**VINTAGE CROP RETIRED** Vintage Crop (Ire) (Rousillon), the only horse ever to win two Irish St. Legers, has been retired. The nine-year-old, hero of the Group One event in both 1993 and 1994, had been an intended runner in yesterday's renewal of the event, but, after failing to satisfy connections in his most recent workouts, the gelding was a late withdrawal. Trainer Dermot Weld stated: "He hasn't been sparkling on the gallops and appears to have lost his speed. I'd like him to be remembered as the champion he was." Vintage Crop was the first Irish-based horse to collect more than £1,000,000 in prize money. He also became the first European-trained winner of the Melbourne Cup when capturing Australia's biggest prize in 1993.

**CHB ALLOCATES 1997 DATES** The California Horse Racing Board gave final approval Friday to the state's 1997 racing calendar while challenging both racing associations and fair meets to cut back on the number of races they will run next year. CHRB Vice-Chairman Donald Valpreto, who co-chairs the Board's Dates Committee with CHRB Chairman Ralph Scurfield, advised members of track management attending Friday's meeting that "Ralph and I are committed to limiting the number of racing events that are run during the year. We aren't going to dictate how you mix and match it up, but we are prepared, as each association comes to the Board with its license application, to limit the number of events they will run. This is our way of dealing with the shortage of horses. By cutting back on the number of racing events, we hope to increase the size and quality of the fields." The complete 1997 Thoroughbred calendar is as follows: Santa Anita--December 26, 1996 to April 21, 1997; Hollywood Park--April 25-July 21 and November 5-December 22; Del Mar--July 23-September 10; Santa Anita/Oak Tree--October 1-November 2; Golden Gate Fields--December 26, 1996 to January 20, 1997, March 26-June 15 and November 19-December 22; Bay Meadows--January 23-March 23 and August 29-November 16. The fair meets will be: Stockton--June 11-22, Pleasanton--June 25-July 6, Vallejo--July 9-21, Santa Rosa--July 23-August 4, San Mateo--August 6-18, Ferndale--August 7-17, Cal Expo--August 20-September 1, Pomona--September 11-29 and Fresno--October 1-12. The issue of whether Hollywood, host of next year's Breeders' Cup, will open for three days in September to offer prep races for racing's championship event is still undecided.

A longshot at 19-1 when he captured the GII Forego H. at Saratoga by a neck, Canadian invader Langfuhr was not much better backed testing Grade I waters but proved an even more decisive winner this time. Now six-for-six at this distance, the bay was unhurried for the first quarter but quickly moved into contention three furlongs from home and easily outfinished favorite Honour and Glory for the victory as the second longest shot on the board. "He's wonderful going seven furlongs," said owner/breeder Gustav Schickedanz. "I don't care where we go, I believe he'd win it. They tell me the time was fantastic today--he's just a fantastic horse." Added jockey Jorge Chavez, "He wanted to go to the lead early, but I wanted to save some horse for the end. He was able to rate and when I let him go, he really got going." The colt makes his next start in the Breeders' Cup Sprint going six furlongs. Crowd's choice Honour and Glory, on the lead through a quarter in :23.12, was unable to hold off the winner but held on well for second. "He had no excuses. He had pressure on him but he got beat by a better horse today," said jockey Jose Santos.

Atticus, second in last year's French 2000 Guineas, had raced on the dirt just once previously, taking a Santa Anita allowance test on a fast track in his State-side debut March 2. Off the board in the GIII Firecracker H. on the grass in his most recent start June 30, the chestnut took two-and-a-half months off before returning to the main track, then splashed through the slop to lead this field from flagfall to finish and keep his dirt record unblemished with a handy score. "Our horse has been training great in California, and that made us think we ought to do something wild like this," said trainer Richard Mandella. "But I was surprised (at the win), because WEKIVA SPRINGS (Runaway Groom) looked pretty tough in there." The even-money choice, Wekiva Springs, who also did not show his best form when fourth in the mud for the GI Pimlico Special, settled off the pace early and had no closing kick. "I knew first jump out of the gate I was in trouble," said his rider, Mike Smith. "He just couldn't handle the track, not even a little bit. He just could never get a hold of it." The winner will go on to the Breeders' Cup, where he will run in either the Mile or the Classic.

Last year's champion two-year-old filly Golden Attraction had returned to the races with a victory in a Saratoga allowance August 8 but disappointed in her second start back, finishing a well-beaten sixth in the GI Ballerina H. 10 days later. Given a month between starts and stretching out in her third appearance of the season, the 6-5 second favorite showed an affinity for the sloppy going, jumping out to the lead at the break and cruising around the oval to pick up her first stakes win since last year's GI Frizette. But the race was marred by the fatal injury of stablemate COUNTRY CAT (Storm Cat), who broke down inside the first furlong; she suffered compound fractures of the sesamoids in her right front leg and had to be destroyed. BRIAR ROAD (Proper Reality) went to her knees at the start, unseating jockey Mike Smith; neither were injured.

**Kentucky Cup Sprint cont.**

Appealing Skier, winner of the GII Hutcheson S. back in February and the GII Withers May 11, hadn't raced since finishing 12th in the 12-furlong Belmont S. June 8. Back sprinting, the colt dueled with FOREIGN PASS (Foreign Holding) for the early lead, left that rival behind turning for home and extended his advantage nearing the final furlong. He bobbled about 70 yards from the wire, but recovered and was able to hold off Capote Belle and finish in track-record time. Even-money choice Capote Belle drifted out four-wide on the turn and couldn't catch the leader. "He was just so ready, once he got to the lead so easy I knew he had a chance," said winning rider Mike Smith. Ben Perkins' assistant trainer Ron Tanner said Appealing Skier may join stablemates Ft. Stockton and Meadow Monster in the Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 26.

Desert King (Ire) is a 25-1 shot for next year's English 2000 Guineas after his hard-fought and narrow victory here. MANTOVANI (IRE) (Treasure Kay {GB}), winner last time out of the Heinz 57 Phoenix S., was an 11th-hour withdrawal, so a field of 10 lined up for this seven-furlong event. Referendum (Ire) was quickest to break and he led at a steady gallop for the first three furlongs; jockey John Reid, aboard the pacesetter, steadily increased his tempo after halfway and, when he established a clear advantage with two furlongs left, it seemed he had the prize in the bag. But winning jockey Walter Swinburn, whose partner had been last reaching the home stretch, somehow managed to find a path through on Desert King and, despite a slight brush with Azra (Ire), drew alongside Referendum in the final 50 yards. His last-stride thrust was just enough to give Aidan O'Brien a first Group One success as a trainer.

Oscar Schindler (Ire), third in last year's Irish St. Leger, made no mistake this time and ran out a very smooth winner. BLUSHING FLAME (Blushing Groom {Fr}) led at a decent pace until three furlongs out, when Key Change (Ire) moved up to the lead and quickly established a clear advantage. But jockey Stephen Craine was just cruising on Oscar Schindler and, when asked to make a challenge inside the final 200 yards, the winner comfortably drew clear. Sacrament seemed to brush fourth-placed POSIDONAS (GB) (Slip Anchor {GB}) in the dying strides. However, following an enquiry, the Stewards allowed the positions to stand. Successful trainer Kevin Prendergast said: "He did it very well. Coming here has been the plan since last year. But, even though we thought he would win, we were starting to get nervous this morning. Oscar Schindler has improved a lot this season--really grown into himself--and I should think it is pretty definite that he will go for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe now."

**PHILLY PARK UNDER QUARANTINE** The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture has placed all horses stabled at Philadelphia Park under quarantine restrictions. The problem arose after a horse stabled at Wingait Farm in Quakertown, Pennsylvania, tested positive for Equine Infectious Anemia. That horse did not ship to Philadelphia Park, but another from the same farm did. According to Philadelphia Park spokesman Steve Kallens, tests have been taken on the Wingait Farm shipper, Grey Code (Lost Code), and they are expected back Monday. If he tests negative, the quarantine is expected to be lifted. Three horses shipped to Belmont yesterday from Philly Park, leaving before the quarantine was put in place. The three were scratched by the New York Racing Association stewards.
