TA RIB RETIRED FROM RACING Ta Rib (Mr. Prospector), the Kentucky-bred filly who won this year's G1 Dubai Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas), has been retired, according to a story in Tuesday's *Racing Post*. Angus Gold, racing manager to owner Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum, told the *Racing Post*, "Ta Rib has been sent to the paddocks and is currently at Shadwell Stud. Her breathing was never quite right and it was decided to retire her after she was scoped one day and we found she had bled a bit." Ta Rib won two of seven starts and finished second in the G2 Falmouth S. at Newmarket in July for career earnings of \$242,897. Her final career outing came Aug. 16 at Newbury, when she was fourth in the G3 Hungerford S. Ta Rib's trainer John Dunlop said, "I will never forget her and she will always have a place in my heart. After all, she gave me a Classic win."

PRENUP TO VINERY IN 1997 Mr. and Mrs. Ben P. Walden Jr.'s Vinery announced yesterday that **Prenup** (Smarten), winner of the 1994 G1 Jerome H., will enter stud at the Midway, Kentucky farm in 1997. Bred and owned by Edward P. Evans, Prenup will retire following his 1996 campaign. The five-year-old has won 10 of 24 career starts for earnings to date of \$428,142. In addition to his Jerome victory, the Virginia-bred owns four New York wins at the distance of one-mile. He also captured the Maryland Million Sprint, was second to champion Dehere in the GIII Sanford S. and third to champions Holy Bull and Dehere in the G1 Futurity S. Out of Homewrecker, Prenup is a half-brother to Honor the Hero, a MGSW of \$688,037, and Capitalimprovement, a stakes-winner of \$184,622. "We're proud of our relationship with Mr. Evans' Spring Hill Farm, one of the premier racing stables in America," said Ben Walden Jr. "In Prenup they've produced a stallion prospect with true miler speed." Prenup will stand for a fee of \$2,500 live foal as the property of Edward P. Evans and Vinery.

PHILLY PARK QUARANTINE TO EXTEND THROUGH OCTOBER 15 The quarantine of horses entering or leaving the grounds of Philadelphia Park Race Track will remain in effect through Oct. 15. The ban was ordered Saturday by the Pennsylvania State Department of Agriculture when it was determined that **Grey Code** (Lost Code), stabled at the Bensalem track, was previously stabled at a local farm where a horse was diagnosed with Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA). Two tests taken on Grey Code were negative, showing no signs of infection. However, Philadelphia Park officials agreed with the Agriculture Department to continue the quarantine as a precautionary measure. The quarantine period is for 45 days retroactive to Aug. 31, when Grey Code left Wingait Farm in Quakertown, where the infected horse had been stabled. The number of days is determined by the incubation period of EIA. Grey Code was taken to the New Bolton Center of the University of Pennsylvania following the tests.

TETHRA TO GLENCREST FARM Glencrest Farm announced yesterday that **Tethra** (Cure the Blues) will stand his first season at stud in 1997 at the Midway, Kentucky nursery. Racing exclusively in stakes company at two and three, Tethra won or placed in all eight of his career starts including five wins. In his first start at two, the Canadian-bred was beaten by ½-length in the Victoria S. (GIIC) at Woodbine. He then won the Clarendon S. (GIIC) by 10½-lengths and took the Vandal S. (GIIC) over eventual champion Talkin Man by 3½-lengths. Winning three of four starts at three, Tethra equaled Woodbine's track record in the Queenston S., covering seven furlongs in 1:21 2/5. He also won the Marine S. (GIIC) and the Woodstock S. (GIIC). Four-year-old Tethra, out of Canadian Champion Two-Year-Old Filly Ada Prospect, earned \$261,306 during his racing career. He will stand as the property of Eaton Hall Farm for a fee of \$2,500 live foal.

KISSIN KRIS BACK AT THE TRACK Kissin Kris (Kris S.), winner of the 1993 GI Haskell Invitational H., is back at the track after his first season of stud duty. The six-year-old successfully covered over 80 mares at John Franks' Southland farm in Ocala, Florida during the 1996 breeding season. An earner of over \$1.6 million, Kissin Kris was retired sound, was galloped daily during the 1996 breeding season and stayed in racing condition. It was decided to send him to trainer Todd Pletcher at Belmont Park with several stakes races possible this fall before the stallion is sent back to the farm for the 1997 breeding season. It is expected that Kissin Kris will start his shortened 1996 racing season in October.

HOUSTON SALE SHOWS GAINS During Fasig-Tipton's yearling sale at the Houston Polo Club in Houston, Texas Monday, 67 yearlings were sold for a gross of \$473,100 and an average of \$7,061, up 2.6 percent from last year's average of \$6,885. The co-sales toppers at \$35,000 were two dark bay fillies by Phone Trick--Katie Lynn (Star de Naskra) and Gilded Time--Chieftain's Native (Chieftain). The Phone Trick filly, previously sold for \$8,700 as a yearling at the Louisiana Thoroughbred Breeders sale in August, was consigned Monday by Glorianna Farm, agent, and purchased by L.W. Heiligbrodt. The Gilded Time filly, previously sold for \$32,000 as a weanling at the 1995 Keeneland November sale, was consigned Monday by Double Diamond Ranch, agent, and purchased by David Klausmeyer.

CANADIAN INTERNATIONAL S.-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/2mT

Singspiel (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}), winner of the G3 Westminster Taxi Select S. at Goodwood in his last start Sept. 14, arrived in Toronto Monday evening with handlers Kevin Bradshaw and Mick Blair. "It was a good flight," Bradshaw said of the trip from London to Toronto. "He travelled very well. He's shipped to France so he knows what it's about. It looks like he's taken to his surroundings and the climate." The four-year-old was returning to his Canadian roots; his dam Glorious Song was the Horse of the Year in Canada as well as the Champion Older Mare in Canada twice.

The five-year-old mare **Windsharp** (Lear Fan), who defeated males when winning this year's GI San Luis Rey S. and GI San Luis Obispo H., breezed six furlongs over the soft E.P. Taylor Turf course at Woodbine yesterday. The Kentucky-bred posted early fractions of :24 2/5 and :50 1/5 en route to a final six furlong time of 1:15 2/5. "It was a very good work," said Aimee Dollase, assistant and daughter of trainer Wally Dollase. "I was impressed with what she did. She finished strong and 1:15 2/5 on that soft turf course was good. It was exactly what we were looking for." Also working for the Canadian International Tuesday was **Dancing Fred** (Fred Astaire), third in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 25. The three-year-old breezed six furlongs in 1:13 flat over Woodbine's soft turf course.

Margaux Farm L.L.C. announced Tuesday that Phillip Teinowitz's 12-year-old stallion **Cryptoclearance** (Fappiano) has arrived at the farm and will stand the 1997 season at stud at the Midway, Kentucky nursery. His stud fee has not yet been determined.

Icy Warning (Caveat), a MSW of \$516,202, has been retired and will be boarded at the Greathouse family's Glencrest Farm in Midway, Kentucky. Team Valor, which owns the six-year-old mare, plans to breed her in 1997 and sell her, hopefully in foal, at the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Maryland-bred Icy Warning was bought by Team Valor from the Ryehill Stable after she beat subsequent Kentucky Derby and Travers S. winner Sea Hero in a turf allowance at Gulfstream Park in 1993.

Robert and Beverly Lewis have announced the retirement of their stakes-winning filly **Miraloma** (Deputy Minister). The three-year-old has arrived at Craig Bendoroff's Denali Stud in Paris, Kentucky to be prepared for the 1997 breeding season. Miraloma, winner of the Kentucky Budweiser Breeders' Cup S. at Churchill Downs during her undefeated two-year-old campaign, retires with earnings of \$106,712. Out of top broodmare Stick to Beauty, she is a half-sister to Champion Sprinter Gold Beauty and MSW Majestic Venture and a full-sister to GSW The Prime Minister. Current plans are for Miraloma to be bred to Mr. Prospector in 1997.
