### RECORD OVERSEAS ENTRIES FOR FOSTERS

**MELBOURNE CUP** A record overseas entry of 33 has been received by the Victoria Racing Club for this year's \$1.5 million Fosters Melbourne Cup at Flemington on Tuesday, November 5. They include seven from the United States, 16 from England, five from Ireland, two from Hong Kong, two from Singapore and one from Russia. The American entries are last year's Arlington Million winner **Awad** (Caveat), GISW **Dare And Go** (Alydar), MGISW **Raintrap** (GB) (Rainbow Quest), nine-time Group and Grade One winner **Sandpit** (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}), GSW **Special Price** (Bering {GB}), GSW **Talloires** (Trempolino) and **Windsharp** (Lear Fan), a two-time graded stakes winner over colts this year. The English list is headed by the Godolphin-owned **Classic Cliche** (Ire) (Salse), winner of last year's Doncaster St. Leger and this season's Ascot Gold Cup. The Victoria Racing Club's General Manager of Racing, Les Benton, said, "I would say Classic Cliche is the best stayer in Europe. It would be terrific if he came over. The biggest stumbling block is his owners' wish to see him run in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. If he runs in the Arc, they will only have one day in which to get organized to come to Melbourne, as he has to go into quarantine." Also nominated is the 1993 Melbourne Cup hero **Vintage Crop** (Ire) (Rousillon), who represents Ireland.

Looking for his first win since spending a year on the sidelines, Mahogany Hall came into this event after back-to-back second-place finishes in the Gil Brooklyn H. and Gl Suburban H. The late-running Kentucky-bred profited from the solid early fractions set by the filly **Serena's Song**, settling near the back of the pack for three-quarters before launching his bid from the far outside to race past the pacesetter in the final strides. "We ran him in the Derby (9th in 1994), and he had an ankle problem that took forever," explained winning trainer Jimmy Baker of his charge's extended layoffs. "He then had a chip in his ankle and he also popped a curb last year. We took our time and things came together. It feels real good. We've had a lot of patience with this horse...we gave him time off and it paid off. Nowadays in this business, everybody seems to be in a rush and this shows you what happens if you show patience." Baker added that the Saratoga Cup August 25 could be next. **Serena's Song**, breaking from the far outside, set an honest pace on a clear lead and seemed to have the race in hand before weakening in the final sixteenth. Favored **Peaks And Valleys**, tucked in along the rail behind the runner-up throughout, made a bid for the lead at the top of the stretch but could not threaten the top two. "(Jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard **Serena's Song**) did a good job going into the clubhouse turn and closed my horse off," said trainer Bill Mott. "Going down the backstretch, I was hoping for better position for my horse, but he made a move around the far turn and tried to catch the leader. I'm pleased."

**THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown**

Can **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) be beaten in his own backyard? That question has caused many to skip the much richer Buick Haskell Invitational in favor of the GII \$150,000 Jim Dandy S., but Monmouth's Grade I event still presents an interesting handicapping exercise.

What makes the race interesting is the fact that the Team Lukas team of **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) and **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew) will take a lot of money, and we don't really like either one. Dr. Caton has never run faster than an 8 1/4, and won the Long Branch S. with the advantage of a ground-saving trip. Victory Speech gave every indication of being a top horse this winter, then tailed off before coming back to form with three big efforts, including a figure of 3 1/2, in a 28-day span, but it's hard to believe he can come back again on two weeks rest without bouncing.

**Foolish Pole** (Polish Numbers) is the longshot to watch. The colt ran a big race in the Long Branch; spotting Dr. Caton eight pounds and several lengths of lost ground, he actually earned a higher figure than the winner in that race despite finishing fourth. If he can run back to that effort, he has a big shot at the weights here. **Devil's Honor** (Devil's Bag) is another who tailed off but has improved recently, and another forward move would give him a chance.

**Skip Away** may be one of the most underrated horses in recent years. He has already run two Thoro-Graph figures of 1 3/4--to put that in perspective, Holy Bull didn't run that fast even once until the fall of his three-year-old year. The best of this year's three-year-old crop has had six weeks to recover from a strong performance in the Ohio Derby, which should prevent a bounce. *The Thoro-Graph play is a box with Foolish Pole, Devil's Honor and Skip Away, doubling up with Skip Away on top.
