected to pass that spot because the Jim Dandy will give his colt a better prep for the Travers. "This will give him an out over the racetrack," Lukas said. "Both races are a mile and an eighth and, since that's not his best distance, I'd rather take him out over that racetrack and get him ready for the Travers than haul him down to Monmouth." Lukas will also start **Prince of Thieves** (Hansel) in the Jim Dandy in what is looking to be a competitive field. Preakness winner **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) is also expected, as is two-year-old champion **Maria's Mon** (Wavering Monarch).

**MIDWEEK WORK FOR CIGAR** His schedule dependent on a continuation of yesterday's nice weather at Saratoga, **Cigar** (Palace Music) is expected to tune up for the August 10 Pacific Classic at Del Mar with a work over the Saratoga surface this week. "I haven't set any workouts because the weather has been so corny," said trainer Bill Mott after rain plagued the upstate New York track Thursday and Friday. "In an ideal world, with ideal weather, we would look at a work maybe Wednesday, which could move a day in either direction depending on the forecast. I think seven furlongs would suit him just fine. Then, just before he leaves for California (Aug. 8), he'll blow out a little bit."

**PENTIRE PACKS HIS PASSPORT** Racing fans in Britain are unlikely to see Saturday's brilliant King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner **Pentire** (GB) (Be My Guest) on his home soil again. Connections have already discounted the possibility of running their G1 hero in next month's Juddmonte International S. at York and trainer Geoffrey Wragg's feeling is that overseas travel is inevitable from now on. Said the Newmarket-based Wragg, "I imagine Pentire will be retired at the end of the season and it is quite possible he will not run again in this country. The Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, if the going isn't soft at Longchamp, the Breeders' Cup Turf and the Japan Cup are the races we have planned as possibles for him. Travelling will be no problem." The four-year-old has been installed at 6-1 in the betting on the big race in Paris Oct. 8.

Exotic Wood, who suffered her only loss against champion Serena's Song in the Jan. 27 GI Santa Monica H., came into this event off an easy win in a July 3 allowance race at Hollywood. The filly earned her first GI win with this wire-to-wire performance, and her first victory beyond a mile. Bolting out of the gate, she outsprinted HALO AMERICA (Waquoit) for the lead, took a half-length lead down the backstretch and led by just a head at the quarter pole. With her lead diminishing and under pressure on the front end, she found another gear, pulling clear to win through the stretch. "There wasn't a question about the distance for my horse," said winning trainer Ronald Ellis. "It was the amount of speed in the race that worried me. I was worried they would go fast on the lead. But (jockey) Chris (McCarron) knows the filly and knew what to do. He knows how to nurse horses on the lead." Said McCarron, "I did what I was supposed to do--go to the lead and keep her together. They only way I was going to take her back was if she broke slow or couldn't get the lead immediately." Shoop was a fast-closing second, but never threatened the winner. Said rider Shane Sellers, "my filly ran her heart out." Ellis will now point Exotic Wood toward the Sept. 1 Chula Vista at Del Mar.

The German-trained mare Hollywood Dream and jockey John Reid teamed up for their second G1 success of the year when they nipped Richard Quinn on the Paul Cole-trained Posidonas by a short head here. In May, Reid and Hollywood Dream won the G1 Premio Presidente della Republica in Rome. **CABALLO** (GER) (Königsstuhl {Ger}) set the pace in Dusseldorf, but he was soon passed by the German Derby runner-up **SURAKO** (GER) (Königsstuhl {Ger}), who led into the straight and then began to fade. Posidonas took over in front, but both Protektor and Hollywood Dream on the outside were travelling well. In the closing stages Posidonas and Hollywood Dream became engaged in a battle royal, with the German mare just prevailing by the smallest margin.

**LEGEND ON TO EMERALD DOWNS** Larry The Legend (Local Talent) will make his next start in the Longacres Mile August 18 at Emerald Downs if all goes well, according to owner/trainer Craig Lewis. The four-year-old colt finished second in a Del Mar allowance race Saturday, his first start since winning the Santa Anita Derby 16 months ago. Knee chips and two operations kept him out of action since that time, and Lewis admitted to being relieved after Kent Desormeaux told him Larry felt like his old self in Saturday's race. "The nice thing about this horse is that he's cooler than me and Kent put together," said Lewis. "He makes us look good."

**STRIKE THE GOLD CHOSEN AS MATCHMAKER STALLION** The connections of Powder Bowl (Pleasant Colony), who won Wednesday's Gil Vinery Matchmaker S. at Atlantic City Race Course, have chosen Strike The Gold as their 'stallion of choice' for their victory in the event. Runner up **Class Kris** (Kris S.) will be bred to De Niro, while third-place finisher **Turkish Tryst** (Turkoman) will be bred to River Special. All three stallions stand at Vinery, who donated the seasons.

**Royal Applause** (GB) (Waajib), second top-rated juvenile in Europe last year, will attempt to regain his winning ways at Doncaster Wednesday. The Barry Hills-trained colt, unbeaten in four outings during 1995, has been 0-for-2 this season, but his handler is hoping that a drop in class to the Vaux Samson Conditions S. over six furlongs will give his charge a confidence boost before more taxing targets are added to his agenda. Royal Applause began his 1996 campaign in the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket back in May and, obviously unsuited by the mile there, finished down the field to **Mark Of Esteem** (Ire) (Darshaan). He was then stepped down to five furlongs for his only subsequent run in the King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot and could manage only sixth in a considerable improvement on his Classic run.

**Sahm** (Mr Prospector), unbeaten after two runs and already quoted among the favorites for next year's 2000 Guineas, makes his third appearance in this Wednesday's G3 Lanson Champagne Vintage S. at Goodwood. The John Dunlop-trained colt, out of the dual Classic heroine Salsabil, is reported in great form by connections and will be seeking his hat-trick in an event won in 1995 by champion juvenile **Alhaarth** (Ire) (Unfuwain). Two other unbeaten colts will line up against **Sahm--Fun Galore** (Gone West), a winner at both Newbury and Newcastle last month, and **Putra** (Dixie Brass), very impressive when successful in his debut at Sandown six weeks ago.
