FASTNESS RETIRED Fastness (Ire) (Rousillon), two-time winner of Del Mar's GI Eddie Read H., has been retired. "He sustained an injury to his right front tendon," trainer Jenine Sahadi said yesterday morning. "He had worked well on Thursday and galloped out fine. We took the bandages off yesterday (Sunday) and found it. There was a slight filling, and we scanned it, and there is some damage there. So he is retired as of right now." The six-year-old was undefeated since finishing second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile, winning the GI Citation in his last start at five and three starts this year, the GIII Inglewood, the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile and the GI Eddie Read in his last start Aug. 4. Fastness retires with nine wins in 24 starts and earnings of \$1,580,576.

SARATOGA MEET POSTS GAINS The on-track attendance and total handle at the 1996 Saratoga Race Course meet, which ended yesterday after continuing through the Labor Day weekend for the first time, showed significant gains over last year's figures while the on-track handle dropped only slightly. Attendance rose 6.6 percent, while total handle was up 7.4 percent; the total daily average handle was a North American record \$12.9 million. "I thought the racing was excellent," said Kenny Noe Jr., the New York Racing Association's President and Chairman of the Board. "The stakes racing really came up good. I also think the fans appreciated some of the improvements we made."

PRINCE OF THIEVES PUT DOWN Prince Of Thieves (Hansel), third in this year's Kentucky Derby and runner-up in the GI Swaps S. before finishing fifth in the GI Jim Dandy S. last time out, broke down as the field headed onto the backstretch of yesterday's GIII Pennsylvania Derby; vanned off the track, the three-year-old was later humanely destroyed. The three-quarter brother to last year's Preakness S. winner and 1994 two-year-old champion Timber Country fractured a sesamoid in his right front leg. The D. Wayne Lukas trainee, a winner of two of his 11 starts and \$368,474, was the 5-2 second choice in Sunday's race. Jockey Gary Stevens, who returned to riding Friday after undergoing rotator cuff surgery, was aboard the colt. "I'm a little sore--he shook me pretty hard," said Stevens. "I'm upset. I'm glad to be back, but it just wasn't a good weekend to come back."

Langfuhr captured an optional claiming allowance on the dirt at Woodbine in his most recent appearance and shipped down to Saratoga looking for his first stakes score. Off the board at 59-1 in the grassy GIII Poker S. in his last trip to New York, the bay was the rank outsider in this field of seven but took advantage of a hot early pace to close from sixth for the win. "He's never been defeated at seven furlongs (now five-for-five) and we've made mistakes by running him shorter," said owner/breeder Gustav Schickedanz. "From now on, he'll go seven." Favored Top Account spotted the field 10 lengths at the break but came flying at the finish to just miss. "I think he was the best today but he nearly dwelt at the start," said his rider, Pat Day. "To come up a neck short after losing that much ground was a great effort."

SARATOGA SEND-OFF Bill Mott sent out his 20th winner of the meet yesterday at Saratoga, which is believed to be a record at the track. Allen Jerkens had 19 winners during a 24-day meet in 1972, but no records were available for meets prior to 1958. Mott squeaked out the victory in the trainer standings over John Kimmel, who finished with 18 winners. The difference was an Aug. 16 allowance race when the Kimmel-trained **Blissful State** (Buckaroo) was disqualified and the Mott-trained **Spanos** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) was placed first. "That's the way it goes, I guess," Mott said. "I've been taken down in \$500,000 races. It was a good, gallant effort on Mr. Kimmel's part. He did a good job and his horses ran very well." It was Mott's second straight training title; jockey Jerry Bailey won his third Saratoga rider's title.

JOCKEY PENNA INJURED Jockey Dave Penna was injured Monday afternoon in a spill at Woodbine. The 37-year-old New York native was riding **Poetry Miss** (Tasso) when the two-year-old filly reared and fell on him just before the start of Woodbine's fourth race. He was sent to Sunnybrook Medical Centre in Toronto where x-rays revealed a fracture of the socket bone of the left hip joint and a broken pelvis bone on the left side. "When the horse fell on Dave, the femur was driven up into the socket of the left hip joint which caused the fracture," said Dr. Lou Teglas, Woodbine's track doctor. Penna is currently eighth in the rider standings at the Canadian track with 53 wins.

MONMOUTH MEET CLOSSES The 1996 Monmouth Park racing season ended its 72-day run yesterday with on-track attendance up nearly four percent and total handle increasing 21 percent. For the first time in New Jersey racing history, Thoroughbred or harness, daily average handle was over \$4 million, at \$4,082,556 for the meet. Daily average attendance was 9,917, compared to 9,566 in 1995, a 3.7 percent increase, while average on-track handle jumped 6.5 percent to \$1.68 million against \$1.57 million last season. "It was a solid mix of strong racing, good weather and hard work," said Hal Handel, executive vice president and chief operating officer of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "The public responded to Monmouth Park as a source of solid racing and family entertainment." On the racetrack, jockey Joe Bravo won an unprecedented sixth straight riding title while Juan Serey took his second straight trainer's title. The battle for leading owner went down to closing day of the meet with James Riccio edging Ed Broome, 18-17. The Oceanport oval will open Tuesday for full-card simulcasting through the winter.

CELTIC SWING'S STUD CAREER STARTS

IN ENGLAND England's Champion two-year-old colt of 1994 **Celtic Swing** (GB) (Damister) will begin his stallion career at the National Stud in Newmarket, England, according to a report in Monday's *The Sporting Life*. The four-year-old's owner, Peter Savill had received several offers but decided not to sell the horse. Instead, Celtic Swing will be moved to Savill's new stud in Ireland once it is completed. While in England, the '95 French Derby winner will stand for \$10,074, or \$8,524 for breeders who send two or more mares, or who send mares who have either earned black type or produced a black-type performer.

MELBOURNE CUP WEIGHTS RELEASED

Godolphin-owned **Classic Cliche** (Ire) (Salse), winner of the 1995 Doncaster St. Leger and this year's Ascot Gold Cup, is the top weight at 136 pounds for this year's \$1,764,149 G1 Melbourne Cup, a handicap to be run over two miles at Flemington Tuesday, November 5. **Double Trigger** (Ire) (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), second in the Ascot Gold Cup, is in at 132 pounds. Of the American horses nominated, Richard Mandella's **Sandpit** (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}), third in last week's Arlington Million, was weighted at 130 pounds, while Million runner-up **Awad** (Caveat) is at 128 pounds. **Dare And Go** (Alydar), conqueror of Cigar in Del Mar's Pacific Classic, has been allocated 125 pounds. Two of the last three winners of the event, **Doriemus** (NZ) (Norman Pentaquod), 1995, and **Vintage Crop** (Ire) (Rousillon), 1993, have both been given 128 pounds.

OCTAGONAL BEATEN AGAIN

Australia's 1995/96 Horse Of The Year **Octagonal** (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), who finished only sixth to Poetic King in the recent G1 Manikato S. in Melbourne, fared even worse when he contested last weekend's G2 Memsie S. over seven furlongs at Caulfield. Ridden again by Darren Gauci, the John Hawkes trainee, sent off the 7/4 favourite, could finish only seventh behind the five-year-old **Sir Boom** (Aus) (Jugah), a 7/1 shot. John Hawkes said: "Octagonal looks well, his attitude is great and he has never been better. I thought his run in the Manikato was very very good, and I have to admit that I thought he would win. But he disappointed today. He was flat all the way. He was a bit one-paced and didn't finish it off like I thought he would. We'll just have to wait until he gets to the mile-and-a-quarter or a mile-and-a-half races, for which he is being trained."

HAYDOCK PARK SPRINT CUP-G1, 3yo/up, 6fT

French-based trainer John Hammond will be hoping to lift his third Haydock Park Sprint Cup when **Miesque's Son** (Mr. Prospector) jets into Britain for the Group One event. Hammond has already taken the prize with **Polar Falcon** and **Cherokee Rose** (Ire). A disappointment came when Mark Johnston, trainer of **Branston Abby** (Ire) (Risk Me {Fr}), announced that the mare will miss Saturday's test. She was found to be sick Sunday night and is undergoing treatment with antibiotics. Johnston said: "It is really disappointing as this will be her last season on the racecourse. But we cannot make any plans until she has fully recovered." Also listed on the five-day entries, published yesterday, were: **Blue Duster** (Danzig), **Catch The Blues** (Ire) (Bluebird), **Cool Jazz** (GB) (Lead On Time), **Danehill Dancer** (Ire) (Danehill), **Hever Golf Rose** (GB) (Efisio {GB}), **Iktamal** (Danzig Connection), **Leap For Joy** (GB) (Sharpo {GB}), **Lucayan Prince** (Fast Play), **Mind Games** (GB) (Puissance {GB}), **Rambling Bear** (GB) (Sharrod), **Royal Applause** (GB) (Waaajib {Ire}), and **Titus Livius** (Fr) (Machiavellian).

Sunday, Longchamp, France

PRIX DU MOULIN DE LONGCHAMP-G1, \$301,745, 3yo/up, 1mT

Four of the best milers in Europe will line up Sunday for the Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Heading the quartet is Irish 2000 Guineas winner **Spinning World** (Nureyev), the Jonathan Pease-trained three-year-old who also won the G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois over a mile at Deauville. The Aga Khan's three-year-old **Ashkalani** (Ire) (Soviet Star), who has not run since being narrowly beaten by **Bijou d'Inde** in the G1 St James' Palace S. over a mile at the Royal Ascot meeting, is also an intended runner. Back in May **Ashkalani**, trained by Alain de Royer-Dupre, beat **Spinning World** in the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) over a mile at Longchamp. Trainer Elie Lellouche will saddle the 3-year-old filly **Shake The Yoke** (GB) (Caerleon), who was an unlucky loser of the Poule d'Essai des Poulaches (French 1000 Guineas) in May, but went on to win the G1 Coronation S. over a mile at Royal Ascot. She has not run since that day in June. Lellouche also intends to run the four-year-old filly **Shaanxi** (Zilzal), winner in early August of the G2 Prix d'Astarte over a mile at Deauville and then third to **Spinning World** in the Prix Jacques Le Marois two weeks later.

Aaron Gryder, Arlington's leading jockey the last two years and currently third in the standings, left after Monday's program to return to the Kentucky circuit. But before he departed, Gryder issued a statement explaining why he is taking the Illinois Racing Board to Cook County Circuit Court for sustaining the five-day suspension handed out by the Arlington stewards for his ride on Mystic Knight in the GII American Derby July 21. "With no notice whatsoever, I was stripped of my rights to bring any witnesses to speak on my behalf, have a Jockeys' Guild representative or director stand with me, or to retain the services of an attorney," Gryder said, referring to the hearing held the day after the American Derby. According to the jockey, state steward Rene Riera later told him privately that he was "surprised and disappointed" that Gryder has exercised his right to appeal to the Board. "I felt like Mr. Riera was trying to intimidate or coerce me," said Gryder.
