**JOCKEY RAYMOND GARRY KILLED** Veteran jockey Raymond Garry was killed in a spill Sunday at the Northampton Fair in Massachusetts. He was 39. Garry was aboard a horse named **Highblast** (High Brite) in the last race on the card and fell when the five-year-old stumbled leaving the backstretch. Garry was taken to Cooley Dickinson Hospital at 6:25 p.m. and died later that evening. The cause of death was not reported. Garry, a native of Lincoln, Rhode Island, rode on the Suffolk Downs--Rockingham Park circuit.

**SANDPIT INJURED** Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}), third in the GI Arlington Million in his last start Aug. 25, came out of the race with a curb injury, trainer Richard Mandella told the *Daily Racing Form* Saturday. "It's kind of like popping a splint," Mandella said. "We'll have to look at that. It might put the Oak Tree (Turf Championship Oct. 6) in jeopardy." Sandpit, winner of this year's GI Hollywood Turf H. and GI Caesars International H., has won 12 of 31 starts and \$2,633,301.

**PHARMA RETIRED** The top grass mare **Pharma** (Theatrical {Ire}), back-to-back winner of the GI Santa Ana H. at Santa Anita and the GI Wilshire H. at Hollywood Park in March and May, has been retired, her co-owner Marty Wygod told the *Daily Racing Form* Saturday. The five-year-old mare, who was bred by Allen Paulson and is co-owned by Paulson and Wygod, made her final start in the June 9 GI Gamely H. at Hollywood, finishing fifth. "I tried to work her a couple of times on the soft turf, but I didn't like the way she worked," said her trainer Ron Ellis. Pharma won seven of 16 career outings for earnings of \$387,659.

**GODOLPHIN INVADES SWEDEN** Godolphin is set to spread its international net to another new country when **Overbury (Ire)** (Caerleon) tackles next Sunday's G3 Stockholm Cup at Taby Racecourse in Sweden. The Dubai-based team has already enjoyed success right across the globe, but Scandinavia is a fresh target for their powerful string. A spokeswoman for Godolphin said Tuesday, "The plan is for Overbury to run in the Stockholm Cup and Frankie Dettori will ride him. It will be the first time Godolphin has had a runner in Sweden." Overbury, trained by David Loder before joining the Saeed bin Suroor stable, is himself an experienced traveller. He finished runner-up in both the G1 Derby Italiano at Rome and the G1 Deutsches Derby in Hamburg before getting up on the line to dead-heat for the win in the GII American Derby at Arlington in 1994. This year his campaign has included two outings in Dubai, a win in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin in Hong Kong and a visit to France for the G3 Grand Prix de Vichy, in which he finished seventh.

**FASIG-TIPTON ANNOUNCES EASTERN FALL YEARLING SALE FORMAT**

Following the two 1996 Grade I successes at Saratoga for its sales graduates **Urbane** (Citidancer) and **Smoke Glacken** (Two Punch), Fasig-Tipton Midlantic yesterday announced the format for its upcoming Eastern Fall Yearling Sale. A record number of 480 yearlings are catalogued for the two-day auction, to be held at Timonium, Maryland Monday, Sept. 30 and Tuesday, Oct. 1. With approximately 240 offerings each day, the opening day features a select session of 180 yearlings. Catalogues will be available from all Fasig-Tipton offices Wednesday, Sept. 11.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.
