DEAUVILLE YEARLING SALE STARTS TODAY

A total of 509 yearlings will be offered during the six days of the 1996 Deauville Yearling Sale, set for August 17-22. Stallions from England, France, Germany, Ireland and the United States will be represented, including A.P. Indy, Alleged, Caerleon, Danehill, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Hansel, Miswaki, Nureyev, Phone Trick, Red Ransom and Sadler's Wells. Freshman sire Exit To Nowhere leads the list with 36 yearlings. Top prospects this year include a half-brother to 1995 Irish Derby winner Winged Love by Arazi, a half-brother to G1 winner Marchand de Sable by A.P. Indy, and a half-sister to MG1SW and top European freshman sire Kendor by Last Tycoon (Ire). Bidding begins at 6:00 p.m. (local time) today. A large international crowd of potential buyers is already on the sales grounds, including the Maktoum family, the Yoshida family, Coolmore's John Magnier and Michael Tabor, as well as several top trainers from Hong Kong. Last year, 415 yearlings sold for an average of \$46,420.

WOODBINE WINS LUKAS ENDORSEMENT After a spate of published reports portraying D. Wayne Lukas as anti-Canadian, the trainer finally made his first visit to the Toronto racetrack and gave the thumbs-up to the host of this year's Breeders' Cup. Lukas had run only one horse at Woodbine during his career, one which he did not saddle himself, and had never been to the track before speaking at yesterday's inductions into the Canadian Racing Hall of Fame. "I think we're going to have one hell of a Breeders' Cup on October 26, and I think you guys have everything in order to have one of the best ones in a long time," said Lukas to the gathering at Woodbine Friday. Complimenting the facility with special praise for the expansive turf course, Lukas said, "I was pleasantly surprised--it's excellent." The horseman, who has already won 12 Breeders' Cup races, enjoyed a warm welcome from Canadian racing fans, saying, "I had a lot of older ladies come up and squeeze my hand--that's not too bad," but he still had reservations about the weather north of the border. "I've only been in Canada 12 hours and I have caught a cold already," he laughed. "I haven't had a cold in five or six years, but I've caught a dandy." Lukas will be back at Woodbine Sept. 15, bringing Belmont S. winner **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) for the Woodbine Million; stablemate **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) is possible for that race. Volochine (Ire), a listed stakes winner in France, had hit the board in two graded stakes in North America, running third in the GI Rothmans International in 1994 and the GII Arlington H. upon a return trip 12 days ago. Shortening up an eighth after that 10-furlong effort, the well-travelled five-year-old, who has also raced in Dubai and Hong Kong, was bumped on the first turn and settled at the back of the pack through moderate early fractions, then launched his bid from the far outside as they headed into the final bend and just got up to edge even-money Green Means Go on the wire. "I was delighted with the victory," said trainer Niall O'Callaghan. "It's a phenomenal experience. Going into the first turn, he was bumped around and he was giving it back. He's been around the world in races where he was being pushed and bumped around--he's used to it. He's a tough horse." O'Callaghan said he would look at the GIII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. September 7 for the winner's next start.

ST. JOVITE SIRE'S FIRST WINNER Freshman sire **St. Jovite** (Pleasant Colony) sired the first winner from his first crop yesterday at Newbury, England, when two-year-old filly **Catechism** won the Sparsholt Maiden Fillies S. over six furlongs on the turf. Bred by Oak Cliff Thoroughbred Bloodstock, the filly was sold at the 1995 Keeneland September Sale for \$45,000. The 1992 European Horse of the Year, **St. Jovite** stands at Payson Stud in Lexington, Kentucky.

BLUE DUSTER SET FOR DONCASTER Last year's European champion juvenile filly **Blue Duster** (Danzig), who lost her unbeaten record when finishing only fifth behind France's star sprinter **Anabaa** in last Sunday's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville, will attempt to regain her winning ways in the Kyoto Sceptre S. at Doncaster September 12. Trainer David Loder named that seven-furlong Listed test as the Sheikh Mohammed-owned filly's next intended target yesterday, saying, "I was very disappointed by her run in France and still do not really have an answer for it. But she came out of the race well--better than she did from her previous (winning) run at Yarmouth--so we have decided to go back to basics and aim her for Doncaster."

The David Loder trainee already had two Listed successes to his credit, but had always found at least one too good for him at this level before. However, given a strong pace set by GREEN PERFUME (Naevus) for the first half-mile and taken up by eventual second Mistle Cat from then on, Bin Rosie settled nicely until jockey Frankie Dettori asked him to make his move with a furlong left. From there onwards all was plain sailing and the Newmarket-based gelding would have had plenty left, even if the late rush of third-placed Magellan had started sooner. Loder was delighted at the result and said: "I wish I had a stable full of horses like this one. He always runs well and, if you hold him up to ride him for finishing speed, he is pretty decent. This was his main target, but we might send him to a G2 in Germany next time out."

Local News: Australia

The 1995/96 Australian Horse Of The Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) makes his long-awaited reappearance today when he runs in the six-furlong G1 \$159,390 **Manikato S.** at Moonee Valley in Melbourne. The colt will be attempting a fifth straight Group One victory. Last season the John Hawkes-trainee, owned by Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud, became the first horse to win Australia's most prestigious weight-for-age event, the W. S. Cox Plate, the Mercedes Classic and the Sydney Autumn three-year-old Triple Crown--the Canterbury Guineas, Rosehill Guineas and AJC Derby--in the same season. Octagonal's last race was April 6, when he won the AJC Derby over a mile and a half.

Local News: England

Philip Robinson, one of Britain's leading jockeys, has announced that he will be leaving next weekend to take up a one-year contract to ride in Hong Kong. Robinson was offered terms earlier this month by Far East trainer David Hill, but he had been deferring a final decision until he had made certain that his family could find suitable accommodation and that no interruptions were going to be caused to his children's education. Yesterday morning, however, the jockey revealed: "We will definitely be going to Hong Kong. It was not an easy decision. But we seem to have sorted out all of those things which concerned us--housing and schools, mainly--so I think the last time I shall be riding in England for the moment is at the Newmarket meeting after York (next Tuesday through Thursday)." Robinson also explained his agreement with Hill would allow him to fly back to Britain for a limited number of important races.
