GILDED TIME COLT FETCHES \$115,000 AT KEENELAND For the second day in a row Monday, a yearling by 1992 Champion Two-Year-Old Colt Gilded Time topped the day's session at the Keeneland September Yearling Sale. Century Venture III paid top price of \$115,000 for the bay colt, the first foal out of the stakes-winning mare Explo Royale (Explodent), during yesterday's session. Spring Farm consigned the yearling. Keeneland sold 282 horses yesterday for \$4,021,000, an average of \$14,259, down 9.98 percent from the same session last year. In last year's corresponding session, Keeneland sold 308 horses for \$4,878,800--an average of \$15,840. The sale continues through Thursday.

HAT TAB GIRL EUTHANIZED Hat Tab Girl (Al Hattab), dam of the 1991 Horse of the Year **Black Tie Affair (Ire)** (Miswaki), was humanely destroyed yesterday at the age of 17. The stakes-winning Kentucky-bred, who was owned by Brushwood Stable at the time of her death, was riddled with cancerous melanomas internally and her in-utero foal by Gulch had been pronounced dead. Hat Tab Girl also produced G1 winner **Great Palm** (Manila) and SW **Start A Tab** (Matsadoon); her last foal was a full brother to Black Tie Affair born this April.

Sahm (Mr. Prospector), winner of his first two career starts at York before crossing the wire third and being disqualified and placed eighth in Goodwood's G3 Lanson Champagne Vintage S. July 31, will bid to get back on the winning trail in the Saturday's National S. A spokesman at trainer John Dunlop's stable said, "Sahm is to be supplemented for the Irish race at a cost of \$32,284 and, assuming he remains in good shape, we plan to run him." England's challenge for the contest will feature **Apprehension (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}), five-length hero of his only race to date at Haydock Sept. 7, and **Referendum (Ire)** (Common Grounds {GB}), who won by seven lengths at Goodwood last time out. Ireland's defense of the National S. will be headed by last month's G1 Phoenix S. winner **Mantovaní (Ire)** (Treasure Kay).

TURFWAY BREEDERS' CUP S.-GII, \$200,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/16m

Two probable starters owned by Overbrook Farm and trained by D. Wayne Lukas worked over a sloppy Churchill Downs track Monday morning. **Country Cat** (Storm Cat), winner of the GIII Gardenia H. at Ellis Park Aug. 18, breezed five furlongs in 1:02 4/5. Last year's Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Golden Attraction** (Mr. Prospector), sixth in the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga in her last outing Aug. 18, went the same distance in 1:02 flat under jockey Donna Barton. "She worked beautifully," Barton said. At Hollywood Park Monday, **Advancing Star** (Soviet Star), a winner of three of four career starts including two stakes, drilled five furlongs in :58. Also possible for the race are **Bedroom Blues** (Cure the Blues), **Betty Van** (Broad Brush), **Ginny Lynn** (Texas City) and **Strawberry Reason** (Strawberry Road {Aus}).

KENTUCKY CUP SPRINT H.-GII, \$150,000, 3yo, 6f

Appealing Skier (Baldski), winner of the GII Hutcheson S. and GII Withers S. earlier this year, drilled five furlongs from the gate in :58 flat at Monmouth Park Monday. Following his work, the three-year-old, unraced since his 12th-place effort in the June 8 Belmont S., departed Monmouth on a van bound for Turfway Park. **Capote Belle** (Capote), the speedy filly who will challenge colts Saturday, worked five furlongs in :59 3/5 at Belmont Sunday. Capote Belle won the GII Prioress S. and GI Test S. in June and July. "When you're shooting for the Breeders' Cup Sprint championship, there's not a lot of options at this time of year," said trainer Dan Peitz. "The timing and the distance of Saturday's race are right for her. If we can't beat the male three-year-olds at this time of year, we'll have to think twice about beating the older males come Breeders' Cup time." **Valid Expectations** (Valid Appeal) breezed a half-mile in :48 at Arlington Monday. The Florida-bred has won his last three starts, including the GIII Derby Trial S. at Churchill Downs April 27. Other prospects for the Sprint are **Basic** (Storm Bird), **Delay of Game** (Summer Squall), **Foreign Pass** (Foreign Holding), **Future Quest** (Relaunch), **Goldminers Gold** (Crafty Prospector), **Laredo** (Crafty Prospector), **Stu's Choice** (Afleet) and **Valid Concept** (Valid Appeal).

Australia's 1995/96 Horse of the Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) will have his final racetrack chance to redeem himself after three successive defeats this campaign when he contests Sunday's G1 Underwood S. over 1 1/4-miles at Caulfield in Melbourne. Trainer John Hawkes and owners Jack and Bob Ingham had given serious consideration to retiring the four-year-old colt after his failure in last weekend's Feehan S. However, they have decided to have one more go and have recalled their horse's regular rider last year, Darren Beadman, to replace Darren Gauci, who has been on board for all three failures this season. Beadman and Octagonal were inseparable for the second half of last season when they won four consecutive Group One events--the Canterbury Guineas, Rosehill Guineas, Mercedes Classic and AJC Derby.
