KENTUCKY CUP WRAP-UP Atticus (Nureyev), winner of Saturday's \$490,000 Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway Park and a perfect two-for-two lifetime on the dirt, will return by plane Monday to California. "He's pretty bright this morning," said Crystal Brown, exercise rider for trainer Richard Mandella. "He ate up and he's in good condition." The four-year-old is slated to start Oct. 26 in either the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Mile on turf or the \$4 million Breeders' Cup Classic on dirt. Meanwhile, **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom), fifth as the favorite in the Kentucky Cup Classic, "will live to see another day," according to Ralph Nicks, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "He didn't handle the (sloppy) racetrack." The gray will be pointed to the Breeders' Cup Classic. Back at his Churchill Downs base yesterday was Kentucky Cup Classic runner-up **Judge T C** (Judge Smells), who will be pointed toward the GII Fayette H. at Keeneland Oct. 19 and probably the Clark H. in November. Trainer Gary Hartlage said he hoped to get Judge T C above \$1 million in earnings before retiring him at the end of the season. The five-year-old currently has \$826,826 in his bankroll. Last year's Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Golden Attraction** (Mr. Prospector), winner of the GII Turfway Breeders' Cup H. Saturday, will start next in Keeneland's GI Three Chimneys Spinster S. Oct. 6, according to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "She's back in form," Lukas said. "She's fresh and pretty talented. She could be tough in the Breeders' Cup." Lukas added that GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile hero **Boston Harbor** (Capote) will go next in Keeneland's GII Breeders' Futurity Oct. 11. If he wins that event, the Overbrook Farm runner will claim a \$1 million Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund bonus for winning four Kentucky stakes.

SUFFOLK DOWNS OPENS TODAY Thoroughbred racing returns to Boston today as Suffolk Downs kicks off its 1996-97 season with free admission and parking for all Opening Day attendees. The 14-race program will usher in a new era for New England racing, as Suffolk Downs and Rockingham Park will alternate races for the region's first "7-And-7" combined-card simulcast. First post is 12:45 p.m.

Fourth in the GII Jim Dandy and GI Travers since his victory in the GI Belmont S. June 8, Editor's Note picked up his second win of the season with a strong late surge as the crowd's second choice. Off a step slowly with jockey Gary Stevens back in the saddle, the chestnut settled well back early but found running room on the far turn and finished fastest of all to wear down longshot The Barking Shark and edge clear. Said Stevens, "Wayne (Lukas) and I felt all year long that he would take a step forward and show some maturity and be more consistent...he kind of proved us wrong late in the summer, but I think today was a new step for him. He was a lot more attentive and more focused going to the gate, and that's the way he was during the race." Added Lukas, "I took (the blinkers) off for his last race because we weren't getting what we wanted out of him. By taking them off, I jacked him up a little bit. Then we put them back on (for the Super Derby) and it's obviously working." The winner starts next in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup October 5. Even-money favorite WILL'S WAY (Easy Goer), winner of the Travers in his latest, made a mild bid on the far turn but flattened out late and finished seventh. Said trainer Jim Bond, "It's very disappointing, to say the least. But it looks like he's walking okay and hopefully he'll come out of it and we will rebuild for our four-year-old year." His jockey, Jorge Chavez, said, "I don't think he liked the track. He was bobbling some...I took him to the outside to see if he liked it there, but it didn't make any difference."

German Derby winner Lavirco reversed the form he showed when beaten by Bad Bertrich Again at Hoppegarten last month with an explosive victory here. After his stable companion **CABALLO (GER)** (**Konigsstuhl {Ger}**) set the pace for the first mile and then **LEAR WHITE** (**Lear Fan**) hit the front briefly, Lavirco stormed into the lead with 3 1/2-furlongs to run and soon went clear of the field, being eased down for a 3 1/2-length victory. Winning trainer Peter Rau said, "I am not sure if he will go for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, but we are hoping for an invitation to the Japan Cup (Germany's Lando won in Tokyo last year). When he was beaten by Bad Bertrich Again at Hoppegarten he had spent a night away from his stable for the first time and we think that upset him." Bad Bertrich Again finished fifth in Sunday's GIII Lawrence Realization H. at Belmont in his U.S. debut. (For result, see p. 4)

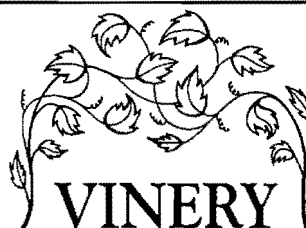
