**TINNERS WAY RETIRED TO VINERY** *Tinners Way* (Secretariat), winner of the \$1 million Pacific Classic in 1994 and 1995, was pulled up on the final turn of last Saturday's renewal of the Grade I event. Trainer Bobby Frankel told the *Daily Racing Form* that X-rays of *Tinners Way's* legs taken after the Pacific Classic were negative, but that the horse's retirement, originally scheduled for the end of this year, had been moved up. The six-year-old chestnut will stand at stud at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky. "He had some filling in a tendon, like he had a broken blood vessel," Frankel told the *Form*. *Tinners Way* won seven of 27 starts for earnings of \$1,849,452. Along with his pair of Pacific Classic victories, he also won the GI Californian S. in 1996 and finished second in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in 1995. He also won a pair of listed stakes in England in 1993.

**ECONOMIC IMPACT STUDY UNDERWAY** At the 1996 Jockey Club Round Table Conference, held Sunday in Saratoga Springs, New York, Michael Vlaisavljevich, the director of fiscal policy analysis for Barents Group, gave an update on the progress of a comprehensive equine economic impact study that is being conducted by his firm. Vlaisavljevich said about the study, "Over 31,000 surveys were sent (to owners and service providers) and approximately 5,000 surveys have been returned and are being processed. In addition to that survey, the second very important survey is of race tracks and off-track betting corporations. In this case, the questionnaire was sent to all 187 racetracks and OTB corporations in the U.S. Approximately 70 surveys have been returned, representing over 70 percent of national handle. And again, we're about halfway through the study. The first phase was collecting the necessary data. We're now in the process of editing and cleaning the data to create the database." At its completion, one of the uses of the study will be to make the voice of the Thoroughbred industry heard in the political arena. American Horse Council Chairman Will Farish said, "Others have accurate economic impact statistics and so must we, in order to receive any effective audience in Washington." The study is expected to be completed this fall.

**MOONLIGHT PARADISE SOLD** Sheikh Mohammed has purchased G3 Princess Margaret S. runner-up **Moonlight Paradise** (Irish River {Fr}) from her former owner Sir Eric Parker, according to a report in yesterday's issue of *The Sporting Life*. The reported price for the two-year-old filly was £500,000, or \$778,210 U.S. She had been previously sold for \$21,000 as a yearling at the 1995 Keeneland January Sale as part of the Allen Paulson (a major reduction) consignment. Moonlight Paradise has raced only three times to date, winning a maiden event at Goodwood June 14 and the listed Empress S. at Newmarket June 29 before finishing second in her most recent effort, the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 27. The Kentucky-bred filly retains an entry in the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 22.

**DUELING GROUNDS ANNOUNCES STAKES**

**SCHEDULE** Officials at Dueling Grounds Race Course yesterday released the track's 1996 stakes schedule. Dubbed the "1996 Fall Turf Festival," racing at the Franklin, Kentucky grass track begins Sunday, Sept. 8 and continues each Sunday, Monday and Tuesday through Sept. 24. Total purses for the 1996 Dueling Grounds meet will top \$2 million, including the \$745,000 stakes schedule; a daily average of \$250,000 in purse monies will be distributed. The \$125,000 Sanford Duncan S. for three-year-olds and up going a mile is the opening day feature. Other stakes include the \$125,000 Dueling Grounds Derby for three-year-olds Sept. 15; the \$125,000 Rachel Jackson S. for fillies and mares Sept. 22; and the GIII \$250,000 Sam Houston S. for ages three and up at 1½ miles Sept. 22.

**VICE REGENT COLT TOPS CANADIAN SALE**

The Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society, British Columbia Division, held its 1996 Summer Yearling Sale August 11. There were 97 yearlings sold for a gross of \$1,213,500 Canadian (\$882,931 U.S.) and an average of \$12,510 Canadian (\$9,102 U.S.). Twenty nine yearlings were reported as not sold. The sales topper was a dark bay colt by Vice Regent--Julia Jane (Mr. Prospector). The colt, consigned by Salishan Meadows, agent for Tod Mtn Thoroughbreds, was purchased by K. Hart for \$82,000 Canadian (\$59,662 U.S.).

John Durkan will commence training next year from one of Newmarket's most historic yards. Together with his wife Carol, he has agreed to terms to purchase Green Lodge Stables from Tom Jones, who has announced he will retire at the end of Britain's current flat season. Jones sent out many exceptional winners from Green Lodge, including **Touching Wood** (Roberto) and **Devon Ditty (GB)** (Song {GB}). Durkan, 30, has spent the past three seasons as assistant to trainer John Gosden.

**Sil Sila (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), successful in this year's G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly, will race next in the G1 Aston Upthorpe Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 21. Bryan Smart's stable star had her final piece of serious work in Lambourn at 6:30 a.m. yesterday. "She's not normally a great worker at home," Smart said. "But she really did go fantastically well. Ray (jockey Ray Cochrane) was bubbling and I honestly think it was the best gallop she has ever done."
