**TWIST AFLEET TO BREEDING SHED?** Multiple Grade I winner **Twist Afleet** (Afleet), a disappointing fifth in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont September 14, came out of the race with heat in her left front leg and may be retired. "We have sent the x-rays out to be analyzed and it's possible she is finished racing and will be bred to Danzig next year," said trainer John Kimmel of the mare who gave him his first Grade I victory. "It will be a sad day when she leaves us, because she has been such an important presence in this barn for so long." Twist Afleet, first in the GI Test S. of '94 and the GI Top Flight H. last year, underwent surgery to place a screw in her left front shin at the end of her three-year-old campaign. Now five and twice a Grade III winner this year, she has captured 13 of her 18 career starts and bankrolled \$659,568.

### CHURCHILL TO REVISE DERBY/OAKS

**ADMISSION PRICES** Churchill Downs officials yesterday announced a plan to standardize admission policies on Kentucky Derby and Kentucky Oaks Days, effective next year. Beginning in 1997, all patrons will pay a general admission price of \$30 on Derby Day and \$15 on Oaks Day, which will allow them entrance through any gate and give access to the clubhouse gardens, the grandstand and the infield. Previously, patrons could pay \$6 on Oaks Day and \$20 on Derby Day for admission to the grandstand and infield only, or pay the higher price for admission to the clubhouse. "With combined Oaks and Derby attendance over 230,000 in 1996, it became necessary to streamline our admission policy," said Churchill Downs Senior Vice President and General Manager Dan Parkerson. "The new policy will solve several of the admission-related problems that we have experienced in the past. The adjusted pricing for these days is representative of admission costs for comparative major sporting events of the same caliber as the Kentucky Derby."

**DIABLO'S STUD FEE ON THE RISE** Today's *Daily Racing Form* reports that leading freshman sire **Diablo** (Devil's Bag), who has 12 winners from his first crop, will stand for a fee of \$20,000 for 1997, up from \$2,500 in 1996. The nine-year-old, who has also sired two stakes winners to date, resides at owner Harry T. Mangurian's Mockingbird Farm in Ocala, Florida.

**CRYPTOCLEARANCE TO MARGAUX FARM?**

According to the *Daily Racing Form*, **Cryptoclearance** (Fappiano), sire of last weekend's GI Futurity winner **Traitor**, will move from Midway's Vinery and likely stand the 1997 breeding season at Margaux Farm, also in Midway, Kentucky. The 12-year-old, a GISW of more than \$3.3 million, has sired four crops to race, with 14 stakes winners and earnings of over \$5.4 million.

**NTA NAMES CHAIRMEN** The National Thoroughbred Association yesterday named Bill Condren, Ed Friendly and John R. Gaines as its co-chairmen. The three will serve as the leadership for the proposed "major league for the sport of Thoroughbred racing." Said Friendly, "Our first order of business was to appoint a Business Plan Committee, and we have four key and experienced Thoroughbred owners who have agreed to lead it: Gary Biszantz, Robert Clay, Don Dizney and Bill Marquard. There will be additional members added to the Committee." The Committee held its first meeting during the Keeneland September Yearling Sales and retained Arthur Andersen to provide tax and business advice as well as audit and research services to the organization. Also retained was ISES, an international sports marketing firm headquartered in Atlanta which will coordinate the development of the Business Plan. "We have assembled a great team for the NTA Business Plan as tangible evidence of the talent this sport can bring together to implement this powerful idea," said Gaines. "We will need many others with experience in business, sports, media and racing to serve on the various committees for the NTA."

**BREEDERS' CUP UNVEILS WEB SITE** Breeders' Cup Ltd. has unveiled a new state-of-the-art web site on the Internet. Designed and implemented by Breeders' Cup Ltd., Equibase Co. and Hammond Communications, the 650-page site will provide fans, horsemen and media with up-to-the-minute information on racing's championship day, to be held October 26 at Woodbine Race-track. Available at <http://www.breederscup.com/>, the site will post notes and photos daily beginning the week prior to the Breeders' Cup, and the past performance program will be on line two days prior to the event.

### Local News: England

Five-time British champion jockey Willie Carson is believed to be suffering from liver damage and is expected to be detained in hospital for up to two weeks after being cow-kicked while attempting to mount a two-year-old before a race at Newbury. The 53-year-old Scottish-born rider was just preparing to climb aboard the Ben Hanbury-trained **Meshhed** (Gulch) when the filly lashed out with a leg and struck her partner in the stomach. Eye witnesses to the incident said Carson was thrown 15 feet into bushes. The four-time Epsom Derby winner was on the ground for some 20 minutes before being carried by stretcher to an ambulance which later took him to North Hampshire Hospital at nearby Basingstoke. He was put on oxygen and a drip in case of internal bleeding, but his condition is described by doctors as stable. A shocked Hanbury said: "It was incredibly quick. It did not look good and must have been terribly painful."
