DEAUVILLE WRAP-UP The final sessions of the 1996 Deauville Yearling Sales, organized by Agence Francaise de Vente du Pur-Sang, confirmed the trend established on the first two days. There was fresh evidence of the recovery in the bloodstock market up to the last evening; after the six days of the sale, held August 17-22, the average was \$63,076, up 30 percent from 1995, while the gross was \$20,058,107, up 5 percent from a year ago. A total of 326 yearlings were sold, 70.4 percent of those offered, and while the market was strong it remained selective, with the proportion of yearlings not sold rising on the last two days. Foreign buyers were a strong presence throughout the sale. Thursday's session topper, a son of Sanglamoire--Double Line (What A Guest) consigned by Haras des Capucines, was purchased for \$103,834 by Agence Winners on behalf of a Spanish client. Japanese buyers, who accounted for 18 percent of the market on the first two days of the auction, were also active, in particular the clients of French agent Patrick Barbe. The Maktoum family spent more than \$2 million, while Khalid Abdullah bought two yearlings for Juddmonte Farms, marking his return to the yearling market after an absence of several years. New French buyers were also prominent throughout the sale, attracted by new premiums and possible purse increases in their country. "I am very pleased for breeders who have had a difficult time for at least 10 years," said Philippe Augier, president of the Agence Francaise. "I think the sale's results justified our policy of selection and this, coupled with the international nature of the French horses in the catalogue, enabled us to maintain the strong demand throughout the week."

Urbane, fresh from a front-running victory in the Gill Delaware H. at this distance, profited from the withdrawal of the speedy Restored Hope. Out of the gate fast once again, the dark bay this time raced head-and-head with Shoop through moderate early fractions before putting that rival away at the top of the stretch and drawing clear. "This seemed like the next logical spot," said her trainer, Randy Bradshaw. "It didn't bother me at all that Shoop went out there with Urbane, just as long as the fractions were slow. She's a tough filly...she may not be Serena's Song, but she's close." As for future plans, he offered, "I'm going to bring her back to California and give her a rest. She has been around the country and deserves a break. I'm considering the Spinster (October 6 at Keeneland) for her next race."

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown

Contested at equal weights, and with the small field unlikely to cause a traffic jam on the long run into the first turn, the 127th running of the Travers will be an equal-opportunity event for the best three-year-olds still standing at midsummer.

Skip Away (Skip Trial) has put up five huge performances since April and has now run his career-best Thoro-Graph figure of 1 3/4 three times--the 1994 Travers winner Holy Bull had not run that fast even once at this point. Giving away weight while winning the GI Ohio Derby and GI Buick Haskell Invitational, the colt won't spot even a pound to his rivals here, and there's no reason to believe he won't run another big one.

On the other hand, Preakness winner **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) took the Jim Dandy while giving 12 pounds to runner-up **Will's Way** (Easy Goer) and racing outside him on both turns to earn a figure of 0--the best figure for a three-year-old since Risen Star earned a negative number winning the 1988 Belmont S. But Louis has a history of bouncing and it's likely he fired his Travers shot three weeks too soon.

So Skip Away looks the likely winner and, if we play Louis Quatorze to run poorly, the betting gets interesting. The Thoro-Graph play is Skip Away on top in exactas and trifectas using **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner), Will's Way and **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew). *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily. CIGAR ON SARATOGA WORK TAB Cigar (Palace Music) had his first breeze since going down to defeat in the GI Pacific Classic August 10 at Saratoga yesterday morning, going an easy half-mile in :51 under jockey Jerry Bailey. "I asked Jerry to go in :50, :51 to see how he was going," said trainer Bill Mott. "He was cruising along a little bit. I guess it was fine." Mott added that the reigning Horse of the Year could work again next Friday afternoon when he makes a public appearance for "Saratoga Salute to Cigar" day. "It depends on him and the racetrack," he said. The six-year-old is scheduled to make his next start in the GI Woodward September 14. According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, owner Allen Paulson has been offered \$30 million to sell his superstar to Japanese interests for stud duty, but Paulson told the *Form* he will not make a decision on Cigar's future until the conclusion of his racing career.

Reams Of Verse (Nureyev) is a 20-1 shot for next year's 1000 Guineas following her win in yesterday's Equity Financial Collections Fillies' Maiden S. at Newmarket. The Khalid Abdullah-owned chestnut had been beaten on her debut, but she was made 4-7 favorite to make up for that disappointment and did so without being asked a serious question. From the moment she grabbed the lead with three of the seven furlongs to run, the result was in no doubt. Bint Baladee (GB), from the Godolphin string, made up plenty of late ground to take second, but Reams Of Verse, trained by Henry Cecil, was always well in control and the winning margin of a neck was flattering to the runner-up. Cecil said: "She did not see the other filly coming, but still had masses left at the end. She holds an entry in the G1 Fillies' Mile (Ascot, September 28) and that would be an obvious target for her."

Yalaïetanee (GB) (Sadler's Wells) earned himself odds of 25-1 for next year's Epsom Derby when making a successful second racecourse appearance in Friday's Girton Maiden S. at Newmarket. The Michael Stoute-trained colt had failed to justify favoritism when making his debut over the same seven furlongs just under three weeks ago, but starting 2-1 market leader to make amends here, he was always prominent and drew clear after getting to the front with a furlong and a half left. His winning margin was officially four lengths and, as this event has been won by such as the G1 Coronation Cup hero Rainbow Quest in previous years, bookmakers were quick to take the hint. Yalaïetanee's handler certainly rates him highly and nominated the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster (September 13) as a possible next target. Winning jockey John Reid said: "I think that race would be ideal for him. He did this well and is obviously a very nice horse. He has a lovely temperament and a marvelous long stride."

Local News: Australia

Three-year-old **Merlene (Aus)** (Danehill), the filly who won Australia's most prestigious juvenile event, the Golden Slipper, last season, will miss the entire Spring carnival in Melbourne. Winner of five of her six starts and \$1,258,446 last year, Merlene had been in work in Brisbane in preparation for the valuable Princess Series for fillies but has succumbed to a throat infection and has had to be rested.

Local News: New Zealand

Our Maizcay (Aus) (Maizcay {NZ}), the New Zealand-trained colt who took Australia by storm in the early part of last year with six straight Group race wins before flopping in the Cox Plate won by Australian Horse Of The Year Octagonal, has been voted New Zealand's Horse Of The Year and champion three-year-old for the 1995/96 season. A winner of seven of his eleven starts as a juvenile, he included the G1 Caulfield Guineas and the G1 VicHealth Cup amongst his Australian victories. After his failure in the Cox Plate he was found to be suffering from a virus and he had a long lay-off until the Autumn when he ran only seventh in the G1 Lightning S. He was found to have picked up a tendon injury in that race and was retired to stud at Glenlogan Park Stud at Innisplains in Queensland.

Local News: Santa Anita

Horse racing will continue to be a "signature" product of the Santa Anita Companies and will benefit from a fresh infusion of capital, the operating company's president, Cliff Goodrich, told the California Horse Racing Board Friday. Santa Anita announced earlier that it is entering into a partnership with Colony Capital, Inc. "I understand how this transaction with a major real estate firm might be causing some anxieties among our employees and within the horse racing industry, but I assure you that our actions over the next 18 months will erase any doubts about our total commitment to racing," said Goodrich at the Board's regular monthly meeting. "I'm here to say on public record that this alliance gives us access to the capital we need to maintain Santa Anita Park as our signature venue. Just because we will be making investments in areas outside of racing does not mean we will be less dedicated to racing." Colony will acquire nearly a million common shares in Santa Anita immediately after an initial investment of \$12.7 million, representing 8 percent of the stock, with options to invest more than \$138 million.
