DETTORI SWEEPS ASCOT CARD Sweeping Britain's racing fans off their feet with an amazing display, Britain's champion jockey Frankie Dettori swept the card on the first day of Ascot's Festival Of Racing yesterday, piloting the winners of all seven events. The Italian-born rider began the afternoon with a trio of Group-stakes successes on **Wall Street** (Mr. Prospector), 2-1; **Diffident** (Fr) (Nureyev), 12-1; and **Mark Of Esteem** (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}), 100-30. But, having returned from a suspension only on Friday, he was clearly not content with monopolizing the major races. Dettori went on to score with **Decorated Hero** (GB) (Warning {GB}), 7-1; **Fatefully** (Private Account), 7-4; **Lochangel** (GB) (Night Shift), a half-sister to the 1994 European champion sprinter Lochsong (GB) off at 5-4; before finally partnering **Fujiyama Crest** (Ire) (Roi Danzig) to victory in the day's last race. Dettori, the first jockey ever to achieve this feat on a racecourse in England, said: "I've had a lot of great days, but this is really unbelievable. To win all seven races is a dream come true. The highlight has to be Mark Of Esteem, of course. He deserves to be voted Europe's Horse of the Year after his performance today." The accumulated odds on Dettori's seven winners came to over 25,095-1. If only.

DARE AND GO TOPS MEADOWLANDS CUP WEIGHTS La Presle Farm's **Dare And Go** (Alydar), who stopped Cigar's winning streak at 16 with his victory in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar, has been assigned highweight of 123 pounds in the GI Buick Meadowlands Cup, to be run October 4, but the colt is expected instead to point for the GII Goodwood H. at Santa Anita October 5. Next in the weights is last year's winner, Canadian Horse of the Year **Peaks and Valleys** (Mt. Livermore), in at 121. A total of 32 horses were weighted for the race; there was one supplementary nomination, three-year-old **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister), 112, whose owners Michael Tabor and John Magnier put up \$20,000 to enter the colt.

Mark Of Esteem (Ire) has effectively crowned himself Europe's champion miler, as the 2000 Guineas hero proved any doubters wrong under Frankie Dettori. **BIJOU D'INDE (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), the Guineas third, set off in front at a sedate pace. His tempo began to increase turning into the home stretch, however, and, from there on in, only the first two to the wire were travelling easily. **Bosra Sham**, the 1000 Guineas heroine, started her rally at the quarter-mile post and established a clear advantage. But a combination of the four-month lay-off since her Classic success and Mark Of Esteem's fine finishing thrust, which began with 200 yards to go, meant she was destined only for the runner-up spot. **First Island** stayed on late to grab third. Sheikh Mohammed, the mastermind behind the successful Godolphin operation, said: "I do not think I have ever had a better miler. These were all the top horses at his distance and he was always going well. He is more mature now than he was in the spring and I think he is a great horse. He might go for the Breeders' Cup Mile after this, but we shall have to sit down and discuss it before making a final decision." Dettori had no doubts. "We have got the best horse and, even though I don't make the racing plans, I would love to ride him in Canada. He is undoubtedly the best miler I have ever ridden," the jockey insisted. The victory for Godolphin and trainer Saeed bin Suroor, one of four on the afternoon, also virtually locked up the English training title for bin Suroor, who went into the event neck-and-neck with Henry Cecil, trainer of runner-up **Bosra Sham**, for the honor. Ironically, Mark Of Esteem began his career in Cecil's yard, and it was his transfer to bin Suroor that brought about Cecil's rift with Godolphin.

Perfect Arc, unbeaten in four starts on the Belmont turf, was coming off a second-place showing in the GI Beverly D. at Arlington Aug. 24. The filly stalked pace-setting CHRISTMAS GIFT (Green Desert) before dismissing that rival in upper stretch and easily holding off the late-closing Fashion Star. "I think she went out and did what she had to do today," winning trainer Angel Penna, Jr. said after the race. "She was obviously the best filly in the field going in, and it was just a matter of dealing with the weight and the soft turf conditions." Penna cited the Oct. 12 Flower Bowl and the Breeders' Cup Mile as possible targets for Perfect Arc.
