**SARATOGA SALUTES CIGAR** A crowd of 17,658 was on hand for "Salute to Cigar" day at Saratoga Race Course yesterday afternoon as the great Cigar (Palace Music) first worked six furlongs, then visited the winner's circle where Saratoga Springs Mayor J. Michael O'Connell presented him with a "Key to the City" (actually a large cookie baked in the shape of a key). The six-year-old, who will look to regain his winning ways in the GI Woodward S. at Belmont September 14, worked six furlongs with jockey Jerry Bailey aboard in an easy 1:16.96 after splits of :24.91, :50.65 and 1:03.58. "He got a little shook up," said trainer Bill Mott of his superstar's reaction to the ceremonies. "Maybe he was a little confused, because he's never done anything like this before. But as keyed up as he was, working in 1:16 or so was fine. Once he left the pony, he relaxed." Mott's response to the "Salute" was more positive. "It was amazing how many people were out there," he said. "It made me feel pretty darn good. Maybe something like this has happened before, but not that I've ever seen." Cigar will head back to Belmont at the beginning of next week.

**MEDAALY LODGES CLASSIC CLAIMS** Medaaly (GB) (Highest Honor {Fr}) earned his place in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot September 28 and odds of 33-1 for next year's Epsom Derby with an impressive victory in yesterday's Charterhouse Conditions S. at Sandown Park. The Godolphin-trained colt, a half-brother to high class four-year-old miler **Charnwood Forest (Ire)** (Warning {GB}), was restrained in second early on while eventual third **Conon Falls (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) made the pace. But jockey John Reid encouraged Medaaly to grab a lead with just over two furlongs of this mile event left to run and had only to push at the reins to ensure a smooth three-and-a-half-length defeat of **Imperial President (GB)** (Known Fact). Simon Crisford, racing manager for Godolphin, said: "The Royal Lodge has been Medaaly's target all year and that's where he will go next."

Oath finished well in her debut going six-and-a-half furlongs and relished the extra sixteenth of a mile in her stakes debut. The 4-5 Pearl City and Fabulously Fast hooked up early and were head-and-head through a half in :44.73 and six furlongs in 1:10, but the rapid pace took its toll and Oath, last as they headed around the far turn, came flying at the finish to flash past the embattled leaders in the final strides. "I couldn't say I was confident going in, but I knew that she was a nice filly," said winning trainer Frank Brothers. "I knew we weren't one of the favorites, but I figured she'd be running at the end. We made the decision in the paddock--win, lose or draw--to not take her out of her game. She's not a very fast filly, and we'd live or die with letting her do her own thing." The favorite was off a step slowly, hustled up to contest the pace, then tired late. "All she needed was about another 50 yards to win the race, but the start took that 50 yards out of her," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas.

"Saturday will tell us if he's going to be a sprinter or a nice little horse," said Allen Jerkens of his undefeated phenom **Kelly Kip** (Kipper Kelly). Winner of a \$35,000 maiden claimer three starts back in his debut June 21 at Belmont, he set the five-furlong track record that day in :55 3/5. The dark bay colt has since added wins in the GIII Tremont and the GIII Sanford, the latter by 10 1/2-lengths. Kelly Kip will be asked to stretch out another eighth of a mile here in an attempt to give his Hall of Fame trainer his first Hopeful win. "If Kelly Kip were to win it, it would be right there in my all-time top five races," said Jerkens.

Favorite MOUNT KAMET (GB) (Seattle Dancer) was quickest out of the stalls, but Brave Act grabbed an advantage after the first furlong. He was never subsequently headed despite the powerful finish of runner-up Falkenham (GB) and the late challenge of Air Express (Ire), and revealed a great deal of courage when hanging on for a short-head victory. Bookmakers offered odds of 33-1 on Brave Act to win next year's 2000 Guineas, but trainer Sir Mark Prescott does not consider that to be terribly realistic. Prescott, having now won three Group races in eight days, said: "This race was as far as we had planned with Brave Act. We came here because he'd had more experience than most of his rivals and he was just that bit tougher than the others. I would like to try him over a mile next time. But he wouldn't be as good as Red Camellia (Prescott's unbeaten 1000 Guineas second-favorite) at home."
