STRONG DEAUVILLE SALE CONTINUES During Sunday night's second session of the Agence Francaise's Deauville yearling sale, the gross of \$8,116,014 was up 20 percent from last year, while the average of \$142,386 represented a 16 percent increase from 1995. Two colts shared the session's high price of \$698,882. The first, by Nureyev out of the G3 Prix de la Nonette winner Sierra Roberta (Don Roberto), was sold by Haras du Mezeray and bought by Patrick Barbe, agent for Mr. Nihonyanagi. The second, by Alzao--Sudah (Rainbow Quest), was consigned by Haras d'Etreham and purchased by Gainsborough Stud. The sale continues through Thursday.

THISTLEDOWN RAISES PURSES Beginning Thursday, August 22, all overnight purses at Thistledown will be increased by 10 percent, the track's Executive Vice President and General Manager Mike Mackey announced Monday. In the first 114 days of the 1996 racing season, Thistledown's purses topped \$6 million, with a daily average purse distribution of \$53,868. With seven live races on the card offered five days each week, the average purse per race is currently \$7,695. With the 10 percent increase, the daily average purse distribution will jump more than \$5,000, with the average purse per race increasing nearly \$1,000. "We are pleased to offer increased purses to the horsemen and feel this increase will make Thistledown more competitive," Mackey said. "This is only the first step in a long walk to keep live racing a priority, even with the inception of full-card simulcasting next month. We do not want our live product to take any steps backward as the track looks toward so many new and promising changes."

WILD ZONE OUT OF NUNTHORPE STAKES

Wild Zone (Wild Again), the Canadian sprinter whose connections had planned an assault on Wednesday's Nunthorpe S. at York, England, has been forced out of contention for the Group One event by travel problems. The six-year-old had been expected to jet into Britain after leaving Frank Passero Jr.'s stables Sunday. But his intended flight was re-routed and he did not leave his home base. Mike Doyle, racing manager for owner Frank Stronach, said, "Everybody connected with the horse is very disappointed. We've been planning the trip for seven weeks." The Nunthorpe S. is for ages three and up at five furlongs.

Saturday, Saratoga:

TRAVERS S.-GI, \$750,000, 3yo, 1 1/4m

Louis Quatorze (Sovereign Dancer), winner of the GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga Aug. 4, breezed five furlongs through the fog Monday morning over Saratoga's main track. The Preakness winner covered the distance in 1:00.47 with jockey Pat Day aboard. "I caught him in 1:00 and a couple, and once again his galloping out time was excellent," said trainer Nick Zito. "We worked on the main track because there is going to be a big crowd Travers Day and he walked around the paddock and went to the track to get the feel of things."

The Team Lukas duo of **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew) and **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) took to the track Monday morning as well. GI Haskell runner-up Dr. Caton worked six furlongs through the fog, and Jim Dandy fourth Editor's Note went five-eighths under Mike Smith. "The fog had settled in on the backside, but they caught Editor's Note the last three-eighths in :36.16," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "If he runs like he worked, he'll have a big shot Saturday."

Skip Away (Skip Trial), winner of the GII Ohio Derby and GI Haskell in his last two starts, was "full of energy" Monday morning following his work at Monmouth Park the previous day, assistant trainer Tony Maeda reported. Jose Santos will have the return mount on Skip Away, who breezed five furlongs in :59 4/5 Sunday. "He ate up his breakfast and he was bouncing around pretty good," said Maeda. "Even Sunday afternoon, he had a group of visitors from Japan and when we brought him out of the stall he was rearing up. I'd say he was feeling good."

Other possible starters for the Travers include Jim Dandy runner-up **Will's Way** (Easy Goer) and the Alfredo Callejas-trained pair **Prince Heaven** (Proper Reality) and **Secreto de Estado** (General Assembly). Allen Jerkens-trainee **Action** (Blushing John) is considered doubtful for the race.

Beauchamp King (GB) (Nishapour {Fr}), the colt who ended the unbeaten run of last year's top-rated juvenile **Alhaarth** (Ire) (Unfuwain) when winning Newmarket's G3 Craven S. in April, will be taking on his old rival again in Saturday's Celebration Mile. Beauchamp King has failed to win since the Craven and on his most recent run finished last of seven in the G1 Eclipse S. Connections blame that poor display on the fact that he pulled very hard off a slow pace and a spokesman for Britain's champion trainer John Dunlop said Monday, "Beauchamp King has had a short break since the Eclipse and we are hoping he will run well on Saturday. Newmarket 2000 Guineas hero **Mark Of Esteem** (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) was also among the nine entries for the Goodwood test and, according to the Godolphin team, he is "on target to run" this weekend.
