**JOCKEY CLUB GOLD CUP PURSE RAISED TO \$1 MILLION** The purse for Belmont Park's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, to be run at a mile and a quarter October 5, has been boosted \$250,000 and will now be worth \$1 million. "We have raised the overnight purses twice in the past couple of months and we thought the Gold Cup was deserving of a raise to cap off the season at Belmont Park," said New York Racing Association President and Chairman of the Board Kenny Noe Jr., adding, "At the current time, trainer Bill Mott has indicated to us that he plans to run Cigar in both the Woodward S. on September 14 and the Jockey Club Gold Cup."

**SERENA'S SONG LIKELY "HIGHWEIGHT" FOR ISELIN** *Dare And Go* (Alydar), who ended Cigar's winning streak with his victory in the GI Pacific Classic August 10, has been top weighted at 121 pounds for the GI Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park August 25 but is not expected to start, which will leave *Serena's Song* (Rahy) as the theoretical highweight in the \$300,000 event. The four-year-old has been assigned 115 pounds, but gets a five-pound sex allowance from the colts. "We'll ship her down (from Saratoga) Wednesday or Thursday," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "She's doing great right now. She showed last year she loves the racetrack, and the fan reaction was great, too." *Serena's Song* beat the boys in last year's GI Haskell Invitational. Lukas will need to find a new rider for his filly, as regular pilot Gary Stevens is still sidelined after rotator cuff surgery and Jerry Bailey, who has been on board for her last three starts, is committed to ride *Geri* (Theatrical {Ire}), 119, in the Iselin for trainer Bill Mott. "I'm not sure yet what we're going to do," said Lukas. "Let's wait a bit and let things sort out." Mott is also considering possible co-highweight **Peaks And Valleys** (Mt. Livermore), 120, for the race. Listed as probable for the mile-and-a-sixteenth test are **Da Hoss** (Gone West), 115, who comes off back-to-back turf stakes wins; the once-beaten **Smart Strike** (Mr. Prospector), 115, winner of the GIII Salvator Mile over the track last out; **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge), 113; **Gulf Reckoning** (War), 113; **Cozy Drive** (Cozzene), 111; and **November Sunset** (Runaway Groom), 111.

Yanks Music, winner of her first three career starts, followed with a second in the GI Acorn S., a win in the GI Mother Goose and most recently a second in the GII Monmouth Breeders' Cup Oaks July 6. Continuing her recent pattern of winning every other start, she came from off-the-pace here for a decisive tally as the fourth choice. Favored My Flag, winner of the GI Coaching Club American Oaks at this distance July 20, raced toward the back of the field early, was in traffic along the backstretch and on the far turn, angled out at the quarter pole, split horses in upper stretch, then closed steadily to narrowly miss the place. "I thought My Flag could beat us at 1 1/4-miles," said winning trainer Leo O'Brien. "It wasn't until the eighth pole that I was really confident. A little moisture in the track helped her today. This is one of the best horses I have ever trained, next to Fourstardave, who was my best grass horse."

Smoke Glacken missed by a 1/2-length over a sloppy Monmouth track in his career debut June 30, then followed with an 8 1/2-length maiden victory and a one-length tally in the \$40,000 Tyro S. at Monmouth July 28. Ridden again here by his Tyro jockey Craig Perret, the gray colt prompted the quick early pace set by JOHNNY LEGIT (Double Negative), put a head in front after a 1/2-mile and drew clear for his first graded stakes victory. "When those numbers went up--:21 1/5 and :44--I started to get a little nervous," said winning trainer Henry Carroll. "Even with the fast pace, it looked like he was within himself. I am going to give him some time off now and then we'll look to meet the Jerkens' horse (Gill Sanford S. winner Kelly Kip) somewhere down the line."

**OCTAGONAL BEATEN IN MELBOURNE** **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}), Australian Horse of the Year in 1995/96, made his seasonal debut in Saturday's G1 Manikato S. over six furlongs at Moonee Valley in Melbourne, but could finish only sixth behind the Lee Freedman-trained **Poetic King (Aus)** (Yeats), a 10-1 shot. Four-year-old Octagonal was carried wide and came from second last to finish just over four lengths behind the six-year-old Poetic King. Octagonal's trainer John Hawkes said, "They were walking and I knew he couldn't win from where he was half a mile from home. But he ran terrific and one defeat doesn't mean he is not a champion. He covered a bit of ground and it just didn't pan out, but that's racing." Octagonal may renew his rivalry with Poetic King in the G2 Memsie S. over seven furlongs at Caulfield in Melbourne Aug. 31.

## ARLINGTON INTRODUCES "FESTIVAL 3" BET

Arlington International will unveil the first multiple-day wager in Illinois racing history when it introduces the "Festival 3," a Pick 3 bet on three events in Arlington's International Festival of Racing. The wager involves picking the winners of the G1 Beverly D. S. August 24 and the G1 Secretariat S. and G1 Arlington Million August 25; it has been dubbed the "ultimate Pick 3" by Arlington CEO Scott Mordell.

**SETBACK FOR LADY CARLA** Epsom Derby heroine **Lady Carla (GB)** (Caerleon) has only a 40-percent chance of meeting her engagement in Wednesday's G1 Aston Upthorpe Yorkshire Oaks after suffering a minor training setback. The Henry Cecil-trained filly was one of 14 entries for the mile-and-a-half test and would probably have started as the favorite. But Saturday, Cecil said, "Lady Carla suffered a slight muscle spasm in her back two days ago and missed her intended work this morning. The problem is only minor." Nevertheless, the Newmarket-based handler, whose charge finished a disappointing fourth in her last start in the Irish Oaks, admitted that he rates her only "40-60" to make this week's field. Britain's final Classic of '96, the St. Leger at Doncaster Sept. 14, is now likely to be her target.
