### MIESQUE'S SON TO THREE CHIMNEYS FARM

Three Chimneys Farm announced Sunday that **Miesque's Son** (Mr. Prospector) will stand stud at the Midway, Kentucky farm in 1997. Farm owner Robert Clay said an agreement has been reached to syndicate the four-year-old at Three Chimneys upon his retirement from racing at the end of this year. Alan Cooper, racing manager for owner/breeder the Niarchos family, who will retain an interest in Miesque's Son, said, "Miesque's Son has proven himself among the top sprinters in Europe, and we are delighted he will be standing at Three Chimneys." The Kentucky-bred colt won the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis at Evry July 12, then followed with a second-place finish in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville in his last outing Aug. 11. He is the third foal and the third group stakes winner out of the multiple champion mare Miesque. His full-brother Kingmambo won three Group 1 events in France, including the French 2000 Guineas, and his half-sister East of the Moon, by Private Account, also accounted for a trio of French Group 1 races, including the French 1000 Guineas and French Oaks. "Miesque has already become arguably one of the best broodmares in the world today," said Robert Clay. "Kingmambo is off to a terrific start at stud and we are very pleased to have this illustriously-connected son of Mr. Prospector join our stallion roster." The stud fee for Miesque's Son will be announced later this year.

### KIRI'S CLOWN'S OWNERS APPEAL

**DISQUALIFICATION** The owners of **Kiri's Clown** (Foolish Pleasure) have filed an appeal with the New York State Racing and Wagering Board over the decision by New York Racing Association stewards to disqualify their horse from first in Saturday's GIII Belmont Breeders' Cup H., trainer Phil Johnson reported yesterday. Kiri's Clown crossed the line a neck in front of **Gentleman Beau** (Beau Genius), but was taken down and placed third for allegedly interfering with **Volochine (Ire)** (Soviet Star) in deep stretch. Volochine crossed the wire third and was placed second. "I just think it was a bad call," Johnson said. "As far as appealing it goes, it's the owners' call and I don't disagree with them. They're good owners and they're not emotional people. I'm not hopeful (the decision will be reversed), but if there's a fair hearing there's a chance." Kiri's Clown is owned by his breeders, Gardner F. Landon and Mary Sullivan.

My Flag, trapped on the turn behind a slow pace in the GI Alabama going a mile and a quarter last time out, rallied late but came up 4 1/2 lengths short, finishing third as the 4-5 favorite. Sent off at 3-5 this time, the regally bred miss was last through a rapid six furlongs in 1:09.90 and this time found herself with plenty of running room late, swinging wide for the stretch drive to overtake Escena and draw clear. "I was glad to see some things going her way," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "In her last race we didn't catch a pace and she was left with way too much to do. I was very pleased with the way she ran." Added winning jockey Jerry Bailey, "I'm of the theory that a mile and an eighth is better for her simply because there's more speed in those races, ensuring a legitimate pace that helps string the field out. The big turns here probably help her as well. All she needs is a place to run." The winner will make her next start in the GI Beldame October 6.

The Aga Khan's colt Ashkalani confirmed his position as France's top miler with an impressive victory here. Winner of the French 2000 Guineas in May, the colt was then beaten in the St. James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot in June and had not run since. He raced in fifth early on as METAPHOR (Woodman), in as pacemaker for Spinning World, went some 20 lengths clear of the field, with CARLING (FR) (Garde Royale {GB}) leading the pack. At the top of the straight Carling took over, but was soon challenged by Spinning World and Ashkalani, who was simply cruising on the outside. With a furlong and a half to run Ashkalani hit the front and went on to score, while the filly Shake The Yoke, who suffered traffic problems two furlongs out, finished strongly to be only a short head back in third. The Aga Khan, owner/breeder of the winner, said, "Obviously, based on his form in the Poulains (2000 Guineas), Ashkalani is still improving. The Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot (over a mile Sept. 28) is a definite possibility now and then possibly the Breeders' Cup Mile. But we are going to take one race at a time. I am not sure if he will stay in training as a four-year-old." Winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "Ashkalani is really special, out of this world. He is possibly the best I have ever trained. He is a very handy type, who has to be waited with off a strong pace. He is a pleasure to train. He will definitely run in the Queen Elizabeth II S., but I am not keen to take him to the Breeders' Cup Mile." Definitely heading for the Breeders' Cup Mile and missing the Queen Elizabeth II is Spinning World. The Niarchos Family's racing manager Alan Cooper said, "We're very pleased with the horse, there were no excuses. The horse needs to be fresh to be at his best, so we will miss Ascot and go straight for the Breeders' Cup." Another possible for the Breeders' Cup Mile is Shake The Yoke, whose

trainer Elie Lellouche said, "If she had not had traffic problems, she would definitely have been second, but might not have caught the winner. But I am very pleased with her, as she had not run for a long time. I would like to go to the Queen Elizabeth II, but I have to talk to Mr Hughes, her owner, and he wants her to go direct to the Breeders' Cup Mile. She may run in both, as she needs to have a race before Woodbine, as she needs the competition."

Bianca Nera won her third race in less than a month when producing a strong late run to take this Group 1 event. The David Loder-trainee collected a maiden event at Beverley in her career debut August 15. Then, following her subsequent success in York's G2 Lower S., she was supplemented here and her connections can surely have few regrets about paying the \$19,374 late entry fee. PEACE MELODY (IRE) (Classic Music) made the early pace. But she was overtaken by Ryafan after a half mile and, at that same point, Azra began to close on the leaders. The eventual second and third seemed to have the race between them with about a furlong to run. However, having been restrained in the rear for the first three furlongs and still looking for room to put in a challenge, Bianca Nera slowly narrowed their advantage. With only 150 yards left, winning jockey Kevin Darley switched sharply to the left, found a gap and was through in a few strides to register a cozy win despite the traffic problems. Loder said, "We came here because I didn't think she had enough natural speed to aim at the Cheveley Park S. (six furlongs) and I didn't really want to run her over a mile this year. So, even though it meant she had to have three runs pretty close together, it was the ideal trip for her."

Dramatic Gold's last stakes victory came 16 starts ago in the GII Molson Million in September, 1994. Fourth to Dare and Go in the GI Pacific Classic in his last outing Aug. 10, the bay was sent straight to the lead here, set fractions of :23.2/5, :47 1/5, 1:11 and 1:22 3/5 on the front end and held on by a neck to defeat 3-5 favorite Alphabet Soup, who won this race a year ago. "This race just set up tactically too good for my horse," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux, who was riding Dramatic Gold for the first time. "He got to gallop along up front and you aren't going to beat him if he does that." Winning trainer David Hofmans added, "I've been touting this horse all week. I thought he would be dangerous. I don't know what it is about being down here. Maybe it's the sea air. He seems rejuvenated. He can run with anybody at a mile. Beyond that he's a little suspect. But at a mile, he's very tough." Alphabet Soup chased the winner in second from gate to wire, but was never able to pass him. "When we turned for home, my horse fired," said Alphabet Soup's regular jockey Chris Antley. "But so did the winner. What could I do? He (Dramatic Gold) had himself an easy lead and he was the winner because of it."
