### RECORD KEENELAND SEPTEMBER

### SALE STARTS MONDAY

A record 3,901 yearlings have been catalogued for this year's Keeneland September Yearling Sale, which opens Monday and runs 11 days through September 19. This year's offering tops the old mark of 3,705 set last year, and represents more than 11 percent of North America's total foal crop for 1995, which numbered 35,200. The catalogue consists of 2,060 colts, 1,840 fillies and one gelding. The 53-year-old auction set records last year for gross sales, average and number of horses sold; a total of 2,913 yearlings sold for \$130,121,300, up 24 percent from 1994. The 1995 average of \$43,990 showed an increase of 18.3 percent. Leading sires represented in the sale include A.P. Indy, Danzig, Deputy Minister, Forty Niner, Gone West, Kingmambo, Mr. Prospector, Nureyev, Pleasant Colony, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold, Storm Bird, Storm Cat and Unbridled. The first day of the sale will offer full-brothers to Canadian champion Free At Last (Wild Again) and to champion Wilderness Song (Wild Again); a half-sister to champion and French Classic winner Culture Vulture (Timeless Moment) by Deputy Minister; a half-brother to Preakness winner Pine Bluff (Danzig) by Seattle Slew; a half-sister to Belmont Stakes winner Colonial Affair (Pleasant Colony) by St. Jovite; a half-brother to Canadian champion Honky Tonk Tune (Cure the Blues) by Gone West; a half-brother to champion Prairie Bayou (Little Missouri) by Danzig; a full-brother to Irish champion Zoman (Affirmed); and a full-brother to 1996 MGISW Twice The Vice (Vice Regent). "There's a great deal of enthusiasm about the sale among both sellers and buyers," said Director of Sales Rogers Beasley. "The selected yearling sales were strong, and there's an abundance of quality in this year's catalogue." Two Keeneland September graduates captured classic races this year, with Editor's Note (Forty Niner), a \$125,000 purchase in 1994, taking the Belmont Stakes and Pike Place Dancer (Seattle Dancer), a \$40,000 purchase that same year, winning the Kentucky Oaks. The September Yearling Sale will be telecast live via satellite for the first time this year; the broadcast can be accessed at Telstar 402R, Transponder 18. Sessions start daily at 10:00 a.m.

Iktamal's powerful late surge proved a fitting climax to a thrilling renewal of the Group One Haydock Park Sprint Cup. The speed division in Britain this year may be short of an obvious star, but that has made for a series of hard-fought events. This was another, with first ROYAL APPLAUSE (GB) (Waajib {Ire}) and then HEVER GOLF ROSE (GB) (Efisio {GB}) reaching the front and setting a very hot pace. Blue Duster was next to lead and, after she had established a definite advantage with a furlong and a half to run, it seemed she might achieve some compensation for her disappointing showing a month ago in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. It was not quite to be, though, as Iktamal, fourth in the Maurice de Gheest, was restrained in the pack early on by jockey Willie Ryan, then somehow found a clear route through inside the final furlong and grabbed the prize in the dying strides. Trainer Ed Dunlop was absent --he is at the Keeneland Sales--but Joe Mercer, racing manager to owner Maktoum Al Maktoum, said: "This horse thrives on racing and is effective over both this six furlongs and over seven. I think he may even stay a mile in time and I hope he'll remain in training as a five-year-old." **Weekend Results cont. p2**
