JOSEPHINE ABERCROMBIE NAMED TOBA STATE BREEDER OF THE YEAR

Josephine Abercrombie, owner of Pin Oak Stud near Midway, Kentucky, was named the recipient of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association State Breeder of the Year Award at the National Breeders Awards Dinner held Friday night at Gainsborough Farm near Lexington. The dinner, sponsored by TOBA, was attended by a sell-out crowd of more than 750. Breeders from 32 states, selected by their peers in their home states, were honored at Friday's event; Abercrombie was presented the overall award by TOBA Chairman of the Board Ron Kirk. "I am so thrilled by this honor," said Mrs. Abercrombie. "It was a surprise. I learned that no Kentuckian had won it before, so that made it extra special." The Pin Oak Stud representatives were led last year by Canadian Horse of the Year **Peaks and Valleys** (Mt. Livermore) and multiple graded-stakes winner **Green Means Go** (Green Dancer). Previous recipients include Richard Bomze (New York, 1992), John Weber (Florida, 1993), Robert Meyerhoff (Maryland, 1994), and Martin Wygod (California, 1995).

MUTAKDDIM TO HILL 'N' DALE FARMS John G. Sikura of Lexington's Hill 'n' Dale Farms announced yesterday the purchase of **Mutakddim** (Seeking the Gold) from Shadwell Farm. The five-year-old, a winner at two, three and four, captured the listed John of Gaunt S. and placed in the G2 Sandown Mile, G3 Charlton Hunt Supreme S. and G3 Prix Perth. From the immediate family of Woodman and Private Account, he will stand for a fee of \$5,000, live foal. "We are very excited about Mutkaddim and have a very receptive group of breeders ready to join us in syndicating him," said Sikura of the \$200,000 Keeneland July yearling. "He is a great-looking stallion prospect with the type of pedigree you dream about."

Four-year-old **Miesque's Son** (Mr. Prospector) was slow to come to hand but has shown promise in his last two starts, breaking his maiden in the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis, then finishing second by a length-and-a-half to this year's dominant sprinter Anabaa in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest last time out.

The California Horse Racing Board will receive an award from the American Association of Equine Practitioners in recognition of the Board's leadership in developing a program to reduce and prevent catastrophic injuries and other risks to racehorses. The CHRB will be honored December 10 with the inaugural Equine Welfare Award during the AAEP convention in Denver. The new award will be bestowed annually to non-veterinary organizations or individuals who have demonstrated exceptional compassion for or developed regulations and guidelines to benefit the welfare of horses.

Local News: England

Classic Cliche (Ire) (Salse), forced to miss today's G3 September S. at Kempton after suffering a minor setback, showed himself still very much on the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe trail when working well in Newmarket yesterday. This year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup winner was pulled out of this afternoon's event because a slight infection caused him to miss a crucial gallop a week ago. But, partnered by dual British champion jockey Frankie Dettori and accompanied by Epsom Oaks second **Pricket** (Diesis {GB}) and a lead horse, he pleased connections when working on Newmarket's Trial Ground, and could be back for next Sunday's Prix Foy, a Group Three test over the Arc course and distance of a mile and a half at Longchamp.

One So Wonderful (GB) (Nashwan) took little time in paying back some of her price-tag when making an impressive first appearance in the Milcars Fillies Conditions S. at Kempton Park yesterday afternoon. This half-sister to 1992 G2 Dante S. hero Alnasr Alwasheek (GB) (Sadler's Wells), who races in the colors of Helena Springfield Limited, had cost \$385,203 as a yearling. But she might look a bargain at the price if she makes the physical improvement her trainer Luca Cumani expects from her over the winter. One So Wonderful was always travelling well and, when jockey Oscar Urbina asked her to quicken some 300 yards from the wire, the response was immediate and Cumani's charge eased home by three-and-a-half lengths. The Newmarket-based handler said: "She is very relaxed and was going nicely throughout the race. She did it well and I was very pleased with this performance. She is in the (G1) Fillies' Mile (at Ascot September 28), but I will be discussing it with the owners before making any decisions about her next race. She is still quite leggy, though, and should improve a lot."

Local News: Australia

The inaugural 1996 Australian Two-Year-Old Breeze Up Sale, conducted Friday, saw 89 lots sell for \$2,084,221, an average of \$23,419. Two juveniles brought bids of \$102,613 to top the sale: a colt by Polish Patriot out of Cash Tip (Aus) consigned by Widden Stud went to Bill Mitchell on behalf of Hong Kong trainer John Moore; and a colt by Bluebird out of G1 winner Deck The Halls (Aus) offered by Wellington Bloodstock was purchased by Doncaster Bloodstock's Les Young. "The sale has had an enormous buyers support both Australia-wide and from Singapore, Malaysia, Macao and Hong Kong," declared Managing Director Reg Inglis. "We are very pleased with the results of this inaugural...sale, and it will definitely become a regular feature on our annual sales calendar."

The filly **Merlene (Aus)** (Danehill), winner of the G1 Golden Slipper in Sydney in March, has been allocated 132 pounds in the official 1995/96 Australian Classifications for two-year-olds, three pounds ahead of the highest-rated male, **Paint (Aus)** (Raami {GB}). Horse of the Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) was allocated 139 pounds on the Classifications for three-year-olds over seven furlongs to a mile and a quarter.
