HOPEFUL FAVORITE GOES UP IN

“SMOKE” Before the race, the question was “What is a smoke glacken?,” but after he humbled the field in the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Saturday, the answer is obvious. **Smoke Glacken** (Two Punch) is all race horse. Favored **Kelly Kip** (Kipper Kelly) had won the six-furlong GIII Sanford with something left, galloping away from the field to dash under the finish line 10 ½ lengths in front. But the extra eighth of yesterday’s Hopeful proved more than the 4-5 favorite could handle as the equally speedy Smoke Glacken looked him in the eye through a half in :44.23, then powered away to an eye-catching nine-length victory as his previously undefeated rival faded to seventh. Successful in Monmouth’s Tyro S. and GII Sapling, the winner is now four-for-five. “The morning after the Sapling, he was a real arrogant kind of horse,” said his trainer, Henry Carroll. “He knew what he had done. He was real vibrant and full of himself--he was doing everything right. We thought about waiting for the Futurity, but this seemed to be the natural progression and we decided to take a chance. Today was a real test--he really crossed the bridge. I wouldn’t trade horses with anyone in the country.” The origin of his name is still a mystery, but the Maryland-bred colt will now likely point for the GI Futurity at Belmont Park September 15. Plans for the obscurely bred Kelly Kip are up in the air. The Allen Jerkens charge, who could have been had for \$35,000 in his first start against maiden claimers, tired badly and beat just one horse, finishing more than 26 lengths behind victor. “It’s hard to believe he gave it up so early,” said Jerkens. “He has been training so well. I’m very disappointed and I don’t know what I’m going to do with him now.”

EXOTIC WOOD INJURED Top distaffer **Exotic Wood** (Rahy) suffered an injury to her left foreleg during morning exercise Friday which will force her to miss this afternoon’s Chula Vista H. at Del Mar. The four-year-old, front-running winner of the GI Go For Wand S. at Saratoga in her latest start and eight-for-nine lifetime, was the heavy favorite in the Grade II event. “She strained something, probably while galloping (Friday),” said her trainer, Ron Ellis. “There’s swelling at the ankle of the left front leg. She couldn’t gallop (Saturday). We’re treating her with anti-inflammatories.” The filly will be x-rayed to determine the exact nature of the injury.

Smoke Glacken had made his first four starts at the Jersey Shore’s Monmouth Park, winning three of them, and had capped off his seaside string with a win in the GII Sapling August 17. But the grey was not expected to offer a strong challenge to the crowd’s overwhelming choice, 4-5 **KELLY KIP** (Kipper Kelly), and was let go at generous odds as the third favorite in the field. On the pace in all of his previous outings, the 7-1 chance did not take back this time, dueling the top pick through fast early fractions; Kelly Kip was done after the half, leaving Smoke Glacken to strut his stuff down the stretch unchallenged. “He was well within himself,” said jockey Craig Perret. “We were going in :21 and :44, but it was easy for him. He’s a big, long-striding horse--other horses have to work to go that fast, but he doesn’t.” The favorite, who had recorded two of his three victories over wet tracks, had nothing left for the finish. “I knew going into the turn I was in trouble,” said jockey Jean-Luc Samyn. “The track being so dry today probably didn’t help him.”

Dernier Empereur, a champion in France, was winless in his first four Stateside starts before breaking through with a victory in the restricted Escondido H. over this course and distance last time out. Showing his affinity for the route once again, the chestnut bided his time in sixth for a mile as URGENT REQUEST (IRE) (Rainbow Quest) set the pace with as many as 12 lengths on the field early; moving to third as they straightened for home, he wore down the 3-5 favorite Talloires late to take his second in a row. "They told me before his last race that if he didn't run good, they were going to retire him," said winning jockey Pat Valenzuela. "After he won there, I said, 'don't you dare!' He really has that kick the last quarter. It feels great." Trainer Ben Cecil said the six-year-old would now head for the \$1 million Canadian International at Woodbine September 29, with an eye towards the GI Breeders' Cup Turf October 26.

Visiting his fifth track in his last five starts, Ops Smile followed a win in the restricted Find S. at Pimlico with his first-ever graded score. Overmatched in the GI Caesars International three starts back, the roan handled Gill foes decisively, sitting last for a half before launching a bid that carried him to a handy win under jockey Edgar Prado. "Edgar has ridden him and knows him, but I told him, 'don't get fooled'--in spite of the fact it's a small field, you can't rush this horse. You have to let him settle and make his run late." The Maryland-bred goes next in the Maryland Million October 12.
