### MATIARA SUFFERS FATAL INJURY IN

**BEVERLY D.** Matiara (Bering {GB}), at 4-1 the fourth choice in yesterday's GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington International, was pulled up on the backstretch while running midpack, and what was at first thought to be a minor injury proved fatal as the four-year-old filly died in the horse ambulance on the way back to her barn. The first report indicated that the Richard Mandella trainee was lame in her left hind leg, but that the problem did not appear serious. "I was sitting three or four wide (when she took a bad step)," said jockey Corey Nakatani immediately after the race. "She's a bit lame in the left hind, but I don't think it's life-threatening." But the Kentucky-bred never made it off the van. "Matiara died in the ambulance as it arrived at the barn," said Dr. Robert Gowen, the track veterinarian. "She died from a major internal hemorrhage, possibly the result of a pelvic fracture. However, we won't know for sure until a complete autopsy is performed. She is being prepared to be sent to the University of Illinois' veterinary school for the autopsy." Matiara, bred by Societe Aland and owned by Alec Head, won the G1 French 1000 Guineas and was beaten only a neck in the G1 French Oaks; she earned her first American Grade I win in Del Mar's Ramona H. last time out. The filly won six of 15 career starts and earned \$847,974. (*Beverly D. chart, p3*)

Will's Way just missed after setting easy fractions in the GI Jim Dandy, finishing second by a neck while getting a dozen pounds from Preakness winner Louis Quatorze. But the lightly raced colt was not fazed by the 12-pound weight shift against him here. Making his third start off a two-and-a-half month break, the bay son of 1989 Travers winner Easy Goer this time sat fifth through a half in :46.30, then moved to challenge the front-running Louis Quatorze and fought that one stirrup-to-stirrup until finally edging clear in the final yards. "He's just getting better all the time," said trainer Jim Bond. "The biggest reason we're here is because we have very, very patient owners. After he pulled a muscle and finished third in the Flamingo, I told Mrs. Rudder, 'We won't make the Kentucky Derby, but I'll make the summer Derby for you, and we'll get it.'" As for future plans, Bond said, "I really like four-year-olds--I'm not going to tear this horse up to win an Eclipse Award. He's nominated to the Molson Million, the Super Derby but again, I'm not going to tear him up. He's a hero today--I don't want to make him a bum in three or four weeks." Louis Quatorze was game all the way to the wire, prompting trainer Nick Zito to say, "I'm disappointed we didn't win but I'm not disappointed with the way he ran. He gave a valiant effort in the end." Skip Away loomed boldly at the top of the lane but could not get past the top two and settled for third; Belmont S. winner EDITOR'S NOTE (Forty Niner) made a mild bid on the far turn but flattened out and finished fourth.

**THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS**

This year's Iselin is being billed as a match race between **Serena's Song** (Rahy) and **Smart Strike** (Mr. Prospector), but in actuality the entire evenly matched field could end up less than six lengths apart at the wire.

Every once in a while, events combine to create a super live longshot in a stakes race. Like most sons of Cozzene, **Cozy Drive** was slow to develop, not showing anything even resembling stakes ability until late in his three-year-old campaign. Since then he has been solid on dirt, finally exploding in June to win a Jersey-bred stakes by 10 lengths while earnings a big Thoro-Graph figure of 2.

After a predictable bounce in his next start, the gray colt began moving forward again in his latest, finishing second behind Smart Strike in the Salvator Mile. Now, with a months' rest, he should fire his best shot. Add in a light weight package and that he is the inside speed with a short run to the turn, and Cozy Drive is the Thoro-Graph play in the Iselin. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily. **HICKEY TAKES LATEST CASE TO COURT**

Trainer Noel Hickey is scheduled to take his case to Cook County Circuit Court on Tuesday after losing an appeal to the Illinois Racing Board on a phenylbutazone overdose finding--and having an additional penalty slapped on. The Arlington International Race Course stewards originally hit Hickey with a 15-day suspension and fined him \$1,000 when Golden Gear, a horse owned by Barry Golden, tested over the limit for Bute after a winning performance in the eighth race June 8. Contending that the overdose was either a veterinarian's mistake or a vindictive act by another person, the three-time trainer titleist appealed to the Racing Board. The Board upheld his \$1,000 fine but increased the length of his suspension from 15 to 60 days. The action is the latest episode in Hickey's ongoing hassle with the Board and the Arlington stewards. Still to be resolved in court is a 1994 case involving six of his horses who tested positive for Albuterol during that summer's Arlington meeting. When Hickey appealed the stewards' six-month suspension in that case, the penalty was increased to one year by the Board.
