TRIVERS WRAP-UP Travers winner **Will's Way** (Easy Goer) came out of Saturday's Grade I event in good shape, his trainer H. James Bond said Sunday. "We're very, very happy this morning," Bond said. "He ate up well and is doing very good. I believed in this horse for quite some time--not a lot of others did--and he lived up to it. Our clients got rewarded for their patience and understanding." Immediate plans for Will's Way are undecided at this time. "We're just going to enjoy the next couple of days and see what develops," Bond said. When asked what's next for his Travers runner-up **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), trainer Nick Zito said, "The (Woodbine Million) in Canada (Sept. 15) is a possibility. The Breeders' Cup Classic is certainly an option down the road and we'll sit back and analyze the situation." According to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, Travers fourth **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) is being considered for the Sept. 21 Kentucky Cup and **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew), who pressed the pace early in the Travers before fading to seventh and last, is being pointed for the one-mile Gil Jerome H. at Belmont Sept. 15. Trainer Alfredo Callejas has mapped out tentative campaigns for **Secreto de Estado** (General Assembly) and **Prince Heaven** (Proper Reality), fifth and sixth respectively in the Travers, that may send Secreto de Estado to the \$750,000 Isle of Capri Super Derby at Louisiana Downs Sept. 22, and would keep Prince Heaven in New York to run in shorter races.

GRINDSTONE'S STUD FEE SET Saturday's *Daily Racing Form* reported that 1996 Kentucky Derby winner **Grindstone** (Unbridled), who was retired after his win in the "Run for the Roses" due to a recurring knee injury, will stand stud in 1997 for a fee of \$20,000 at owner/breeder William T. Young's Overbrook Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. The three-year-old won three of his six career starts and earned \$1,224,510.

Mecke now has two Grade I victories on the turf, the other being his tally in the Early Times Turf Classic at Churchill Downs May 4, compared to only one Grade I victory on the dirt, which came in last year's Isle of Capri Super Derby at Louisiana Downs. The bay trailed this nine-horse field through the first six furlongs, with 1995 Arlington Million hero Awad alongside him. Meanwhile, European-breds **TORCH ROUGE** (GB) (Warning {GB}) and **NEEDLE GUN** (IRE) (Sure Blade {GB}) set a moderate early pace of :24 and :48 1/5 on the front end. 7-5 favorite Sandpit was always tracking that pair closely, however, and he took the lead at the top of the stretch. However, with the pace quickening, Awad rallied outside in the drive and looked like he might repeat his victory of last year. But displaying the strongest closing kick of all was Mecke, who came down the center of the track to win in his first start since June 22, when he finished fifth to Sandpit in the GI Caesars International.

Marlin put a head in front at the top of the stretch in the GII mile-and-three-sixteenths American Derby last time out but could not sustain his rally and faded to third. Stretching out beyond a mile and a sixteenth for the second time here, the Florida-bred bay this time grabbed the lead after a slow half in :49.39 and held it all the way to the wire, widening on his field in the final furlong to win going away. "I was anticipating being close to the pace, but I never anticipated being on the lead that way," said winning jockey Shane Sellers. "(Jaunatxo) pressed me, but he pressed me a little late and I was able to get on away. From that point on, I just pitched his head away." Favored Trail City, DQ'ed from first in the American Derby, picked up six pounds from that race; while no match for the winner, who was in receipt of 12 pounds, he gamely held off Dancing Fred to hold the place spot.

Smart Strike, second in his racecourse debut at Keeneland in April, 1995, had won all five of his starts since, including the GIII Salvator Mile at Monmouth July 27. Sent off the 5-2 third choice here, the regally-bred bay made it six in a row, racing just behind the leaders early, drawing on even terms with the frontrunners entering the stretch, taking command in midstretch and striding clear for a decisive victory. "It was just a super, super effort," said Ernie Samuel, who bred and owns Smart Strike under the name of his Sam-Son Farm. Samuel watched his horse win the Iselin on television from Woodbine. "We've known all along that this was a

special horse. When he injured his tendon last year we said we'd just have to be patient with him. I don't know where we'll run him next. I'll have to sit down with Mark (trainer Mark Frostad) and determine that. Our goal, of course, is the Breeders' Cup right here on our home ground at Woodbine." Eltish, third to Cigar in the Arlington Citation Challenge in his last outing July 13, finished fast on the outside to steal second place from the favored filly Serena's Song. The filly raced head and head for the early lead with longshot COZY DRIVE (Cozzene) through fractions of :23 2/5, :46 4/5, 1:10 3/5 and 1:35 1/5 then continued gamely to the wire to be third despite tiring in the final stages. "Serena hung a little bit today," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "But she never disappoints us or the crowd. She ran her heart out."

In his last three starts, Chief Bearhart finished third in the Plate Trial (GIC) June 23, fourth in the Queens Plate (GIC) July 7 and first in a Woodbine turf allowance July 25. The allowance score was the chestnut's third career start on the grass and his second victory over the surface. Sent off as part of the favored entry here, he upped his turf record to three-for-four with a come-from-behind move that saw him bound away from the field in the stretch for a 9 1/2-length romp. Sam-Son Farm owner Ernie Samuel, who also won yesterday's GI Iselin H. at Monmouth with Smart Strike, said of Chief Bearhart's victory, "I'm just getting my voice back after yelling so hard for Smart Strike, but I didn't have to yell so much for Chief, he won so easily. I can't say I'm surprised; we always thought this horse was much, much better on grass and that he'd love a distance. The way he finished today hopefully he can handle something like the Canadian International (formerly the Rothmans Int'l, to be run Sept. 29). You know three-year-olds get the weight allowance in that race. It'll be tough. But he deserves a shot. He's a serious grass runner."

Sharp Cat made history earlier this year when she sold for \$900,000 at the Barretts March Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training, making her the highest-priced unraced 2yo filly ever to sell at auction. The chestnut, who broke her maiden in her second career start at Del Mar Aug. 12, quickly stepped up against graded stakes company in a bid to earn back some of her purchase price. Ridden for the first time here by Rene Douglas, the 11-1 outsider settled behind the quick early fractions of :21 2/5 and :44, took command at the top of the stretch and held on to defeat GII Sorrento S. winner Desert Digger in a three-way photo. 8-5 favorite STARRY ICE (Ice Age), undefeated in four previous career starts and coming off a win in the July 6 GII Landaluce S., was up front early through the blazing fractions, then tired to be ninth in the 10-horse field.

L'Carriere hadn't visited the winner's circle in six tries since taking last year's Saratoga Cup by seven lengths. Back to defend his title as the 3-1 third choice, the bay gelding, fifth to Mahogany Hall in the GI Whitney H. in his last outing Aug. 3, turned the tables on that rival here. L'Carriere was put to the whip early to contest the early pace alongside SUAVE PROSPECT (Fortunate Prospect), took command after the two had run six furlongs in 1:11.38, then drew clear to defeat the favored Peaks and Valleys. Winning trainer Harold James Bond and winning jockey Jorge Chavez had also paired together for a victory with Will's Way in the GI Travers Saturday. "This weekend has just been fantastic," said Bond. "I might fly off the roof. Last night I went to bed early, woke up 30 minutes later, fell asleep, woke up again...this is just ice cream on the cake." When asked what's next for L'Carriere, Bond said, "The Woodward (Sept. 14) is a possibility. You don't get a lot of spots. Hopefully, we'll have two for the Breeders' Cup."

OBS AUGUST YEARLING SALE STARTS TODAY

A 90-horse consignment from Harry T. Mangurian's Mockingbird Farm is included among the 1,129 yearlings to be offered during this year's Ocala Breeders Sales Co. Yearling Sale, which starts today and runs through August 29. Mockingbird will sell its consignment at the end of the opening-day session. Valid Appeal, sire of 66 stakes-winners to date, will be represented by 21 yearlings, 19 of them in the Mockingbird consignment, and top freshman sire Diablo, who already has 12 winners from his first crop, will have 27 in the sale--22 of them from Mangurian's operation. Summerfield, agent, sells 22 lots, including a half-brother to world-record setter Klassy Briefcase by Kipper Kelly, sire of the undefeated two-year-old Kelly Kip, winner of the GIII Sanford in his latest start. There are 18 Kipper Kelly yearlings in the sale. Bridlewood Farm will offer six yearlings during the auction's opening session, with two fillies by the farm's stallion Skip Trial, sire of GI Haskell Invitational winner Skip Away. "The success of horses in all price ranges is one reason buyers have been attracted to this yearling sale over the years," said Tom Ventura, OBS Director of Sales. "And the continued success of Florida-breds this year points out that the best yearling buys in August may be in Ocala." Sessions for the four-day OBS Yearling Sale begin daily at 10:30 a.m.

FUSTOK TO SET UP SAUDI STUD BOOK Buckram Oak Farm owner Moustapha Fustok left for England yesterday on the first leg of what he anticipates will be a multi-year journey to set up Saudi Arabia's stud book and get it internationally classified. Fustok said that he has signed a contract with Weatherbys to accomplish the project, and will spend six weeks training in England before heading to Saudi Arabia after the Arc de Triomphe in October. Weatherbys, the administrators of horse racing for the British Horse Racing Board, are publishers of the General Stud Book in England and have contracted to do the same in Saudi Arabia, said Fustok. "There are currently approximately 600 broodmares in Saudi Arabia, and the country produces about 350 babies per year, around the same as Denmark or Sweden." But the country, which currently does not blood-type or DNA test the offspring to verify parentage, does not meet international standards. "They are not able to buy well-bred fillies and mares because once breeders sell them to (Saudi Arabia), the pedigrees are lost," said Fustok, who added that Dubai's organization of its stud book and subsequent success as an international winter racing site spurred the Saudis to follow suit. "The first job will be to re-identify every single horse through DNA testing, the way we do here or in Europe," said Fustok. "Then all the babies will have to be registered the way they are here." Fustok said he expected it to take two to three years to accomplish that task, and perhaps five years before Saudi Arabia is internationally recognized. Ultimately, he said, he would like to work with racing secretaries to set up a Breeders' Cup-type event, something to encourage the breeders to register their horses. Down the road, he predicted, "They will be internationally competitive."
