ARLINGTON CUTS PURSES Stakes and overnight purses at Arlington International Racecourse will be slashed 20 percent effective Saturday. The substantial cut was announced Wednesday, one day after the Illinois Racing Board turned down the track's request for a reduction in the racing week from six to five days. Overnight handicaps will be reduced from \$30,000 to \$25,000 and overnight stakes from \$35,000 to \$30,000. In addition, purses from four races on the stakes schedule will be reduced. The William Hale Bishop for Illinois-breds Sept. 1 will go from \$75,000 to \$50,000; the Gill Arlington Matron H. Sept. 7 will go from \$150,000 to \$125,000; the Gill Swoon's Son H. Sept. 15 will be decreased from \$100,000 to \$75,000; and the Anita Peabody H. for Illinois-breds Sept. 1 will be reduced from \$75,000 to \$50,000. Arlington's current daily purses of \$197,997 are already down 26.33 percent from last year, when Illinois introduced the five-day race week as an experiment. The proposal to bring back the five-day schedule won the support of the Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, but the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association was in opposition because of a projected loss of between \$200,000 and \$300,000 in simulcast revenue at Sportsman's Park and Balmoral Park.

GULFSTREAM PLANS RACING IMPROVEMENTS

Gulfstream Park has established new measures designed to further enhance the quality of racing during its 1997 meeting, January 3-March 16, Douglas Donn, track president and chief executive officer, announced yesterday. The new measures include offering a Florida record total projected purse distribution of over \$20 million. The increase of approximately 10 percent from last season comes from a new revenue-sharing plan with horsemen that will place half of the reduction in state taxes into purses and from Gulfstream's aggressive marketing of its new incoming full-card simulcasting program and its on-track product. The track will also raise the minimum stakes purse to \$75,000 and institute a 48-hour entry system with no scratch time for virtually all races. A claiming rule change will make it mandatory to race claimed horses at their claimed price or higher for no less than 30 days after being claimed. "The purse increases should produce even better quality competition," commented Gulfstream's Director of Racing Robert D. Umphrey.

All Chatter, who broke his maiden by 3 1/2-lengths at Saratoga in his last outing Aug. 3, had posted a bullet workout since that score, drilling three furlongs in :35 2/5 at Saratoga Monday. Sent off the fourth choice in this 10-horse field, the dark bay took command at the onset, blazed on the front end through fractions of :21 4/5, :45 and 1:09 3/5 and held on for his first stakes victory. "This horse has a lot of speed," said winning jockey Jorge Chavez. "That doesn't hurt you in a race like this, especially when he broke well from the gate. When I asked him to run in the stretch, he responded well." All Chatter's trainer Stanley Hough added, "I'm not sure if we are going to come back into the Hopeful (at Saratoga Aug. 31). He has already run twice here. Most likely, we're not going (into the Hopeful). I'll wait to get back to New York to decide what to do with him next." The 7-2 favorite SPY INTRIGUE (Forty Niner), who defeated All Chatter by more than five lengths when breaking his maiden at Belmont July 18, rushed up to vie for the lead after breaking slowly, then gave way on the turn to be eighth.

KING'S THEATRE RETIRED King's Theatre (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) has been retired, according to a story in yesterday's *Racing Post*. The five-year-old won two Group 1 events in England--the Racing Post Trophy S. in 1993 and the King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. in 1994. The bay was sent to trainer Bill Mott in the U.S. as a four-year-old but failed to win in five stateside starts. He did post a third-place finish in the G1 Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga last July. Overall, King's Theatre won five of 19 starts for earnings of over \$1.1 million. In his final career start in Italy, he finished third in a four-horse field in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano. "After his last run in Italy, we took the view that it would be in the best interests of the horse to retire him," said Simon Crisford, racing manager to Godolphin, which owns the horse.

DEL MAR YEARLING SALE RESULTS Here and Now, a chestnut filly by Green Forest--All Present (Tom Rolfe), brought a final bid of \$50,000 to top the California Thoroughbred Sales 1996 Del Mar Select and Preferred Yearling Sale, held Monday and Tuesday. Consigned by Havens Bloodstock Agency Inc., agent for Mr. and Mrs. Van Rose, the filly was purchased by The Thoroughbred Corp. The second and third highest-priced yearlings at the sale were both from the first crop by \$1.8 million earner **Flying Continental** (Flying Paster). A chestnut colt out of the mare Petite Maid was sold by Yearsley Bloodstock, agent for \$47,000 to Wallace A. Dollase, and a bay filly out of Thoughtful Queen, also consigned by Yearsley Bloodstock, agent, was purchased by Jack L. Finley for \$40,000.

LONE STAR PARK TO HOST TTBA SALE

FUTURITIES In a major development for Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie's inaugural Thoroughbred meet, track Vice President and General Manager Corey Johnson has announced that Lone Star will be the host track for both \$250,000 divisions of the Texas Thoroughbred Association Sale Futurities in June, 1997. The TTBA Sale Futurities include a division for colts and geldings and another for fillies. Horses become eligible for nomination to the TTBA Sale Futurity by selling in one of the public auction sales sponsored by the TTBA. "The addition of Lone Star Park to our TTBA sales and racing program should increase the value of the horses offered in our sales," said Jeff Hooper, executive director of the 3,500-member TTBA. "With 562 yearlings catalogued, our sale next week looks to be the deepest and strongest we have ever offered." The 1996 TTBA Summer Yearling Sale will be held Aug. 19 and 20 at Will Rogers Equestrian Center in Ft. Worth, Texas.

TINNERS WAY STUD FEE SET Tinners Way (Secretariat), retired following a minor injury sustained in last Saturday's G1 Pacific Classic, will be sent from trainer Bobby Frankel's Hollywood Park barn to Juddmonte Farm near Lexington, Kentucky to be let down as soon as shipping arrangements can be finalized. About a week later he is due to arrive at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky, where he will enter stud in 1997 for a fee of \$5,000 live foal.

Judge Lenore Nesbitt has denied motions of dismissal filed by seven off-track betting outlets and tracks in the lawsuit filed by the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association against them. In the lawsuit, the FHBPA alleges that Hialeah and 75 casinos, racetracks and OTBs unlawfully accepted approximately \$11 million in interstate off-track wagers placed on races conducted during Hialeah's Spring 1995 racing season.

Local News, Monmouth Park:

Jockey Herb McCauley was released Wednesday from Monmouth Medical Center in Long Branch, New Jersey. The veteran rider was hospitalized Monday and Tuesday with pneumonia. "Herb had viral pneumonia and is on antibiotics," said his agent Michelle Barsotti. "He had 104 degree temperature. Herb won't be able to race until Tuesday."

Local News, Maryland:

Neena Ewing, a photographer whose work appeared in the *Maryland Horse*, *Mid-Atlantic Thoroughbred*, *Chronicle of the Horse* and *Spur*, died suddenly Saturday at St. Joseph's Medical Center in Baltimore. She was 45. Ewing, who lived in Monkton, Maryland, also published work under her maiden name, Neena Tolley. She worked as a professional photographer for 25 years, specializing in cross-country racing, conformation shots and children's photographs. Also a respected horse-woman, she had worked as a groom and exercise rider at Maryland tracks. She is survived by her husband Michael, daughters Tolley, Alexandra, and Isabelle, her parents and sister. In lieu of flowers, the family requests that donations be sent to Goucher College in Towson, Maryland, of which Ewing was a graduate.

Local News, Pimlico:

Jockey Mario Pino rode his 3,500th career winner in Wednesday's sixth race at Pimlico. Pino, a 34-year-old native of Wilmington, Delaware, is considered to be the winningest jockey in Maryland racing history. Pino began riding in 1979 and his win on two-year-old **Stormy Cloud** (Smarten) yesterday ranks him about 50th on the all-time list of winning jockeys in North America. After the winning ride, Pino said, "I'm just happy to be here to win that many."
