SWINBURN RIDES COMEBACK WINNER Jockey Walter Swinburn, out of action for over six months following a fall in Hong Kong in February, won on his comeback ride at Windsor Monday afternoon. The three-time Epsom Derby hero had suffered serious injuries to his head, lungs, ribs and shoulder when his mount swerved into a rail at Sha Tin Racecourse in February. But Swinburn showed all his old verve to force **Talathath (Fr)** (Soviet Star) into the lead inside the final furlong of the one-mile Royal Bank Of Scotland H. and keep him going well for a 1½-length victory. Swinburn, who celebrated his 35th birthday last week, said, "I cannot believe it. I came here expecting just to take a couple of rides. So to do this is quite amazing--really something else--and it probably won't sink in until I get home tonight."

JOCKEY CLUB ROUND TABLE INTRODUCES "REMOTE REGISTRATION" The Jockey Club held its 44th annual Round Table Conference in Saratoga Springs Sunday, and one of the innovations announced was an interactive Registration system which will allow Thoroughbred owners and breeders to register their horses through the use of their personal computers. Explaining the system, Nick Nicholson, Executive Vice President/Executive Director of The Jockey Club, said, "This new method of registration will, in effect, let owners and breeders talk directly to our database and thus complete many of the Registration requirements in real time...24 hours a day, 365 days a year, this will be true interactivity." After logging onto the system, horsemen will have a choice of live foal applications, name applications, imports, exports and transfer of ownership, among others, and the computer will guide the user through the process of filling out the paperwork. Live Foal registrations will be confirmed immediately, while Name Claims will be okayed within 24 hours. "In the next few weeks, the system will move to beta test, operating in real conditions in a few locations," said Nicholson. "The Live Foal Report system will be in full operation for next year's crop. And, by this time next year, we hope that all will have a chance to experience this new evolution of Jockey Club 'paperwork'."

Storm Song broke her maiden in impressive fashion at Keeneland in April, then was off until resurfacing to finish fourth over a sloppy track against Saratoga allowance foes August 1. Making her stakes debut here, the Dogwood colorbearer raced in close contention early, launched a six-wide sweep at the top of the stretch and dashed away from the field to win easily. "Last time she didn't handle the racetrack," said winning jockey Pat Day. "But she has been training very well since her last race. Once she got by horses at the eighth pole, she started waiting...I tapped her on the shoulder and she responded. I knew she had something left." Trainer Nick Zito said the filly would be pointed for the GI Spinaway August 30. The 2-1 favorite CITY COLLEGE (Carson City) set the pace briefly before fading to finish eighth. "She just came up empty," said jockey Jerry Bailey.

Ta Rib (Mr. Prospector), heroine of this year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulches, will head the field for Friday's G3 Hungerford S. The Ed Dunlop-trainee, runner-up on her most recent outing in Newmarket's G2 Falmouth S., is reported in top form by connections, but a spokesman for Dunlop's yard explained Monday that the handler is hoping for dry weather this week. "Ta Rib ran on soft ground at Ascot last season and we didn't think it suited her," he said. "But the plan is to run her and, if the forecast is right, the going should be fine. We are optimistic at this stage." Opposition to the French Classic winner is likely to include **Green Perfume** (Nae-vus), twice a winner in the past month; **Mistle Cat** (Storm Cat), sixth in the Goodwood's G1 Sussex S.; and **Thrilling Day (GB)** (Groom Dancer), successful in her latest, a listed race over Friday's seven-furlong distance.

DELAWARE AND SPORTSMAN'S REJOIN TRA

The Thoroughbred Racing Associations yesterday announced that Delaware Park and Sportsman's Park have rejoined the national racetrack association. Sportsman's, which originally became a member in 1981, had resigned at the beginning of 1995; Delaware was a member from 1942-82 under the ownership of the DuPont family, and again from 1985-1992 under the direction of current owner William M. Rickman. The two tracks are the fourth and fifth to be added to the TRA roster since November, following Beulah Park and Oaklawn Park, who rejoined the organization, and the newest member, Prairie Meadows Racetrack and Casino.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.
