**PENTIRE SOLD TO JAPAN** Pentire (GB) (Be My Guest), winner of Saturday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, has been sold to Japan's Shadai Farm and will retire there for next year's covering season. The four-year-old, whose victims over the weekend included both last year's St Leger winner Classic Cliche (Ire) and this season's Epsom Derby hero Shaamit (Ire), will remain with Newmarket-based trainer Geoffrey Wragg for the rest of his racing career. But from his next start onwards he will be carrying the colors of the famous Yoshida family from Japan. John Ferguson, manager of Mollers Racing, the colt's former owner, said, "Nothing will change except the silks until Pentire goes to stud. He will be trained by Geoff and ridden by Michael Hills until he has completed his 1996 campaign. The Japan Cup will, obviously, now take on major importance for the horse. But that has always looked an ideal race for him as the course in Tokyo and the fast ground they usually have will suit him."

### STRONG THISTLEDOWN MEET CONCLUDES

Thistledown in Cleveland, Ohio concluded the second meet of its season Monday as the 45-day Thistledown Meet recorded increases in both average daily handle and average daily attendance. The Thistledown Meet, run exclusively with River Downs as its seven and seven simulcast partner, opened June 1 and ran through yesterday's card. Total attendance for the meet was 187,117 for a daily average of 4,158, up 1.8 percent from last year's 4,085. The total handle for the 1996 Thistledown Meet was \$29,851,296 for a daily average of \$663,362, up 6.2 percent from \$624,784 in 1995. Shirley Girten topped the trainers' standings with 15 victories, and Julio Felix led all jockeys with 35 wins. Michael Friedman and Raymond Fischer captured their first owners title with seven victories from their stable of five horses. Thistledown reopens its gates this Thursday, Aug. 1 for the first day of the 46-day Randall Meet. The Randall Meet runs through Oct. 10 and will feature full-card simulcasting beginning Sept. 19, the first legal day for taking simulcast products in Ohio.
