NORTHERN SPUR TO STAND AT LONGFIELD

FARM Charles Cella's Northern Spur (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), last year's Eclipse Award-winning turf male, will enter stud in 1997 at Longfield Farm in Goshen, Kentucky. "He'll arrive here probably within the next seven to 10 days," said Allan Lavin Jr., Longfield's general manager. "We'll announce his stud fee in the fall. He's our first major stallion. We've stood stallions before, but not any Breeders' Cup winners or champions." Five-year-old Northern Spur, retired following his third-place finish in the GI Caesars International June 22, closed out his 1995 campaign with a pair of Grade I victories in the Oak Tree Invitational at Santa Anita and the Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont. He also won a pair of Group events in France at age three--the G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay and the G3 Prix du Lys. Overall, Northern Spur won six of 15 starts and finished in the money 13 times for earnings of \$1,614,955.

EUROPEANS VIE FOR ARLINGTON STAKES

Two separate equine flights arriving from Europe early next week in Chicago assure that the 1996 International Festival of Racing at Arlington International Racecourse will be world-class in scope. Six of those European-based horses are pointing to the 16th running of the Arlington Million Aug. 25. They are **Parfait Glace (Fr)** (Pampabird {Ire}), **Needle Gun (Ire)** (Sure Blade), **Prince of Andros (Al Nasr {Fr})**, **Glory of Dancer (GB)** (Shareef Dancer), **Valanour (Ire)** (Lomond) and **Definite Article (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}). Four turf specialists whose previous starts were in Europe have won the Arlington Million, but that feat has not been accomplished since Dear Doctor came off a race in Germany to win the 1992 Arlington Million. Five of the European shippers are pointing to the GI \$500,000 Secretariat S. for three-year-olds Aug. 25. They are **His Excellence (El Gran Senor)**, **Bahamian Knight (Ascot Knight)**, **Regal Archive (GB)** (Fairy King), **Pro Trader (Lyphard)** and **Dancing Fred (Fred Astaire)**. Two fillies--**Khalisa (Ire)** (Persian Bold {Ire}) and **Timarida (Ire)** (Kalaglow {Ire})--will be flying in to contest the ninth running of the GI \$500,000 Beverly D. Aug. 24. Only one distaffer whose previous start was in Europe--Hatoof in 1994--has ever won the Beverly D. No horse whose previous start was in Europe has ever won the Secretariat.

Irish 2000 Guineas hero Spinning World bounced back to his best form after a disappointing effort in the St. James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot. The colt, owned and bred by the race-sponsoring Niarchos Family, raced in mid-field for the first six furlongs. He took the lead with just over a furlong left to race and battled back when challenged late by Vetheuil and Shaanxi. Alan Cooper, racing manager to the Niarchos family said, "(Trainer) Jonathon Pease did a great job to bring the horse back so well after Ascot. In retrospect, we perhaps shouldn't have run him there, as he was probably over the top. But he's had two months rest and has come back as a fresh horse and showed his true ability here. The Prix du Moulin at Longchamp on Sept. 8 is his next target. We'll probably miss the Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot and aim for the Breeders' Cup Mile."

The colt joined German runner Zero Problemo on the lead with a furlong to run and had just enough reserves left to hold off the very strong late challenge of the Andre Fabre-trained Android. Winning jockey Michael Hills said, "Sasuru had not run since mid-June at York as he had had a problem with a hind leg. I sent him into the lead at the top of the straight because I had to, as there was no pace. I was lucky that he just lasted out to the finish."

PRESENTING RETIRED George Strawbridge's **Presenting (GB)** (Mtoto {GB}), third to Lammtarra in the 1995 Epsom Derby, has been retired, according to a story in yesterday's *Racing Post*. The four-year-old colt, whose retirement is due to a tendon injury, won six of 10 starts for earnings of \$340,264. His four stakes victories included the G2 Tripleprint Geoffrey Freer S. and the G3 Westminster Taxi Ins. Gordon S., both in 1995. In his final career start, he finished 14th in the G1 Rothmans International at Woodbine last Oct. 15. "He first picked up the injury at Woodbine, after which we gave him time off," trainer John Gosden told the *Racing Post*. "We've been steadily bringing him back and increasing the tempo, but sadly, after his last bit of work, the tendon didn't stand up."

PLEASANT TAP COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON TWO-YEAR-OLD SALE **Pleasant Pope**, a bay colt by Pleasant Tap--Calltheminstrel (The Minstrel), topped Fasig-Tipton New York's Saratoga Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, held Wednesday night in Saratoga Springs. Consigned by Wavertree Stables, agent for Desmond Castle Farm Inc., the colt was purchased by Paraneck Stable for \$125,000. Overall, 34 juveniles were sold Wednesday for a gross of \$878,200 and an average of \$25,829, down 17.4 percent from last year's average of \$31,284. There were 14 two-year-olds reported as not sold.

TRF DOG SHOW SET FOR AUGUST 20 The annual Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation dog show will be held Tuesday, August 20 at 12:30 p.m. in the paddock at Saratoga Race Course. Benefiting the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation in Walkill, New York, which provides homes for retired racehorses with no other options, the dog show will feature the Olympics as this year's theme. Up to 90 dog owners are expected to outfit their charges as everyone from Kerri Strug to Carl Lewis. The prizes, which will be awarded in a number of best-costume categories, will be distributed in Calvin Klein shopping bags, donated by Thoroughbred owner Barry Schwartz. Among last year's winners was trainer Jonathan Sheppard, who staged a preview of the Julie Krone--Matt Muzikar wedding with his six dogs. The defection of Virginia Kraft Payson's Irish-bred leaves **Rowdy Irishman** (Erins Isle {Ire}), seventh to Cheering News in the A.P. Smithwick S. at Saratoga Aug. 1, the highweight in the New York Turf Writers Cup at 158 pounds. Cheering News has won all four of his starts over hurdles this year.

GI Whitney H. winner **Mahogany Hall** (Woodman) will make his next start in the Saratoga Cup August 25, stretching out to a mile and a quarter for the race. "He'll have no problem getting the distance," said trainer Jimmy Baker. "He can run all day if he wants to."

Last year's Arlington Million winner **Awad** (Caveat) worked five furlongs in 1:00.96 yesterday morning; he will ship to Chicago next Thursday to defend his title in the big event, set for August 25.
