**GONE WEST, GREEN DANCER FILLIES TOP DEAUVILLE OPENER** Two fillies attracted bids of \$320,000 to top the opening session of the 1996 Deauville Yearling Sale, which began Saturday evening. The first, a daughter of Gone West out of L'Argentelle (Lyphard), was consigned by Haras du Mezeray. Named **Arbeles**, the bay was purchased by Patrick Barbe on behalf of the Yoshida family; her dam is a half-sister to GISW Roi Normand, MGSW Trampoli and MGSW Luth Dancer. The second, consigned by Haras des Capucines, is a half-sister to G1SW Top Sunrise; the daughter of Green Dancer out of Marie de Russy (Sassafra {Fr}) was bought by the Wertheimer brothers. A total of 69 yearlings were offered on the first day at Deauville, with 59 sold for \$4,797,115 for an average of \$87,220, figures nearly identical to last year's opening session. The sale continues through August 22.

**SMART STRIKE SHARP FOR ISELIN** Getting ready for an assault on Grade I company in the Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth August 25, **Smart Strike** (Mr. Prospector) turned in a sparkling five-furlong move in :57 2/5 at Woodbine yesterday morning, galloping out six furlongs in 1:11 3/5. The four-year-old broke six lengths behind stablemate **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown), a favorite for the third leg of Canada's Triple Crown, the Breeders' S. August 25, and went his first three-eighths in :33 3/5. "It was a great work for both horses," said trainer Mark Frostad. "Smart Strike, when he sees a horse in front of him, really rocks and rolls." A half-brother to Canadian Horse of the Year Dance Smartly, Smart Strike will ship to New Jersey Thursday.

**SARATOGA TRIBUTE FOR CIGAR** The reigning Horse of the Year **Cigar** (Palace Music) will not compete at Saratoga, but the six-year-old superstar will make a public appearance between races at the track Friday, August 30, as part of the "Saratoga Salute to Cigar." Fans at the track will also receive a free full-color photograph of the champ, autographed by owner Allen Paulson, trainer Bill Mott and jockey Jerry Bailey.

Chaposa Springs hasn't been beaten since last November, taking five stakes, two graded, coming into this race. Off at a generous 9-2, she rated in fourth while last year's champion two-year-old filly **GOLDEN ATTRACTION** (Mr. Prospector) battled 4-5 Capote Belle through the early fractions, then grudgingly gave way to the favorite turning for home. Capote Belle opened a clear lead at midstretch but could not hold on as the winner charged by along the rail in the final strides. After the race John Moynihan, manager for winning trainer Marty Wolfson said, "It wasn't the best of trips for us. She's normally one or two lengths off the lead and today she was farther back. Between the three-eighths and the quarter-poles, she normally wins her races. Today, she won it in the stretch." Jockey Shane Sellers took over the reins on Chaposa Springs for regular rider Laffit Pincay, Jr. who was out with a stomach flu, and said, "I didn't realize that she had a lot of quirks about her. She doesn't like to get dirt in her face, she wants to be outside, and she doesn't like to be hit with the whip. I didn't think I was going to get by Capote Belle on the inside--that filly ran a superb race. But I showed her the stick and she went on." The Breeders' Cup Sprint is a possibility for Chaposa Springs.

The speedy miss, a two-time Grade I winner on the main track, was sent off the 7-5 choice and led every step to pick up her first Grade I on grass. Winning jockey Chris Antley, earning his second graded stakes win of the weekend after piloting Alphabet Soup to victory in the featured Gill Pat O'Brien H. Saturday, said, "I didn't want to be on the lead, but she wanted to go. She would have been a run-off the whole race if I tried to take a hold. At the three-eighths pole, I didn't look back. I didn't want to. From there I just kept on riding. She was right today--she's never been better."

At that stage John Reid brought the German mare Hollywood Dream with her challenge, but she could never close on Luso, who won hard-held.

Newmarket trainer David Loder pulled off a major surprise when saddling Bahamian Bounty to beat the French hotshot Zamindar. Zamindar, the unbeaten full-brother to 1993 English 2000 Guineas winner Zafonic, set the pace and appeared to be cruising two furlongs out, but jockey Frankie Dettori kept hard at work on Bahamian Bounty and the Loder colt mastered the pacesetter, only for the Andre Fabre-trained colt come back at him close home. However it was too late for Thierry Jarnet's mount and he was beaten a short neck. A delighted David Loder said: "This horse has a wonderful temperament. I was very pleased with his win at Yarmouth last time out. I knew I was taking a calculated risk by bringing him here, as this was a big step up in class. But at this time of year with the two-year-olds, there is not a lot of difference between a Group One race and an ordinary Group race, and now it has paid off. I feel that the horse will have only one more run this year and that will probably be in the G1 Middle Park S. over six furlongs at Newmarket on October 3." Of Zamindar, Grant Pritchard-Gordon, racing manager to Prince Khaled Abdullah, said: "You can't really blame the horse. He had never been challenged in any of his races until now and he didn't know how to battle. Inexperience probably cost him the race, but perhaps his jockey should have made more use of him and taken off when the others were under pressure."

**NUNTHORPE S.-G1**, 3yo/up, 5fT

High-class Canadian sprinter **Wild Zone** (Wild Again) will face a tough test when he runs in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Thursday. Ten-times British champion jockey Pat Eddery has been booked to ride Frank Passero's six-year-old, but opposition is strong with eight of Europe's top sprinters expected to line up in this five-furlong test. **Hever Golf Rose** (GB) (Efisio {GB}), heroine of last season's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp and a good third last month in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket, will be one of Wild Zone's main rivals if her final workout on Epsom racecourse yesterday proves a reliable guide. Joe Naughton, the filly's trainer, said: "I was very happy with her and expect a very good run on Thursday. The course was in lovely condition and she had a nice spin. In an ideal world she needs a good lead and, with **Eveningperformance** (GB) (Night Shift) also set to run, that looks certain." The other Nunthorpe entries included: **Pivotal** (GB) (Polar Falcon) and **Mind Games** (GB) (Puissance {GB}), first and second home in Royal Ascot's King's Stand S., and Swedish-based raider **Windmachine** (Swe) (River Scape).

Five contenders for the third leg of Canada's Triple Crown, the Breeders' S. at Woodbine August 25, worked yesterday over the track's turf training course. Prince of Wales S. runner-up **Firm Dancer** (Affirmed) went five furlongs 1:01 3/5 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:16 3/5; **Rebmec** (Miswaki) went the same distance in 1:02 2/5 but went out the three-quarters in 1:15 4/5. **Bartholomew Bandy** (Silver Deputy) rounded out the five-furlong drills, going in 1:01 2/5. **Talkin Proud** (With Approval), a full-brother to Canadian champion Talkin Man claimed for \$20,000 August 1, was timed in 1:15 flat for six furlongs, while **Kristy Krunch** (Varick) went seven-eighths in 1:28 3/5, breezing. The 106th Breeders' S. is expected to draw a field of eight.
