**DANZIG FILLY TOPS KEENELAND SESSION** A filly by Danzig brought a top price of \$270,000 during yesterday's session of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale. B.T.A. Stable bought the yearling out of Shakela, by Alydar. She was consigned by Calumet Farm. Danzig has been North America's leading sire five time. Camelia J. Casby bought a colt by Red Ransom for \$170,000, the second high price of the day. Taylor Made Sales Agency consigned the yearling, who is out of stakes-placed Last in Time and is a half-brother to stakes winner Bright Time. During Friday's session, Keeneland sold 280 horses for \$9,708,000, an average of \$34,671. Last year, 299 horses brought \$9,808,000, an average of \$32,803. After five days of the 11-day sale, 1,389 horses have been sold for a gross of \$113,691,900. The average is \$81,852. At this point in the sale last year, the average was \$72,558 on a gross of \$106,514,500 for 1,468 horses. The sale continues through Thursday.

True Flare began her racing career in France, where she won listed stakes at age two and three. The Kentucky-bred filly shipped to the U.S. this summer and promptly took the GII San Clemente H. over the Del Mar turf in July. Third after a troubled trip in the GI Del Mar Oaks in her latest outing Aug. 18, the bay tried the East Coast for the first time here and tasted success in yet another region, rallying from last to first in the nine-horse field to win as the 4-5 favorite. "I thought she ran very well," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "Gary (Stevens) said she stumbled leaving there; that's why she was so far back early. But I had a lot of confidence in her. She's a very nice filly; she fires every time. We'll probably run her next in the (GI) Queen Elizabeth II S. (at Keeneland Oct. 5)." GIII Nijana S. winner MEMORIES OF SILVER (Silver Hawk), who would have been heavily favored in the Rare Perfume, was scratched. Trainer Jimmy Toner said the filly is suffering from a minor throat infection and should be fine to start in the Queen Elizabeth.

Bahhare, already favorite for next year's 2000 Guineas before his smooth win in the Champagne S., is as low as 5-1 for the 1996 Classic after beating In Command by 3 1/2-lengths. Musheer led early on at a pace which produced a course record. But In Command took control with two furlongs left and quickly established a decent advantage. Willie Carson, however, was soon making up ground aboard Bahhare, who swept from the back of the field with just over 200 yards left to win going away. Only a tendency to flash his tail when shown the whip marred the Hamdan Al Maktoum-owned colt's success, which made his career figures three-for-three. Trainer John Dunlop said, "It is always grand when a horse comes out and wins a proper race like this. He has settled well in behind and, despite running a bit green in the middle of the race, has done it nicely in the end. I suspect this will be his final run of the year. That was always Sheikh Hamdan's plan and I think it is a very good idea to put him into winter quarters now."

**Woodward (Cont.)**

The reigning Horse of the Year makes his first of two scheduled starts on his home track this year, and, despite his defeat in last month's Pacific Classic, the six-year-old **Cigar** (Palace Music) remains as popular as ever. "Maybe some people think less of him since he got beat, but I surely don't," said rider Jerry Bailey. "Certainly there's a mystique about a streak, but you're going to see as great a horse as you did a year ago, six months ago, three months ago." Aboard when Dare and Go derailed Cigar at Del Mar after 16 straight, Bailey puts some of the blame on himself for Cigar's loss, but also aims some toward members of the California riding colony. "I don't think the jockeys here have a single mission in mind, to get Cigar beat as certain jockeys did in California," said Bailey. "In his last race, maybe I was the victim of 'there's nothing he can't do.' I'm looking forward to riding him again, and I would guess that he's looking forward to winning again, too."

Today's Man o' War features eight runners that should be packed into about six lengths at the wire, and with the favorites raising questions, we're going for a price. **Mecke** (Maudlin) ran as well as he can (3 1/2) to win the Million, and that's the problem. He has a history of bouncing from big efforts. **Awad** (Caveat) bled in the same race, may not have had time to recover sufficiently and faces another wide trip. **Marlin** (Sword Dance {Ire}) is a nice three-year-old, but would have to move up to handle these strong older horses. **Diplomatic Jet** (Roman Diplomat) has a history of predictable cycles. After a big Thoro-Graph effort of 4 3/4 in July he bounced, then began moving forward in a decent Arlington Million effort concealed because of a wide trip. With a history of running well over a soft Belmont course, and a lifetime best at this distance, we look for a big effort at a big price from Diplomatic Jet. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily. **PASSERO CHARGES DISMISSED** The State of Florida dismissed charges of animal cruelty against trainer Frank Passero and three employees after Hearing Officer Michael Parrish ruled that a confession from Abraham Siddo, a groom for Passero, was inadmissible. Passero, who won a record 14 straight races at this year's Gulfstream meeting, was leveled with the charges after investigators claimed he used a mixture of hot pepper on his horses' genital areas in an attempt to enhance their performance. The 33-year-old Siddo, who is from Jamaica, claimed to have a seventh grade education and said that he can't read or write. The signed, four-page confession the state used to prosecute the case was written by Mike Mulvey, an investigator for Gulfstream Park, based on what Mulvey claimed was a statement given by Siddo. After testimony yesterday by Siddo, Passero's attorneys moved that the confession be stricken because phrases in the document were inconsistent with language used and understood by Siddo. The defense attorneys questioned Siddo on his use of such words as "anus, rectum and genitals." The attorneys argued to the hearing officer that the words were beyond the scope of his understanding. Parrish ruled that the confession was inadmissible because the "testimony (presented) a problem of mis-communications," between the investigator who recorded the statement and Siddo. The state's attorney, Tom Darby, then asked that all charges against Passero, his son, Gino, and grooms Siddo and Errol Powell be dismissed because the state lacked the evidence to proceed. The motion was granted and the hearings closed.

**HOLLYWOOD SUSPENDS STADIUM BID** Hollywood Park notified the National Football League today that it will suspend its pursuit of a new football stadium and support the L.A. Coliseum proposal for returning the NFL to the Los Angeles area. R.D. Hubbard, Chairman of Hollywood Park, said in a letter to NFL Commissioner Paul Tagliabue that Hollywood Park would only consider further discussions about a stadium on its Inglewood property if the Coliseum is determined to be unacceptable as a venue.

**HENNESSY RETIRED TO ASHFORD** Hennessy (Storm Cat), winner of the Hopeful S. and over a half-million dollars at two, has been retired to Ashford Stud to stand the 1997 breeding season, it was announced yesterday. Hennessy's grandsire, Storm Bird, also stands at Ashford. Hennessy recorded his first victory in his second start at Hollywood Park, the first of a four-race winning streak which included the GII Hollywood Juvenile, the GII Sapling and the GI Hopeful. He fell just a neck short of Unbridled's Song in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile before making his last start in the Hollywood Futurity. His stud fee has yet to be announced. Hennessy was originally purchased privately by Coolmore Stud and partners this spring, but the sale was put on hold when it was discovered he had one undescended testicle. After being revetted last week, it was discovered that the other testicle had descended, and the sale went forward. Hennessy's half-brother, Shy Tom, is the sire of Refinado Tom, who confirmed his position as Argentina's leading three-year-old on dirt with a runaway win the Argentinean 2,000 Guineas this past Saturday, his third Group 1 win.

**LADY CARLA OUT FOR SEASON** Epsom Oaks heroine Lady Carla (GB) (Caerleon) will not race again this year. The Henry Cecil-trained filly has been suffering from persistent problems in her back since finishing fourth as the odds-on favorite for the Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 14 and, following veterinary tests, it has been now revealed that she has inflammation to some vertebrae. Connections are hoping to race the bay again as a four-year-old, but have already discounted having her fit to return to the racecourse in 1996. Tim Bulwer-Long, racing manager for owner Wafic Said, explained, "We will give her five or six weeks rest in the paddocks and then she will return to Henry in November."
