TATTERSALLS SALE STARTS TUESDAY Tattersalls' Houghton Yearling Sale gets underway Tuesday evening in Newmarket, England. More than 15 percent of the 284 yearlings catalogued for this year's sale, which continues with an all-day session Wednesday and concludes after racing Thursday night, are by U.S.-based stallions, with 24 represented. Woodman, sire of Bosra Sham, the '94 Houghton sales topper and winner of England's 1000 Guineas this spring, has 12 in the sale. Other top American stallions represented include Storm Cat and his sire Storm Bird, Nureyev and his son Theatrical (Ire), El Gran Senor, Silver Hawk, Lear Fan and Alleged. There are also four yearlings each catalogued by European Horse of the Year St. Jovite and Kingmambo. Last year's Houghton Yearling Sales saw 222 yearlings sell for just under \$30 million, an average of about \$125,000.

ROCKINGHAM PARK CLOSES Rockingham Park ended its 90th anniversary season yesterday. While on-track handle and attendance figures declined from the '95 season, the New Hampshire track saw gains in overall handle on live racing from all sources with the addition of intertrack wagering. "Hopefully, the legislature will enact changes in the take-out structure during the off-season and there is the possibility of expanding gambling opportunities at the track which would enable us to offer larger purses next season," said Vice President and General Manager Ed Callahan. Trainer Gerald Souto and jockey Josiah Hampshire, Jr. topped the final standings for the first time in their careers.

JUDGE T.C. TO UPSON DOWNS Judge T.C. (Judge Smells), most recently second in the GIII Kentucky Cup Classic, will be retired to stud next year at Upson Downs Farm outside of Louisville, Kentucky, according to a story in today's *Daily Racing Form*. The five-year-old multiple graded stakes-winning stallion has earned \$826,826 while winning 11 of his 26 starts and is scheduled to duplicate his victory in last year's GII Fayette H. in his next start Oct. 19 at Keeneland.

The consistent Singspiel (Ire), first or second in 11 of his 13 career starts while racing almost exclusively in Group stakes in Europe, was expected to carry his form across the Atlantic and he did not let his backers down. The crowd's 9-5 favorite, racing on Lasix for the first time, broke sharply, sat just off the pace of the mare WINDSHARP (Lear Fan) to the quarter pole, then strode to the lead and drew clear under jockey Gary Stevens. "This course was in fantastic shape," said Stevens. "People were concerned the course would be deep and soggy, but Kevin Bradshaw (assistant to winning trainer Michael Stoute) said, 'believe me, this isn't soft compared to what he's used to running on in Europe, and he loves ground when he's almost sinking up to his knees.' If it rains for another month leading up to the Breeders' Cup, he's not going to have a problem, that's for sure." Anthony Stroud, racing manager for winning owner Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, confirmed that the four-year-old would be back for the Breeders' Cup. "For our European horses, this turf course is absolutely ideal," he enthused. "I must say for the amount of rain it's had, it rode very, very well today, and I can only think that there will be no excuses come a month's time. There were only seven horses in the race today, and there'll be an extra seven in the Breeders' Cup race. But with such a long stretch, there'll be no excuses."

Newmarket trainer Henry Cecil's Sleepytime was favored to give her trainer his fourth win in the previous 10 runnings of the Fillies' Mile, but she encountered serious traffic problems and her less-fancied stablemate lifted the prize. Reams Of Verse began to challenge for the lead two furlongs from the wire. Sleepytime, still cantering, attempted to split rivals, but could not squeeze clear and remained trapped in behind as Khassah arrived very late to grab second place. Not even a lengthy stewards' inquiry could come to the rescue of favorite backers. Pat Eddery, on the favorite, admitted: "I should have won and, if I could have pulled her out, I would have done." Cecil said: "They are two very good fillies and, hopefully, could both make the Guineas."

Benny The Dip is a 20-1 chance for next year's 2000 Guineas and 25-1 for the 1997 Epsom Derby following his hard-fought victory. Besiege, unbeaten in two starts, set out to make the running while Benny The Dip was always close behind the pacesetter. The winner took an advantage 200 yards from the wire. Desert Story made him work hard and only 3/4 lengths separated the duo as they flashed past the post. Trainer John Gosden said: "Benny The Dip will be entered for the Derby. But he is out of a speedy mare and I don't think he will stay that trip. He will be put away for the winter now and trained with the 2000 Guineas in mind."

Kahal (GB) (Machiavellian--Just A Mirage {GB}, by **Green Desert**) earned himself odds of 25-1 for next year's 2000 Guineas when posting an impressive victory in yesterday's Sunday Conditions S. at Ascot. The Ed Dunlop-trained colt was never far off the pace and was always moving sweetly under Richard Hills. Kahal made his move with two furlongs to go and registered a 3 1/2-length win. Hills said: "This is a very nice horse. He's going the right way and has come on a lot for his first run. We shall have to see how he winters, but we all hope he's top class."

Further Flight (GB) (Pharly) is target to bid for an unprecedented sixth consecutive win in the G3 Jockey Club at Newmarket Saturday. Yesterday morning, trainer Barry Hills issued an upbeat bulletin on Further Flight's progress. Hills said "I think, provided there are no more setbacks, that we have a decent chance of getting him to Newmarket for the weekend. He is looking a picture and, fingers crossed, I think he can make it." Further Flight's win in the 1995 Jockey Club Cup made him the first European racehorse ever to have captured the same Group race on five occasions.
