**DANISH RETIRED** Grade I winner **Danish (Ire)** (Danehill), in foal to Gone West on a May 2 cover, has been retired from racing. The five-year-old finished sixth in her final start, the GII Diana H. at Saratoga September 1, but captured the GIII Saratoga Breeders' Cup S. in her penultimate effort August 11. A stakes winner in France, the Irish-bred captured the GI Queen Elizabeth II Invitational Challenge Cup at Keeneland at three; she won six of 24 career starts for earnings of \$562,994. She will be offered in the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, selling as Hip #937 November 12.
