SUPER SATURDAY WRAP-UP He refused to eat his favorite peppermints after a loss in the Pacific Classic, but **Cigar** (Palace Music) was scarfing them down again Saturday night following his win in the Woodward S., reported trainer Bill Mott. "He's very happy and proud of himself," said Mott. "The horse is good, he ate up very well and had his peppermints. Everyone has had a good response to his race." Mott confirmed that Cigar would make his next start in the Oct. 5 Jockey Club Gold Cup followed by the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Classic at Woodbine. **L'Carriere** (Carr de Naskra), second to Cigar Saturday, also came out of the race in good order and should be back to test him again in three weeks. **Yanks Music** (Air Forbes Won), who defeated **Serena's Song** (Rahy) in the Ruffian, will go straight to the Breeders' Cup Distaff, while the latter will be pointed to either the Oct. 6 Beldame or the Three Chimneys Spinster at Keeneland the same day.

DARE AND GO CAMP UNDAUNTED BY CIGAR'S WIN Dick Mandella, who sent out 39-1 Dare and Go (Alydar) to derail Cigar's win the Pacific Classic, "was very happy to see (Cigar) win again," in yesterday's Woodward, said Mandella from his Hollywood Park headquarters. But that doesn't mean Mandella won't aim to play the spoiler again in the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Classic. "He looked very good, but we're going to give him another try in Canada," said Mandella. "Dare and Go is doing super. We plan to run him in the Goodwood (at Santa Anita Oct. 5), and then it's on to Canada. He's doing great and it will be interesting to see if we can do it again."

Traitor won his debut at Laurel in July and came into his stakes debut with a third in an Aug. 16 Saratoga allowance. The colt rated patiently behind a four-horse duel for the lead that whipped out fractions of :22.49, :45.15 and 1:10.35. He moved up on the inside around the turn and then moved to the outside to pass tiring favorite SMOKE GLACKEN (Two Punch) and drew off for the win. "It set up perfect," jockey John Velazquez said after the race. "He ran to the horses quickly. When I asked him to run and hit him left-handed he just sprinted away." Henry Carroll, trainer of the beaten favorite, said, "(Jockey) Craig (Perret) said that after the first eighth he wasn't the same. He could have gotten third, but why abuse him? It's time to stop and take care of him before we discourage him." Traitor will now be pointed towards either the Oct. 6 Grey Breeders Cup at Woodbine or Belmont's Champagne S. Oct. 5.

Sharp Cat, who won the GII Del Mar Debutante Aug. 25 in her last start, added a GI event to her resume with this front-running performance. The filly set fractions of :22.91, 45.44 and 1:10.15 while being pressured by favorite Fabulously Fast. Sharp Cat shied from the rail in upper stretch, but continued on holding off the late-closing Storm Song to the wire. "I kind of wanted to be on the lead; the inside speed has done real well and I thought that was the place to be," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "The only anxious moment was when she shied away from the rail. She just got too close to it and she jumped away, but she didn't hit it. Then she went on and just drew away from them again." Sharp Cat will now be aimed for the GI Frizette Oct. 6.

Newmarket trainer Rae Guest's My Emma, a half-sister to the 1995 St Leger and 1996 Ascot Gold Cup winner Classic Cliche (Ire), pulled off a surprise here. Brilliantly ridden by Cash Asmussen, My Emma raced in third behind Luca Cumani's Papering (Ire) for much of the race, then found a gap between Papering (Ire) and Miss Tahiti (Ire), hit the front a furlong and a half out and held on well to beat Zafzala (Ire) (Kahyasi) by a head. Zafzala (Ire) was disqualified from second and placed fifth, behind Leonila (Ire) (Caerleon), to whom she caused continual interference up the straight. Rider Johnny Murtagh was given a 4-day suspension, starting on Tuesday, Sept. 24. A spokesman for My Emma's owners, Matthews Breeding and Racing, said, "She is not in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. She's a late developing filly and will stay in training as a four-year-old, when she may have a tilt at the Arc, if all goes well beforehand."

Robert Sangster's Revoque justified trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam's decision to switch from the Laurent-Perrier Champagne S. at Doncaster on Friday and completed an English sweep of yesterday's French Group 1 races at Longchamp. Paul Cole's The West edged out the French favourite Zamindar by a short head for second. Zamindar was forced to lead after his intended pacemaker SACRISTAN (GB) (Warning {GB}) could not get to the front. Zamindar led into the straight from The West, but Revoque was cruising in behind them and two furlongs out quickened well and shot into the lead and went on to score comfortably by three lengths. Chapple-Hyam said: "I finally have my first winner at Longchamp. Revoque is a big, lazy horse, who does the minimum at home. He needs a mile already. He will probably be put away now until next season and come back for the 2000 Guineas."

The 4-1 favourite with Ladbrokes for the Oct. 6 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe is now Helissio (Fr), who led from the start and ran on really well in the closing stages of this event, beating the strong-finishing Darazari by a length. Winning trainer Lellouche said: "I wasn't at all surprised that Helissio (Fr) ran so well. While he has improved since he won the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, he is still only 80 per cent fit right at present. Olivier Peslier told me that the horse was more relaxed than he has ever been. There are no worries if the ground is soft for the Arc. He is top-class and the legitimate favourite for the Arc." Peter Chapple-Hyam's Polaris Flight (Northern Flagship) raced in second behind Helissio, but was struggling a half-mile out and the runner-up in both the French and Irish Derbys faded badly to finish ninth of the ten runners. Why Change took two stakes at the recently concluded Monmouth Park meet, the Spend a Buck S. on the turf and the Aug. 18 Housebuster S. on the main track in his last start. The colt was disregarded by the bettors in his graded stakes debut, but set the pace in hand before drawing off in upper stretch for his third straight win. Why Change survived a claim of foul lodged by Jose Santos, rider of second-place finisher Distorted Humor. "Why Change came over a little too quickly (at the start) and I had to take a hold of my horse; at the same time, I shut off Craig Perret's horse (GOLD TOKEN {Mr. Prospector}). That is why I claimed foul," explained Santos. "When they said go, he got up and left," said winning rider Chuck Lopez. "I cleared them and I went right to the inside because that's the place to be. After that, he did everything easily."

NEWS CONT.**GILDED TIME FILLY SELLS FOR \$78,000 AT**

KEENELAND Wistaria Bloodstock, agent, of Pasadena, California, paid a top price of \$78,000 for a filly from the first crop of Gilded Time during Sunday's session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale. Walmac International, agent, consigned the yearling out of unraced Cat's Image, by Storm Cat. Gilded Time, by Timeless Moment out of Gilded Lily, was champion two-year-old colt of 1992. During Sunday's session, Keeneland sold 286 horses for \$5,189,500, an average of \$18,145. During the same session last year, 310 horses brought \$5,934,800, an average of \$19,145. After seven days of the 11-day auction, 1,987 horses have been sold for \$126,879,900, an average of \$63,855. At this point in the sale a year ago, 2,080 horses had been sold for \$119,111,000. The average was \$57,265. The sale continues through Thursday.

BOSRA SHAM NOW HAS ASCOT AIM Newmarket 1000 Guineas heroine **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) was confirmed an intended runner in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 28 after pleasing connections in a racecourse gallop under her usual jockey Pat Eddery at Doncaster late Saturday afternoon. The unbeaten filly has not raced since her Classic win because of persistent foot problems. But she appeared in top condition when working with two stable companions after the St Leger meeting and trainer Henry Cecil is very hopeful of a big run as she returns to competitive action a week Saturday. Cecil said: "She should have a further three gallops before she goes to Ascot and, by that stage, we would hope to have her 100 per cent."

Pentire (GB)'s half-length defeat by Swain (Ire) in the mile and a half Prix Foy was almost certainly brought about by the slow pace of the race, which caused his rider Michael Hills to take the lead after only three furlongs. A quarter of a mile out, Pentire (GB) tried to quicken, but he could not withstand the late surge of Swain (Ire), who came through to win cleverly. Swain (Ire) and Pentire (GB) will definitely run in the Arc and the latter's trainer Geoff Wragg said: "I expected the pace to be false and Michael Hills had to do whatever he had to do. The horse has never won from the front. He only wins when he can come from behind. But this will help get him into the right condition for the Arc and he will definitely run unless the going is bad. I just hope that matters will be different in the Arc itself."

The Ian Balding-trained filly won a maiden event at Sandown on her racecourse bow and followed up with a short-head victory in Ascot's G3 Princess Margaret S. July 27. But connections felt Seebe was disadvantaged by her stalls position after she was beaten behind subsequent Group One winner **Bianca Nera (GB)** (Salse) in the Lowther S., as she was forced to make her challenge on the outside, where the ground may have been slightly slower. Balding, who trained Mill Reef, has a special reason for wanting to capture the race named in his honour.
