### SMART STRIKE FOR MEADOWLANDS CUP

**Smart Strike** (Mr. Prospector), undefeated on the year and winner of the GI Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park last time out, is training well and will make his next appearance in the GI Buick Meadowlands Cup at the Meadowlands October 4. "He came out of the Iselin in great shape," said trainer Mark Frostad. "He'll work next weekend here and we'll try to slow him down a little, but that's not an easy task." The four-year-old, a half-brother to Canadian Horse of the Year and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Dance Smartly, prepped for the Iselin with five furlongs in :57 2/5. Jockey Craig Perret replaced the injured Sandy Hawley on the colt for the Iselin, but Frostad said that a decision on which rider will be in the saddle at the Meadowlands has not yet been reached.

**TURFWAY OPENS WEDNESDAY** Turfway Park will stage its richest meet in track history when the fall season begins Wednesday, September 4. With a daily purse distribution of more than \$250,000, the Florence, Kentucky track will offer the second-highest purse structure in the country during the 23-day meeting. The highlight of the Fall Meet will be the third running of the \$1,250,000 Kentucky Cup Day of Champions, set for Saturday, September 21, which features the \$50,000 Starter S., \$100,000 Juvenile Fillies, GI \$100,000 Juvenile, GI \$200,000 Sprint, GI \$300,000 Turfway Breeders' Cup and GI \$500,000 Classic. The Kentucky Cup purses have been increased 25 percent for this year's edition, and the Sprint and Classic have been awarded graded status for the first time. The Fall Meet runs through Friday, October 4. Post time for Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays is 7:00 p.m., while the action gets underway at 1:00 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays. Post time for Kentucky Cup Day is 12:20 p.m.

Newmarket raider Pilsudski gave jockey Walter Swinburn his first Group 1 success since his return from serious injury when he pulled off a surprise victory here. Last year's winner Germany set out to make all the running and still led entering the final furlong, but Swinburn gradually closed the gap with Pilsudski, taking control with 100 meters to run and going on to score in course-equaling time. The winning jockey said after the race: "Pilsudski is a very good horse and improving all the time. One of his major attributes is that he can act on any going." Frankie Dettori said of Germany, whose next target is the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe: "With more cut in the ground, I think he would have won. This was too fast for him to be at his best."

Grade I winner of the Beverly Hills H. over the Hollywood turf last out and two-for-two in the States since shipping up from South America, Different (Arg) followed in the hoofsteps of McAnally-trained countrymates Bayakoa and Paseana to win this event as the overwhelming favorite. Last in the field reduced to four by the scratch of morning-line choice EXOTIC WOOD (Rahy), she found herself in traffic from the top of the stretch to the final sixteenth but found room between rivals in the final yards and drew away once clear. "She was in a lot of trouble," said trainer Ron McAnally. "She had no place to go--those guys were trapping her. I don't know how Chris (McCarron) found his way through there, but he did."

Shortening up after a win in the 10-furlong GII New York H. and a third-place finish in the 11-furlong Glens Falls S. last time she ran, Electric Society (Ire) was not fancied by the fans to pick up her third graded-stakes win of the year. The dark bay broke sharply but was taken in hand by jockey Mike Smith, settling near the back of the pack to the far turn; she circled the field as they rounded the final bend and outfinished longshot Powder Bowl to take a tight photo. "We were a little concerned that this might be a little short for her, but we got a good pace up front for her to run at," said the meet's second-leading trainer John Kimmel, winning his second race of the day and his 17th at the meet. "Mike did a good job keeping her in the clear. I couldn't tell if she got it--it was very close. I was just hoping and praying." The winner will make her next start in the GI Flower Bowl H. October 12. The 7-5 favorite APOLDA (Theatrical {Ire}) was with the leaders for six furlongs but dropped back in the drive and finished seventh.

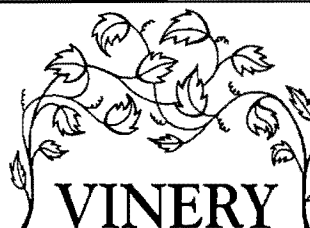
