CIGAR TO STAY IN USA Allen Paulson has decided to turn down an offer which would have sent Cigar (Palace Music) to Japan; America's greatest horse in 20 years will now stand at stud in the U.S. when his career comes to a close. "I have a firm offer of \$30 million from Japanese interests for Cigar, but I'm not going to sell him," said Paulson yesterday. "I think he belongs to America. (The money) gets you thinking, but I have a lot of beautiful ladies in the barns in Kentucky who would love to meet Cigar. If I sold him, I'd miss the horse. When all the people started writing and calling me, I made up my mind." Paulson also opened the door to a possible seven-year-old campaign for his superstar. "I always leave my options open," he said.

REKINDLED: CIGAR REIGNS SUPREME IN WOODWARD There will never be another 16-race win streak for Cigar, but the six-year-old sensation who saw his streak broken with a loss in the GI Pacific Classic August 10 was back home in the winner's circle once again yesterday after another stirring performance in the GI \$500,000 Woodward S. at Belmont Park. None the worse for his cross-country adventure, the reigning Horse of the Year came back to Belmont as the 1-5 favorite and toyed with four rivals in the mile-and-an-eighth event, crossing the line in cruise control for a facile four-length triumph. "It's what we thought would happen," said a confident trainer Bill Mott, but he added, "It's always a relief. There are a couple more races to go and you don't want to use it all up. We'll bask in the glory of this tonight, but we'll be looking forward to the next ones." Cigar started his new skein before a disappointing Belmont crowd of 16,701, the smallest crowd to see Cigar this year, but the fans on hand let their voices be heard in support of the hometown hero. "The crowd seemed to get into it as much as I did," said Mott. "Everyone was sharing in it. It felt pretty darned good." Jockey Jerry Bailey, who raised his fist to salute the stands as he and Cigar stepped past the sixteenth pole, added, "I was wondering how many people would be here. The streak wasn't there, it was a Jewish holiday, this is not a small town--I knew it couldn't be the same as the other times. But I was very proud of the New York fans. They were very vocal and loving of Cigar." New Yorkers will have a chance to redeem themselves with an even better showing at Belmont when Cigar makes his next start in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup October 5.

ELTISH (Cox's Ridge) stumbled coming away from the gate but quickly pulled rider Eddie Delahoussaye up along the outside to contest the pace. SMART STRIKE (Mr. Prospector) sat just off his flank to the inside and took command down the backside, leading the field into the turn through a half in 46.23. But Cigar, reserved off the early leaders, swept past the group at will on the turn and hit the top of the stretch with a length advantage, which he widened with every powerful stride under the wire, leaving even the vanquished in awe. "Racing needs a hero," said trainer Jim Bond, whose L'Carriere-came off the pace for a second-place finish. "God bless Mr. Paulson and Mr. Mott for keeping him running." Others weren't as happy with the performance of their own contenders. "He's a better horse than he gave me," said jockey Craig Perret of Iselin winner Smart Strike. "I'm not saying I'd have beaten Cigar, but if he gave me the same kind of race he gave me at Monmouth, we'd have been second today." Delahoussaye thought his mount could have fared better, as well. "I thought if we didn't win this race, we had a great chance for second," he said, "but he just didn't fire at all."

Shantou gave trainer John Gosden his first British Classic with a powerful late surge to reverse Epsom Derby form with Dushyantor in the St Leger. MONS (GB) (Deploy) set off at a good gallop, while Frankie Dettori on Shantou and Pat Eddery aboard Dushyantor were content to bide their time near the back of the pack over the first mile. SHARAF KABEER (GB) (Machievellian) went to the front just over four furlongs from the finish and here both Dettori and Eddery began to make progress. Dushyantor was next to take an advantage and, when he poached a two-length lead with around 300 yards to race, it seemed he might gain compensation for his Derby second. But Shantou, third at Epsom, inched alongside in the final furlong and just managed to put his neck in front before the wire. Gosden was delighted by his success. "It's lovely to win a Classic finally," he said. "I've had enough places up to now. Shantou has picked up a reputation for being a bit of a character-- even ungentle in some quarters--but he looked pretty brave to me today."

Diplomatic Jet returned to his favorite course today after finishing an unlucky sixth in the Arlington Million last out. Five-for-nine over the Belmont turf course coming into this race, the chestnut had already picked up one Grade I here in the Early Times Manhattan earlier in the summer, but had yet to find the winner's circle since that score. Marlin lay down easy fractions and looked tough to the top of the lane, but Diplomatic Jet, who sat just off that lead, proved too much for both the three-year-old and Mecke, who came flying through the stretch just a bit too late. Trainer Jimmy Picou said the Turf Classic may be next, followed by the Breeders' Cup Turf.

Yanks Music was looking for the third Grade I stakes win of her career after taking the GI Alabama Aug. 17 at Saratoga. Getting 10 pounds from Serena's Song, the 3-year-old stalked the pacesetter into the stretch. The pair left the rest of the field in their wake as they battled down the Belmont stretch with Yanks Music earning a hard-fought neck victory. "I knew it wasn't going to be an easy task, but we were getting 10 pounds, and that was barely enough," said winning trainer Leo O'Brien. "She has a great heart. She just fights, fights, fights." Serena's Song's rider Gary Stevens said, "It was unfortunate she didn't win the race, but I thought she ran a winning race." Yanks Music will start next in the Breeders' Cup, while Serena's Song will aim for the Oct. 6 GI Beldame.

The heroine just three weeks ago of the Beverly D scored a brilliant win here. **Dance Design (Ire)** made a steady pace with **Glory Of Dancer (Ire)** and **Epsom Derby hero SHAAMIT (IRE)** (Mtoto) close behind. **Dance Design** increased the gallop turning into the home stretch and, as she did so, **Shaamit** appeared to be caught a little flat-footed. But **Timarida** made rapid progress on the outside with two furlongs left and eventually won easing down. **Glory Of Dancer**, only fourth in the **Epsom Derby**, reversed **Classic** form with **Shaamit** to collect third prize. Successful handler **John Oxx** said: "Timarida will be retired to the paddocks at the end of this season and I should think the **Newmarket Champion S.** (Oct. 19) will probably be her last start. There is just a chance, though, that she might be supplemented for the **Arc.**" Trainer **William Haggas** put on a brave face following **Shaamit's** disappointing display. "This won't be the last you see of him," he insisted. "It's just a temporary setback. I'll have to go away and think about it, but I'd be inclined to give him one more run this season."

Easycall (GB), who had lost his unbeaten record on his previous start in the **G2 Gimcrack S.** at **York** last month, came back to top form with this win. **COMPTON PLACE (GB)**, second in the **Gimcrack**, broke fastest and set a strong gallop. **Easycall**, fourth in that **York** event just over three weeks ago, was not far behind, however, and loomed up alongside his old rival with over a furlong left. Jockey **Michael Tebbutt**, never before a winner at this level, got down to work in the final 150 yards and gradually **Easycall** gained the upper hand. **Deep Finesse (GB)**, hampered a quarter of a mile from home, finally got a clear run to take third. Winning trainer **Brian Meehan** said: "Things didn't go right in the **Gimcrack**, although we never really found out what exactly went wrong. But **Easycall** has confirmed here that he is a good two-year-old. We may supplement him for the **Middle Park Stakes** at **Newmarket** (October 3). It would be nice to have a crack at a **Group One.**"

Three English-trained fillies try to make a mark in this Arc trial, headed by John Dunlop's **Bint Salsabil** (Nashwan), who "won" last month's G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville, only to lose the race in the stewards' room to Andre Fabre's **Luna Wells (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Willie Carson partners **Bint Salsabil**, who will be joined in the 10-runner field by Luca Cumani's Yorkshire Oaks runner-up **Papering (Ire)** (Shaadi) and Rae Guest's **My Emma (GB)** (Marju {Ire}). The Aga Khan has two runners, the Yorkshire Oaks disappointment **Shamadara (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}) and the John Oxx-trained **Zafzala (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}). Shamadara won the G2 Prix de Malleret at Longchamp in June and was then runner-up to Dermot Weld's Dance Design in the Irish Oaks. As well as **Papering (Ire)**, Sheikh Mohammed will be represented by **Tulipa (Alleged)**, who won the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot. Tulipa beat the Yorkshire Oaks winner Key Change at Ascot, so, on form, she should have the beating of Shamadara. Fabre also saddles **Luna Wells**, who won the G1 Prix Saint-Alary in May and was awarded the Prix de la Nonette at Deauville on the disqualification of both **Bint Salsabil** and **Bint Shadayid**, and **Miss Tahiti (Ire)** (Tirol {Ire}), who was runner-up to the surprise English-trained **Sil Sila** in the French Oaks.

OCTAGONAL MAY BE RETIRED Australia's 1995/96 Horse Of The Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) looks set to be retired from racing following his third successive defeat from three starts this season when failing badly in the one-mile G2 \$200,000 J F Feehan Stakes at Moonee Valley in Melbourne yesterday. Octagonal, winner of 10 of his 19 starts, including five G1 successes last season, and earner of \$3.9 million, could finish only fifth, beaten six and a half lengths, behind the winner **Toil (NZ)** (Star Way {GB}). Trainer John Hawkes said: "I think I will recommend retirement to the horse's owners, Jack and Bob Ingham. It will be up to them to make the decision. There is no doubt that he is nowhere near the horse he was at two and three. He just gave in too quickly today for my liking to continue on. I have tried a few things with him, but nothing seems to have worked, although he's got nothing left to prove. He must have his mind on other things and he would be better suited at stud now." Octagonal ended his three-year-old season with a victory in the Australian Jockey Club Derby, having previously won the Cox Plate, Canterbury Guineas, Rosehill Guineas and Mercedes Classic, all G1 races. In his first two seasons he was never unplaced, but he finished out of the money in both the G1 Manikato S. and the G2 Memsie S. prior to this latest failure.
