EQUINE EXPENSE DEDUCTION RETAINED A provision which would have eliminated the Section 179 first-year deduction for horses has been removed from the Small Business Job Protection Act, and the bill is now expected to be passed before the Senate and the House break for their August recess. Not only will horses continue to qualify for the first-year deduction; the bill also increases the deduction from \$17,500 to \$25,000, phased-in over seven years. "It is important that the horse industry keep this tax benefit to support the continued rebound from the economic problems of the 1980s," said James J. Hickey Jr., president of the American Horse Council. "We certainly did not want a tax provision which discriminated against horses versus other business assets from a tax standpoint. This is a significant victory for the industry. It is good to see that we can work together for a common cause and have such an impact on Capital Hill. The many individuals and organizations that worked on this so hard are to be congratulated." Over 20 equine organizations and countless additional individuals contacted more than 100 senators and representatives to explain the importance of the expense deduction to the industry.
