STORM CAT COLT TOPS KEENELAND

OPENER The 1996 Keeneland September Yearling Sale kicked off yesterday with 264 yearlings selling for a gross of \$36,786,000 and an average of \$139,341, up 24.1 percent from last year's opening session average of \$112,245. There were 70 yearlings reported as not sold. The session topper, a chestnut colt by Storm Cat--With a Twist (Fappiano), was purchased by Dorothy Scharbauer of Midland, Texas for \$800,000. D. Wayne Lukas will train the colt, according to Scharbauer's husband Clarence, who said Monday, "When we first saw him this morning, Dorothy really liked him. He was the brightest-eyed yearling we saw. (The \$800,000) was about twice what we wanted to pay, but we liked him so much. Four hundred thousand was the figure I had in mind." The Scharbauers, owners of 1987 Kentucky Derby winner Alysheba, currently have seven Thoroughbreds in training, including four trained by Lukas. "I don't want over 10 horses in training," Clarence Scharbauer continued. "I want it where Dorothy and I can keep up with them every day and know what they're doing." The colt will be sent to California to be broken. "But he'll come back to Kentucky if he's the right kind," Mr. Scharbauer added. The second highest price of the day was \$550,000 paid by Don Adam's Lanesborough Stables for a bay colt by Mr. Prospector--Dance for Lucy (Dance Bid). According to Adam, the colt was bought with the intention of reselling him at a 1997 two-year-olds in training sale. "If somebody's not willing to pay a pretty good number for him, we'll end up keeping him," Adam said, adding that there's a "strong likelihood that everything I buy here I'll resell." The colt will be broken at Adam's Courtlandt Farm in Ocala, Florida. The 11-day Keeneland September Yearling Sale continues through Thursday, Sept. 19.

TRF AUCTION SEPTEMBER 14 AT BELMONT

An auction to benefit the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation will be held at 10 a.m. this Saturday, September 14 on the Belmont clubhouse apron. Viewing begins at 9:30 a.m. Donated items to be auctioned include Serena's Song's 1995 Breeders Cup saddle cloth; several items of Cigar memorabilia, including a Skip Dickstein photo of the 1996 Mass' Cap which appeared in *Sports Illustrated*; two Breeders' Cup tickets; a Tiffany bowl donated by The Meadowlands; a 1970 Derby commemorative Jim Beam bourbon decanter; four Arc de Triomphe commemorative posters; and an advance reviewer's paperback copy of *The Kid* by Pete Axthelm. Richard Rosner, president of the New York Auctioneers Society, will serve as the auctioneer. A tag sale offering books, photos and posters will be held beforehand in the auction area and after the auction on the second floor of the clubhouse. Organizers hope the auction will raise more than \$10,000 for the TRF, which provides homes for retired racehorses with no other options. Catalogues are available at Belmont information booths.

WOODWARD S.-GI, \$500,000, 3yo/up, 9f

Martina Hingis, the 15-year-old tennis sensation who reached the semi-finals in the U.S. Open last weekend before losing to eventual champion Steffi Graf, will stop by Belmont Park this morning to visit racing sensation **Cigar** (Palace Music). Cigar makes his next start in Saturday's GI Woodward S.; he is scheduled to breeze Wednesday or Thursday.

Smart Strike (Mr. Prospector), originally set to make his next appearance in the GI Meadowlands Cup, will now take on the reigning Horse of the Year in the Woodward. The Canadian invader, winner of the GI Iselin last out and undefeated in three starts this year, ships to New York Wednesday.

Doncaster's St. Leger, the final leg of Britain's Classic Triple Crown, looks to be contested by 13 colts and one filly. Connections of 14 horses confirmed entry at Monday's noon deadline and all are intending for their three-year-olds to go to the post. Godolphin will have two runners--Epsom Oaks second **Pricket** (Diesis {GB}) (the one female set to start) and **Sharaf Kabeer (GB)** (Machiavellian). But British champion jockey Frankie Dettori, who could have partnered either, has chosen instead to stick with Epsom Derby third **Shantou** (Alleged). Pat Eddery, miles clear in the race to capture Dettori's title in 1996 and seemingly all set to lift an 11th championship in Britain, will take the leg-up on Derby second **Dushyantor** (Sadler's Wells). Other five-day entries for the Group 1 event are **Chief Contender (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Clerkenwell** (Sadler's Wells), **Desert Boy (Ire)** (Green Desert), **Flying Legend (Alleged)**, **Gordi** (Theatrical {Ire}), **Heron Island (Ire)** (Shirley Heights {GB}), **Samraan** (Green Dancer), **St Mawes (Fr)** (Shahrestani), **Wilawander (GB)** (Nashwan) and **Mons (GB)** (Deploy). Local News: Finger Lakes

According to a report from the *Associated Press*, **Fio Rito** (Dreaming Native), the first New York-bred to win a Grade I race, was buried in the infield at Finger Lakes Racetrack yesterday. The 21-year-old was humanely destroyed Sunday night due to the infirmities of old age; he was buried 100 yards from the Finger Lakes finish line. The grey, a winner of 16 stakes and \$584,142, is best remembered for his dramatic neck victory in the 1981 GI Whitney H. after breaking through the gate before the start of the race. He was named New York-bred Horse of the Year twice.

Local News: Florida

Kiri's Clown (Foolish Pleasure), owned and bred by Gardner F. Landon and Mary A. Sullivan, became the newest Florida-bred millionaire despite losing the victory via a stewards' disqualification in Saturday's GIII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. The seven-year-old, placed third in the Belmont Breeders' Cup, has now earned \$1,003,789; he becomes the fifth Florida-bred to reach the million-dollar plateau this year.
