**OBS SALE CONCLUDES** The Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's August Yearling Sale ended Thursday with a total of 779 horses bringing in \$10,658,600, an increase of 12 percent over the 1995 sale when 683 horses sold for \$9,498,000. While the average at the selected session, \$34,943, was up 16.6 percent, the open-session average of \$7,884 was down 3 percent from a year ago. Thursday's topper was a filly by Piccolino--Evil's Sister (Medieval Man); consigned by Red Oak Farm, agent, the full-sister to multiple-stakes winner Evil's Pic went for a bid of \$50,000 to Diane Allen. "The sale held up well at the top end," said Tom Ventura, director of sales at OBS. "The nice athletic yearlings commanded good prices, while the lower end of the market was light." Summerfield Sales Agency was the leading seller in both the select and open sessions.

**BAY MEADOWS OPENS TONIGHT** Bay Meadows Racecourse in San Mateo, California, opens its 52-day Fall meeting tonight, with post time set for 6:45 p.m. PDT. A total of 28 stakes will be offered during the meet, including the \$200,000 Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint September 14, the GII \$200,000 Bay Meadows H. September 28 and the GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Derby October 12. The track will race Wednesdays through Sundays with the exception of special Monday cards September 2, September 9, October 14 and closing day, November 4. Post time will be 1:15 p.m. PDT daily except for Fridays, when the first race will go off at 6:45 p.m.

**PATTON TO AIRDRIE STUD** Airdrie Stud has purchased Patton (Lord at War {Arg}) from Carolyn Hine and Marilyn Rothstein and the five-year-old has been retired to stand the 1997 breeding season at Airdrie for a fee of \$3,000 live foal. A winner of six of his 18 starts, Patton earned \$237,462 in his racing career. In his first start at two, Patton broke the 5 1/2-furlong track record at Calder, going the distance in 1:04 4/5. After winning his three-year-old debut at Gulfstream by 11 lengths and finishing second to Holy Bull in the GII Hutcheson, Patton was considered a Triple Crown prospect. But, after winning his next start, he had chips removed from both knees and later underwent colic surgery. He made just four starts at four and four starts this year at five, winning the GIII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint March 15 in his next-to-last outing.

With just one start (and one impressive win) under her belt, **Pearl City** (Carson City) has been established as the morning-line favorite in her first GI effort, but Dalias Stewart, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, thinks she more than fits the bill. "She's got a lot of talent," said Stewart. "She's definitely Grade One material." Pearl City made that one start August 16 at Saratoga, and was a runaway 10 1/2-length winner. "We took our time getting her to where she was," said Stewart, "but she stepped up to the plate big-time that day." Gary Stevens, aboard the other D. Wayne Lukas entrant, **Private Pursuit** (Private Account), is back in the saddle for the first time since undergoing rotator cuff surgery in June. All starters carry 121 pounds.

**JAPANESE STALLIONS NOMINATED TO**

**COMMON FUND** Officials of Breeders' Cup Limited and the European Breeders' Fund announced yesterday that nine stallions standing in Japan have been nominated early to its Common Fund program for the 1996 breeding season. Six of the stallions--Carnegie (Ire), Dr. Devious (Ire), Hector Protector, Sunday Silence, Timber Country and Tony Bin (Ire)--stand at Shadai Stallion Station, while Generous (Ire), Forty Niner and Rodrigo de Triano reside at Japan Bloodhorse Breeders Association. Stallions standing outside North or Central America or continental Europe can be nominated to the Common Fund by the payment of a fee equal to the advertised stud fee, with the minimum payment being \$1,000. The final deadline for nominations for the '96 breeding season is December 15, 1996.

**ZAGREB ON CHAMPION TRAIL**

**Zagreb** (Theatrical {Ire}), brilliant six-length winner of the Irish Derby at The Curragh June 30, is right on target to have his prep for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown September 14. The Dermot Weld-trained colt, who races in the silks of Allen Paulson, thrilled his handler in a workout Tuesday. "He's in great form and now we are fairly certain that he will be going next for the Irish Champion," said Weld. "He worked well for (stable jockey) Michael Kinane over a mile and I was delighted with him. His main target is the Arc, for which I see he is now joint-favorite, and that's what we are concentrating on at the moment. But there is obviously the chance he could go to America for the Breeders' Cup or to the Japan Cup later on. Right now, however, we are not looking any further ahead than Leopardstown and Longchamp."

**GLITTERMAN TO KENTUCKY** Eleven-year-old stallion **Glitterman** (Dewan) has been sold to a syndicate and will be moved from Lucas Farm in Summerfield, Florida to Wafare Farm in Lexington, Kentucky to stand the 1997 breeding season. **Glitterman's** most successful runner from his three crops to race has been three-year-old filly **J J'sdream**, a two-time GIII winner who was third in the GI Test S. at Saratoga. **Glitterman** will stand for \$4,000 live foal.

**MAKTOUMS TARGET FINAL CLASSIC** The Maktoum family is making a concerted effort to win Doncaster's St. Leger September 14, the third leg of Britain's Triple Crown. Six of the 21 entries for Britain's final Classic of 1996 are owned by members of the Dubai-based dynasty and it seems that at least five of them are intended runners. **Shantou** (Alleged), the Epsom Derby third, and **Clerkenwell** (Sadler's Wells), successful on his last run in York's Ebor H., are booked to carry Sheikh Mohammed's silks in the G1 event. Derby 10th **Double Leaf** (GB) (Sadler's Wells) will sport the Mana Al Maktoum colors and **Wilawander** (GB) (Nashwan), another recent handicap hero, is to represent Maktoum Al Maktoum. The Godolphin team, meanwhile, is still uncertain about the participation of Epsom Oaks runner-up **Pricket** (Diesis {GB}), but the same stable's **Sharaf Kabeer** (GB) (Machiavellian) will definitely be in the field following his smooth victory in Goodwood's listed March S. last Saturday. Britain's bookmakers, however, think that Epsom Derby second **Dushyantor** (Sadler's Wells) is the leading candidate and make him their 3-1 favorite.
