DARE AND GO STOPS CIGAR Some records are made to be broken, but the great **Cigar** (Palace Music) will forever find himself on even terms in the history books with the hero of a half-century ago, **Citation** (Bull Lea). Cigar's attempt to break Citation's mark of 16 straight U.S. victories was foiled when 39-1 **Dare And Go** (Alydar) astounded a Del Mar crowd 40,000 strong, sweeping past the 1-10 favorite at the head of the stretch and powering his way to the wire as Jerry Bailey conceded victory in the GI Pacific Classic with a half-hearted wave of his whip; Cigar had given all he had, but yesterday, it was not enough. Double-teamed by the Richard Mandella-trained duo of Dare And Go and the pacesetting **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}), the brave-hearted bay broke cleanly and found himself off the flank of the front-runner; with jockey Corey Nakatani and **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold) just outside of him, Bailey opted to press the pace rather than take back and get caught in a switch. But hell-fire fractions of 1:09 1/5 and 1:33 3/5 left Cigar smoldering, and, after putting Siphon away on the far turn, he held the lead only briefly. When Dare And Go asked the question at the top of the stretch, he had no answer. "I knew it before we hit the quarter pole," said Bailey. "I could hear (Dare And Go) coming, and I didn't have a lot of horse left. I didn't think it was a killer pace, but when we got to the three-eighths pole, I knew if somebody was going to come at me I was going to be in trouble today." Bill Mott observed, "I knew when they went in :45 and change for the half, it was too fast. I think it was the horse lapped on the outside of us that forced the issue and that was probably the deciding factor. The streak is over but there are more races to be won. I think Cigar has made some new friends for racing today." On this day, Cigar was second-best, with the rest of the field strung out behind him like the tail of a kite, all the way back to **Tinners Way** (Secretariat), who was eased in his bid for a third consecutive victory in the \$1,000,000 event. "He took a bad step somewhere and he wasn't putting out," said jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "He wasn't extending himself. It was in his left front. I pulled him up--I didn't want him to really hurt himself. I don't know how bad it is. He just wasn't right."

He is certainly no slouch, but even those watching who believed Cigar could be beaten did not expect Dare And Go to be the spoiler. Scorned at the windows as a rank 39-1 outsider despite finishing on the board in 17 of his 19 career starts, the consistent Kentucky-bred had shown flashes when winning the GI Strub S. last year and was coming off a strong second-place finish in the GII Bel Air H. July 14. Usually up with the pace early, the bay this time let stablemate Siphon (Brz) lead the way as he sat uncharacteristically far back in fourth. But after Siphon softened up Cigar and faded to third, Dare And Go came flying on the far outside and ran past the favorite without a fight, drawing away with authority in the final eighth. "This horse has always shown great talent--it's just been a little hard to get it out of him," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He had problems with soundness earlier this year, but it has all worked out for the best." As for his two-pronged attack, Mandella said, "I knew someone would go after Siphon, but I was a little surprised it was Cigar. I knew whoever it was would get softened up themselves. I told (Alex Solis, aboard Dare And Go) to get him to relax as much as he could and let someone else go after Siphon early." The top two will meet again on neutral ground; both will point to the Breeders' Cup Classic at Woodbine October 26.

DICK DUCHOSSOIS NAMED COBRA GOLF/TDN SUBSCRIBER OF THE MONTH FOR JULY

Dick Duchossois, the Chairman of Arlington International Racecourse, has been named July's Cobra Golf/*Thoroughbred Daily News* Subscriber of the Month after showcasing the best racing has to offer with the Arlington Citation Challenge July 13. Duchossois put together an event which set the stage for Cigar's 16th straight victory as the six-year-old tied Citation's U.S. record for most consecutive victories; he also drew international television coverage and nearly 35,000 fans to the track. "I'm very flattered, very honored," said Duchossois. "Through the grace and good sportsmanship of Allen Paulson sharing his horse with us, we were able to reach a lot of people who drifted back into Thoroughbred racing with this event, and we also had the potential to expose the sport to new fans with world-wide t.v. coverage. I don't deserve this award--it should go to the whole Arlington team and to our horsemen. We work very closely with our horsemen--it took us a long time to understand that by doing things together, we can get them done." Duchossois will receive a set of King Cobra Golf Clubs, the country's leading oversize irons and woods.

HALL OF FAMER TOMMY KELLY

HOSPITALIZED Trainer Tommy Kelly, who was elected to racing's Hall of Fame in 1993, suffered a heart attack Friday night after attending this year's Hall of Fame ball in Saratoga Springs. He is currently listed in serious but stable condition in the intensive care unit at Saratoga Hospital. The 76-year-old horseman, who saddled his first winner in 1945, conditioned 1980's champion sprinter Plugged Nickle as well as the top runners Droll Role, Globemaster, Misty Gallore and Noble Dancer II. Three of his sons, Patrick, Larry and Timmy, have followed in their father's footsteps and are also trainers.

PIKE PLACE DANCER OUT FOR THE YEAR

According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, top three-year-old filly **Pike Place Dancer** (Seattle Dancer), winner of the GI Kentucky Oaks on the dirt and the GIII California Derby on the turf over colts, will miss the rest of the season due to a severely bruised foot. Trainer and co-owner Jerry Hollendorfer told the *Form*, "She's going to be out for about three months. It's not a serious injury, but it will take time to heal."

PURSE INCREASE AT MONMOUTH

Monmouth Park has announced a second 5 percent across-the-board purse increase, effective for the track's final condition book which begins Tuesday and continues through Labor Day, Monday, September 2. On-track attendance at the Jersey oval is currently up 4 percent over last year, while total handle is up 7 percent. The first purse increase went into effect July 27, and the track now offers a daily purse distribution of \$250,000.

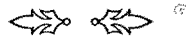

Frances in the Sky won at first asking at Churchill June 23, but finished second last time out July 18 after dueling for the lead. The filly was off a step slowly and allowed to settle in the early going. "The plan was to let her rate today and since she broke a step slow, I didn't hustle her," said winning jockey Mike Luzzi. "She took off on her own and should only get better with distance."
