FAIR GROUNDS ANNOUNCES STAKES

SCHEDULE Fair Grounds' Director of Racing and Racing Secretary Mervin Muniz Jr. announced the 1996-97 stakes schedule for the New Orleans racetrack yesterday. The track's upcoming 88-day meet will mark its 125th anniversary with opening day slated for Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 28. Highlighting the schedule will be the Spring Festival of Racing beginning March 9, 1997. The seventh annual Festival is anchored by five graded events: the \$250,000 Gill New Orleans H. March 9, \$150,000 Gill Fair Grounds Oaks March 15, \$350,000 Gill Louisiana Derby March 16, \$150,000 Gill Explosive Bid H. for older turf horses March 29 and \$125,000 Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. for older horses March 23. Louisiana-bred Thoroughbreds and Quarter Horses will take the Fair Grounds' spotlight Dec. 14 with the sixth annual Louisiana Champions Day. The feature race on the \$765,000 ten-stakes race card is the \$125,000 Classic for three-year-olds and up at 1 1/8-miles. "We think our winter racing program keeps getting better and better," said Muniz. "We had another record-breaking season last year in terms of handle and daily wagering and we awarded more in total purses than ever before. The upcoming meeting is special to us. It marks our 125th anniversary and we think we will have the best season ever." The meet concludes March 31.

OCALA SALES RESULTS The Ocala Breeders' Sale Company completed the first day of the August Yearling Sale yesterday. The sale topper from the selected session came from the consignment of Big C Farm. The colt by Pentelicus out of the stakes-placed Northern Baby mare Jungle Woman brought a final bid of \$200,000 from Buzz Chace acting as agent for Ernie Paragallo's Paraneck Stable. Paraneck Stable was the leading buyer, spending \$275,000, adding a Jolie's Halo colt from Bridlewood Farm to their stable. A total of 106 horses were sold in the selected portion of the sale for a gross of \$3,704,000 compared to the 1995 selected session gross of \$3,417,700. The average of this year's sale increased almost \$5,000 or 16.6 percent to \$34,943. The median was \$30,000, representing a 20 percent increase over the \$25,000 median in 1995. The open portion of the yearling sale continues through Thursday, starting at 10:30 AM daily.

SPINAWAY S.-GI, \$200,000, 2yo, f, 7f

Storm Song (Summer Squall), six-length winner of the Gill Adirondack S. in her last outing Aug. 12, breezed five furlongs in 1:01.63 yesterday at Saratoga. "She's doing fantastic," said trainer Nick Zito. "It's very exciting to have a two-year-old filly as good as this one." Among Storm Song's rivals in the Spinaway will be a pair of D. Wayne Lukas-trained fillies. They are **Pearl City** (Carson City), who broke her maiden by 10 1/2-lengths in her only career start at Saratoga Aug. 19, and **Private Pursuit** (Private Account), winner of a maiden special weight at Churchill Downs and an allowance at Saratoga in her last two outings.

HOPEFUL S.-GI, \$200,000, 2yo, 7f

Hobeau Farm's undefeated **Kelly Kip** (Kipper Kelly) worked seven furlongs Monday over Saratoga's main track, covering the distance in 1:27.63 under jockey Jean-Luc Samyn, who has ridden the colt to all three of his victories. "He finished up really strong," said Chuck Simon, assistant to trainer Allen Jerkens. "Allen had wanted him to work between 1:27 and 1:28, so it was just perfect, exactly what he wanted. He's doing well and he will be ready for Saturday." Kelly Kip, winner of a \$40,000 maiden claimer in his debut at Belmont June 21, has since won the Gill Tremont S. by 4 1/2-lengths and the July 26 Gill Sanford S. at Saratoga by 10 1/2-lengths.

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas will send out a triple threat in the Hopeful with Gill Sapling S. third-place finisher **Country Rainbow** (Rahy), Sapling sixth **Mercer Mill** (Forty Niner) and Tyro S. third **Partner's Hero** (Danzig).

SHAAMIT TO IRISH CHAMPION STAKES Epsom Derby winner **Shaamit (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}) is now definitely on target to run in the Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 14--and connections still have not completely ruled out the possibility of their colt going on to tackle the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp October 6. Shaamit's only run since the Derby produced a third in Ascot's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. and, following that race, his trainer William Haggas suggested the G1 Irish Champion would possibly be his final start of 1996. But now--after the form of the Ascot event has been boosted several times--Haggas is contemplating his options. He said, "I am as definite as any trainer can be of Shaamit running in Ireland. But, having seen recent results, we are taking one race at a time and not discounting anything. Shaamit is in very good form--he is just being kept ticking over at home--and, if he won the Irish race nicely and came out of it well enough, we would have to consider the Arc."

WHITHAM NAMED TOBA OWNER OF THE MONTH Janis R. Whitham enjoyed back-to-back graded stakes wins at Hollywood Park July 13 and July 14. In recognition of this accomplishment, she has been named the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association's Owner of the Month for July. July 13, Whitham's **Listening** (Night Shift) scored an upset in the G1 Hollywood Oaks. Listening was bred by Whitham's late husband, Frank Whitham. The following day, **Cleante (Arg)** (Kleight) took the GII Bel Air H. Also in July, Whitham's homebred filly **Madame Pandit** (Wild Again) won a Hollywood allowance. "It was a fun weekend, very fun because we were there," noted Whitham, a native and resident of Leoti, Kansas. In addition to the three horses previously mentioned, she has about nine others in training. While the majority are conditioned by Ron McAnally in Southern California, four are stabled in Vancouver, British Columbia. As July's winner, Whitham will be featured on ESPN's *Racehorse Digest*.
