HELMSMAN OUT OF PACIFIC CLASSIC Helmsman (El Gran Senor) will miss next Saturday's GI Pacific Classic after suffering a pulled muscle in his back. Explained trainer Wally Dollase, "He actually did it some time ago, probably in the (Hollywood) Gold Cup. We gave him some time off; we thought he was okay and we were training him back, but after the workout (July 27), he was sore again." The injury is not considered career-threatening, but the trainer said, "If he's not 110 percent, I don't want to run him. It's very tempting, with the bonus, but I don't want to do that. We'll start lasering him now and really working on it." Helmsman is one of only two horses eligible for the MGM Grand Classic Crown participation bonus for running in all three legs of the series, which totals \$500,000. The other horse eligible for the bonus, **Luthier Fever** (Mt. Livermore), worked five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 yesterday morning.

CIGAR SPECIAL ON ESPN "Cigar's Race to History," a special on the reigning Horse of the Year's quest for his 17th straight victory in the \$1,000,000 Pacific Classic, will be televised on ESPN at 10:00 p.m. EDT this Friday night, August 9. The half-hour presentation, hosted by Tom Durkin and Chris Lincoln, will include footage of Cigar's (Palace Music) races and interviews with his connections, and a preview of the Pacific Classic field. The race will be televised on ESPN Saturday, August 10, at 6:00 p.m. EDT.

CECIL AND ALLAN SPLIT Ten-time British champion trainer Henry Cecil and leading Far East-based owner Ivan Allan have ended their long and successful association. No public reasons have been revealed concerning the split. But Cecil has confirmed that one-time Epsom Derby hope **Clever Cliche** (GB) (Danahill)--the colt was supplemented for the Classic but did not run because of firm ground--and a two-year-old son of Kris (GB) have both left his Newmarket stable. He added that he does "not expect to be receiving any more horses" from Allan, who is not only a Thoroughbred owner in Britain but has also trained successfully in his own name in both Hong Kong and Singapore. Allan posted a British Classic win in 1984 when Commanche Run--trained by Luca Cumani--collected the St. Leger at Doncaster. He currently has horses in training in England with Peter Chapple-Hyam.

Skip Away proved once again to be the classiest and most consistent performer among this year's crop of three-year-olds with yet another sterling effort. The steel grey was bet down to 3-5 after taking the GII Ohio Derby last time out and running a gutsy second in the GI Belmont Stakes two starts back. Typically a free-runner, the crowd's choice was this time throttled back as Dr. Caton set a lively pace, pressed hard by stablemate and Ohio Derby second Victory Speech, but he drove up to challenge on the far turn and would not be denied despite a gallant effort by the runner-up. "I was anxious the whole race," revealed trainer Sonny Hine, who also won the 1985 Haskell with Skip Away's sire, Skip Trial, and the 1992 edition with Technology. "We were laying fourth or fifth at one time, but the horse really came through. This is the best horse I've ever trained. Maybe he's not getting all the accolades he deserves. But who are they going to make the three-year-old champion if not us?" The winner now heads for the Travers August 24, as does Dr. Caton. "He ran a great race--you can't ask for more," said Mike Maker, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "It sure looks like the Travers would be next. We're not going to back away from anyone, that's for sure." A total of 31,455 fans were on hand at Monmouth--the second largest crowd in 25 years.

Preakness winner Louis Quatorze was making his first start since finishing fourth in the June 8 Belmont S. The colt stalked pacesetter Will's Way to the quarter pole and was hard driven to get by that rival in deep stretch. "There were tense moments in the stretch," admitted winning trainer Nick Zito. "But I think he has proved he is the best three-year-old." Belmont champ EDITOR'S NOTE (Forty Niner) was forced to race wide after an awkward beginning and finished fourth. "Those two (Louis Quatorze and Will's Way) kind of got away on the lead," explained D. Wayne Lukas. "Going three quarters in 1:11 over this track--you're not going to run them down." Louis Quatorze, Will's Way and Editor's Note will now be pointed toward a rematch in the Aug. 24. Travers. Last year's two-year-old champ MARIA'S MON (Wavering Monarch), making his second start of the year, raced in contention for six furlongs but faded badly in the stretch. "It looked like he just quit running," said trainer Rick Schosberg. "Maybe he bled. It looked like he pulled up perfectly sound. He's a better horse than that."

Fastness (Ire) is now four-for-four since running second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile, and hasn't finished worse than second in eight starts over the last two years. Bet down to 2-5 here, the talented grey sat third for three-quarters, moved to take the lead on the far turn, then had to dig down deep in the drive to hold off the late charge of Smooth Runner. "When I asked him to fire on the turn, he gave it to me," said winning jockey Corey Nakatani, who was picking up his second Grade I win of the weekend after guiding Matiara to victory in the GI Ramona H. Saturday. "He was all out at the finish--he was packing a lot of weight. He worked hard and was fully extended to earn this today." Added jockey Chris McCarron on the runner-up, "I gave Corey a scare. I was riding, riding, riding--and hoping. He gave it a good shot."

PRESENTING TARGETED FOR NEWBURY Presenting (GB) (Mtoto {GB}), third in last in year's Epsom Derby, is expected to make his belated reappearance for 1996 in Newbury's G2 Geoffrey Freer S. August 17. The four-year-old colt sustained an injury when flown over to Canada for the Rothmans International at Woodbine last October and has not been seen on the racecourse since. But trainer John Gosden has been steadily nursing him back to full fitness and is aiming for the 13-furlong event he won almost a year ago. Gosden said: "The Geoffrey Freer is the race we have had in mind for him and it is currently his intended target. We will see how he gets on there before we look any further. We are taking it one step at a time." Plans remain more fluid for the Gosden-trained **Tamure (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), just ahead of his stable companion when second at Epsom last June. The handler added: "He needs genuinely good ground. So if we have a traditional autumn--something we don't seem to have had for the past couple of years--he'd have a back-end campaign. There is the possibility he could go for the Breeders' Cup Turf; he did pretty well when fourth in it last year. But the weather has not been very helpful to him this summer."
